## Minimum amount of notes Issue per person

One Packet of 100 notes from any denomination (Rs.20/-, Rs.50/-, Rs.100/-, Rs.500/-, Rs.1000/-)

Further, it has been revealed that a considerable volume of unusable Rs.10 notes are in the circulation as per the Central Bank data. Therefore, the public is hereby requested to exchange unusable Rs.10 notes from the nearest branch of any Licensed Commercial Bank or from the Damage Notes Exchange Counter at the Head Office building of the Central Bank of Sri Lanka.

The Damage Notes Exchange Counter at the Head Office building of the Central Bank of Sri Lanka is opened on every weekday from 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. except public and bank holidays.
