The Central Bank of Sri Lanka has opened a Counter to issue coins to the Public at the ground floor of the Central Bank Head Office Building, No.30, Janadhipathi Mawatha, Colombo 01, from 27 March 2019.

Days Counter will be kept Open:

Wednesday and Thursday except public and bank holidays

Opening hours:

9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m.

Minimum Issue:

One Packet of 100 coins from any one denomination (Re. 1/=, Rs. 2/=, Rs. 5/=, Rs. 10/=)

Maximum Value of Coin Issue:

Rs. 20,000/= at a time (one denomination/ combination of any denomination).

Bulk coin Issues:

An individual or organization should apply to the Superintendent of Currency Department two days prior to collection.

Application Form and Instruction Form:

Available at the Cash Counter of the Currency Department on any working day and website of the Central Bank (www.cbsl.gov.lk).
