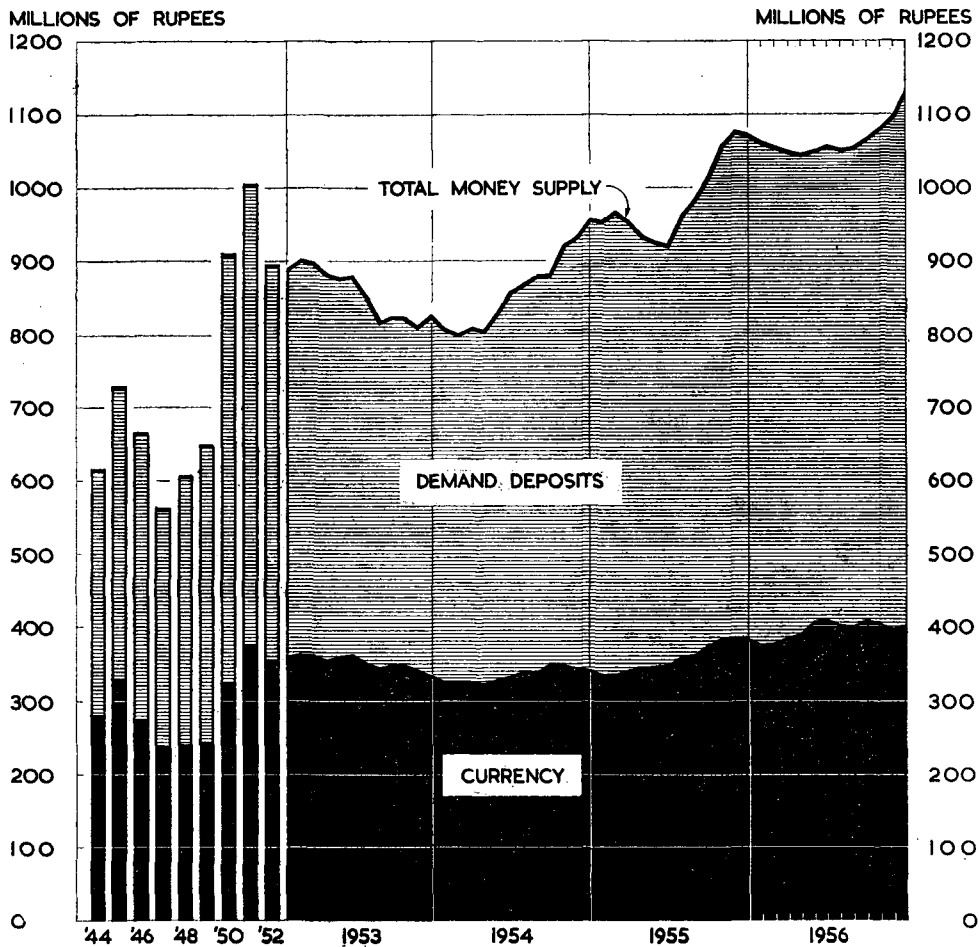


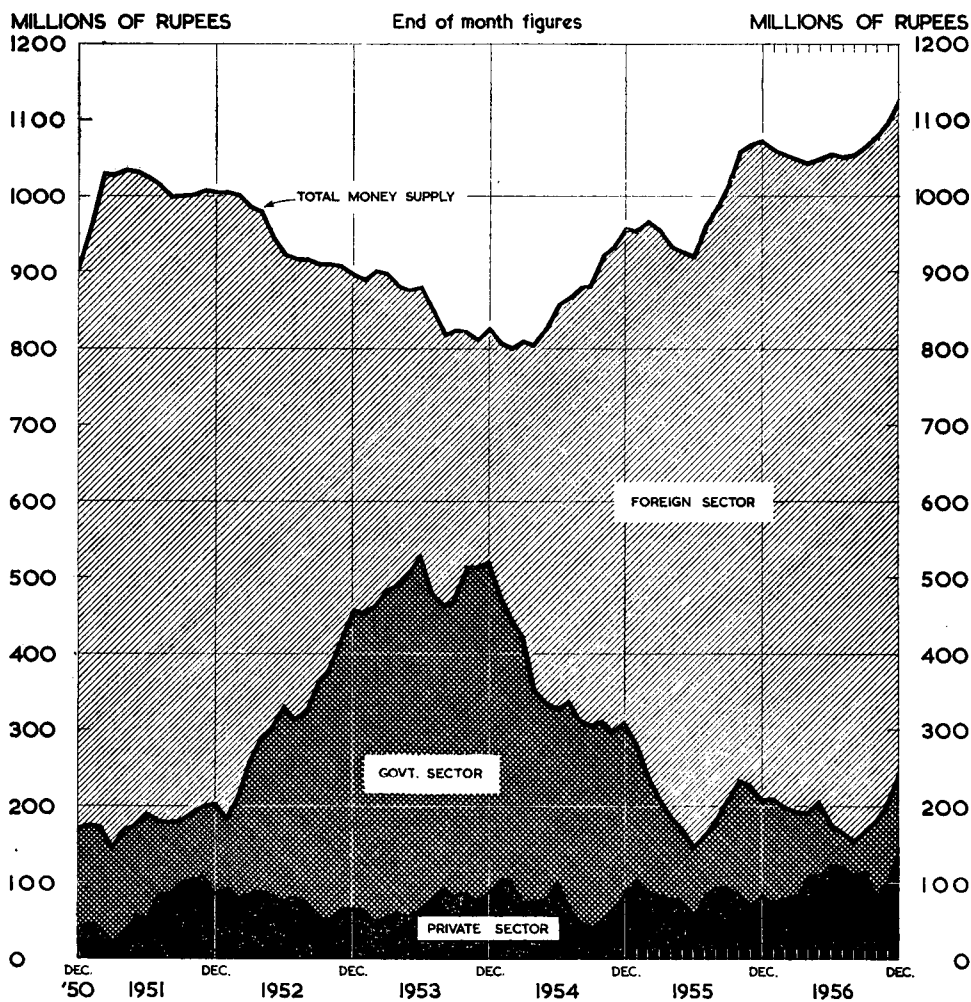

End of year 1944-1952; End of month January, 1953

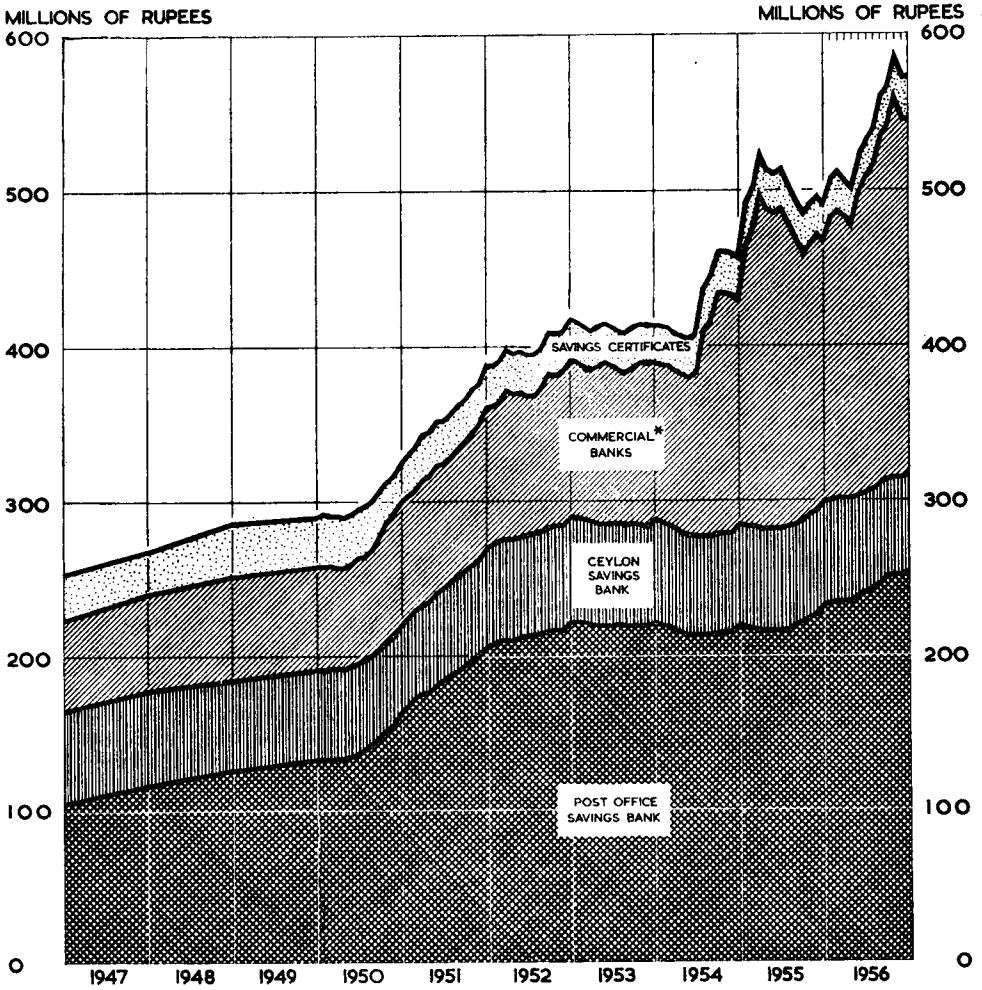


SECTORAL ANALYSIS OF MONEY SUPPLY

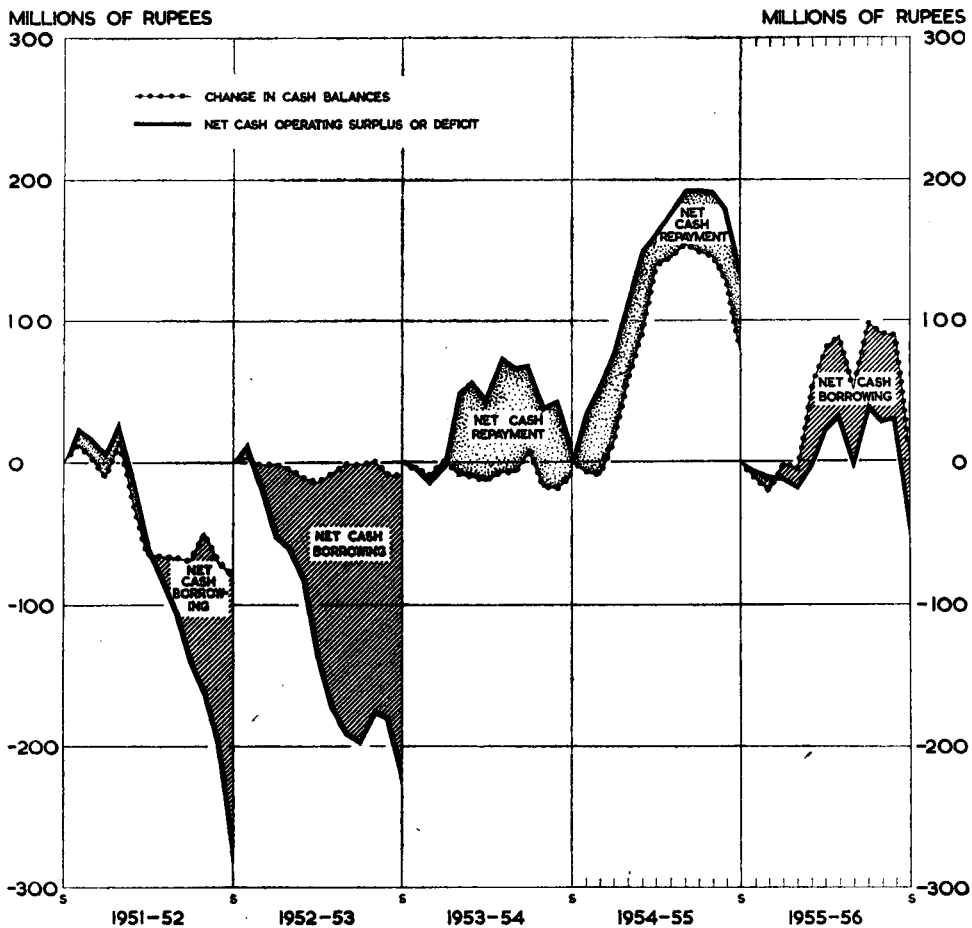
End of year 1947 - 1949: End of month Jan. 1950



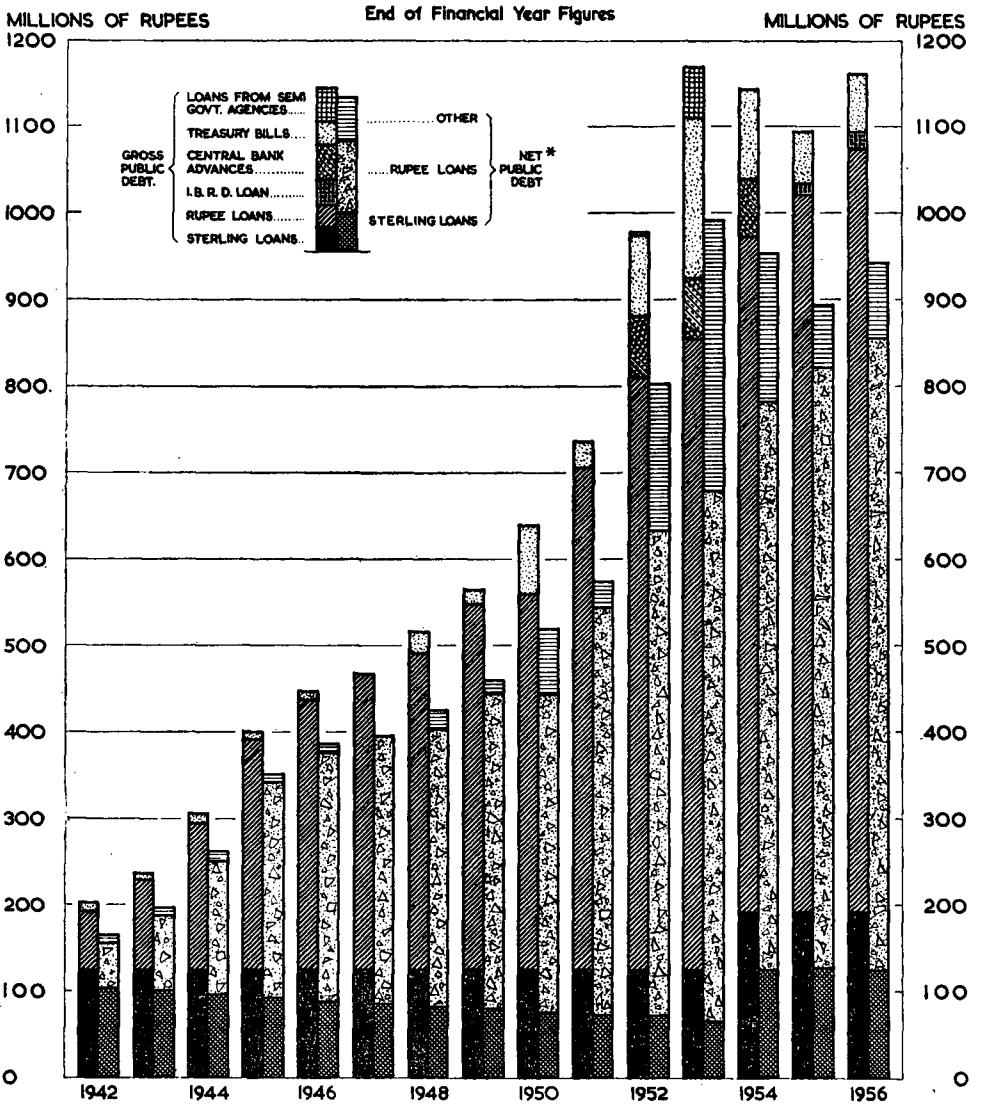

Cumulative data, by Financial Years.

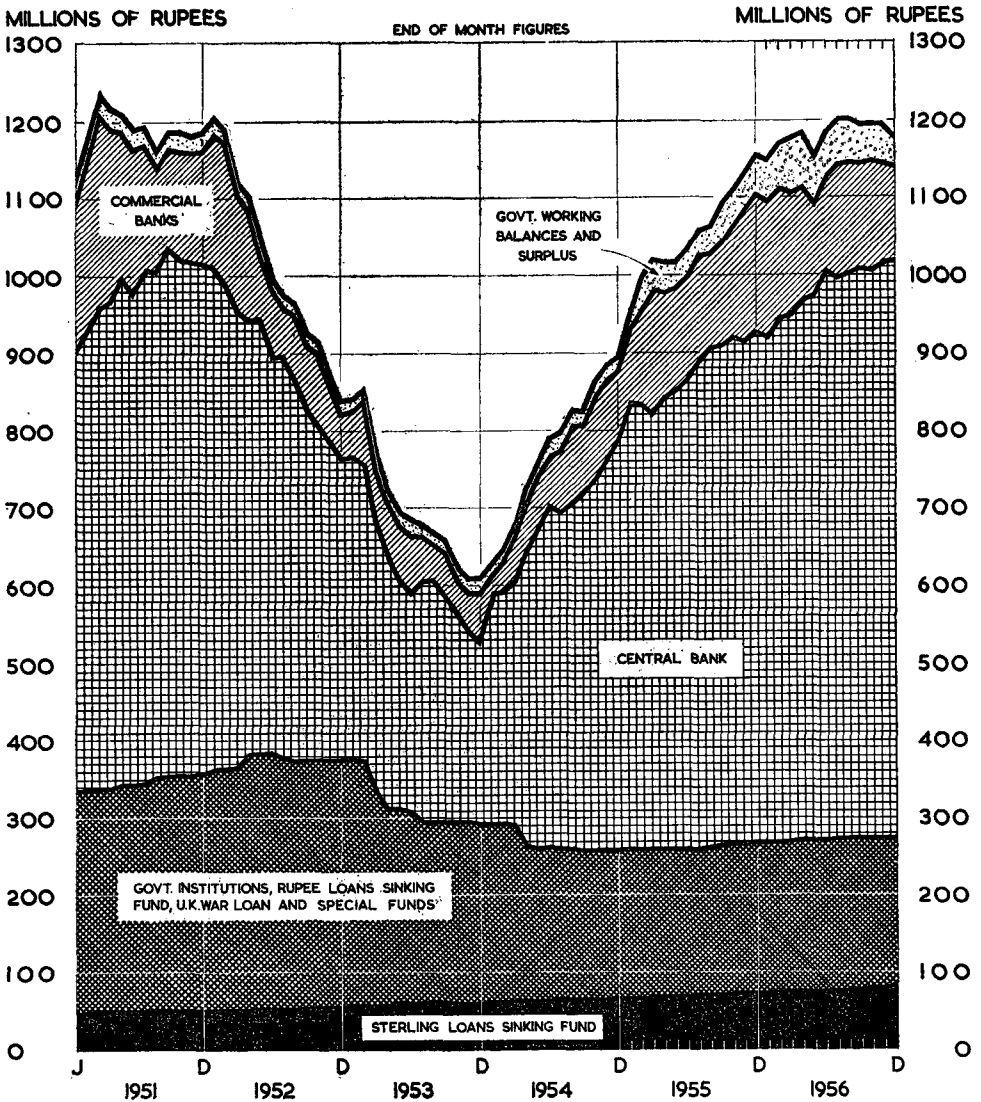


PUBLIC DEBT



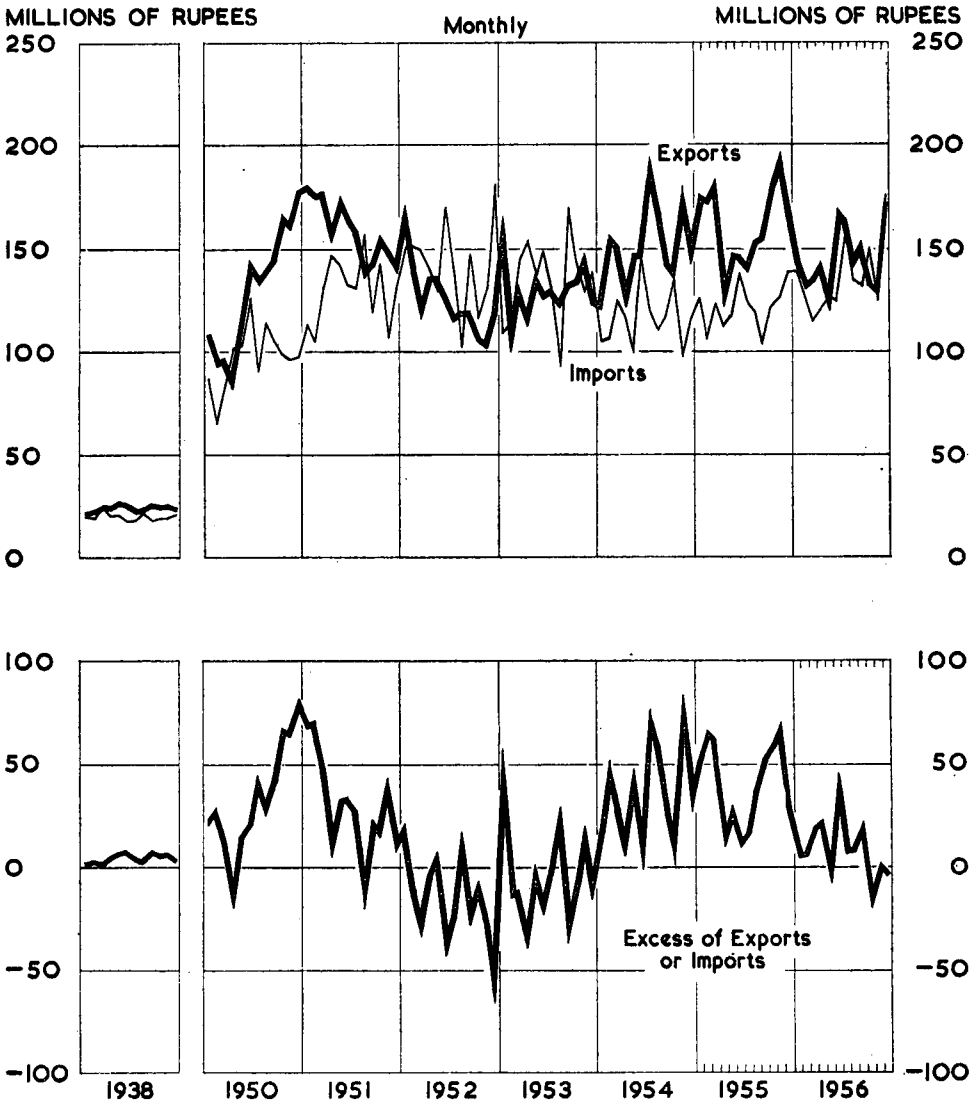
* GROSS PUBLIC DEBT LESS SINKING FUNDS

EXTERNAL ASSETS OF CEYLON

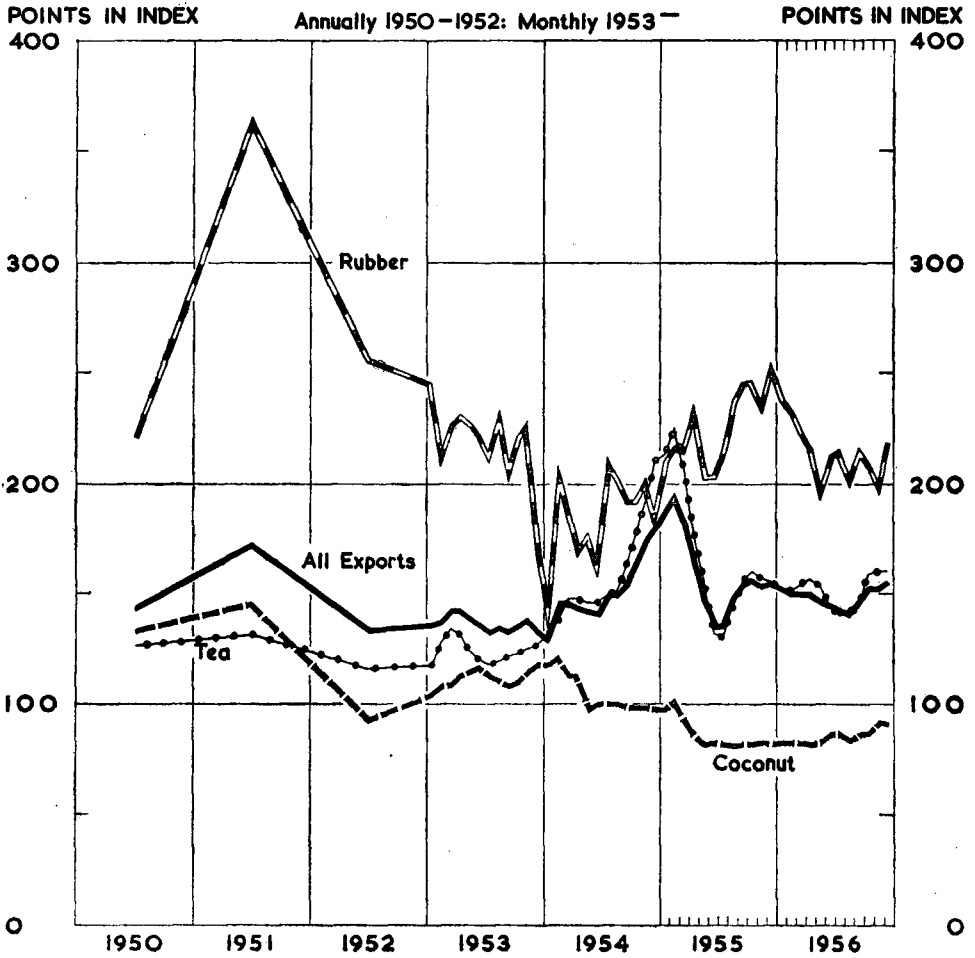

MERCHANDISE EXPORTS & IMPORTS

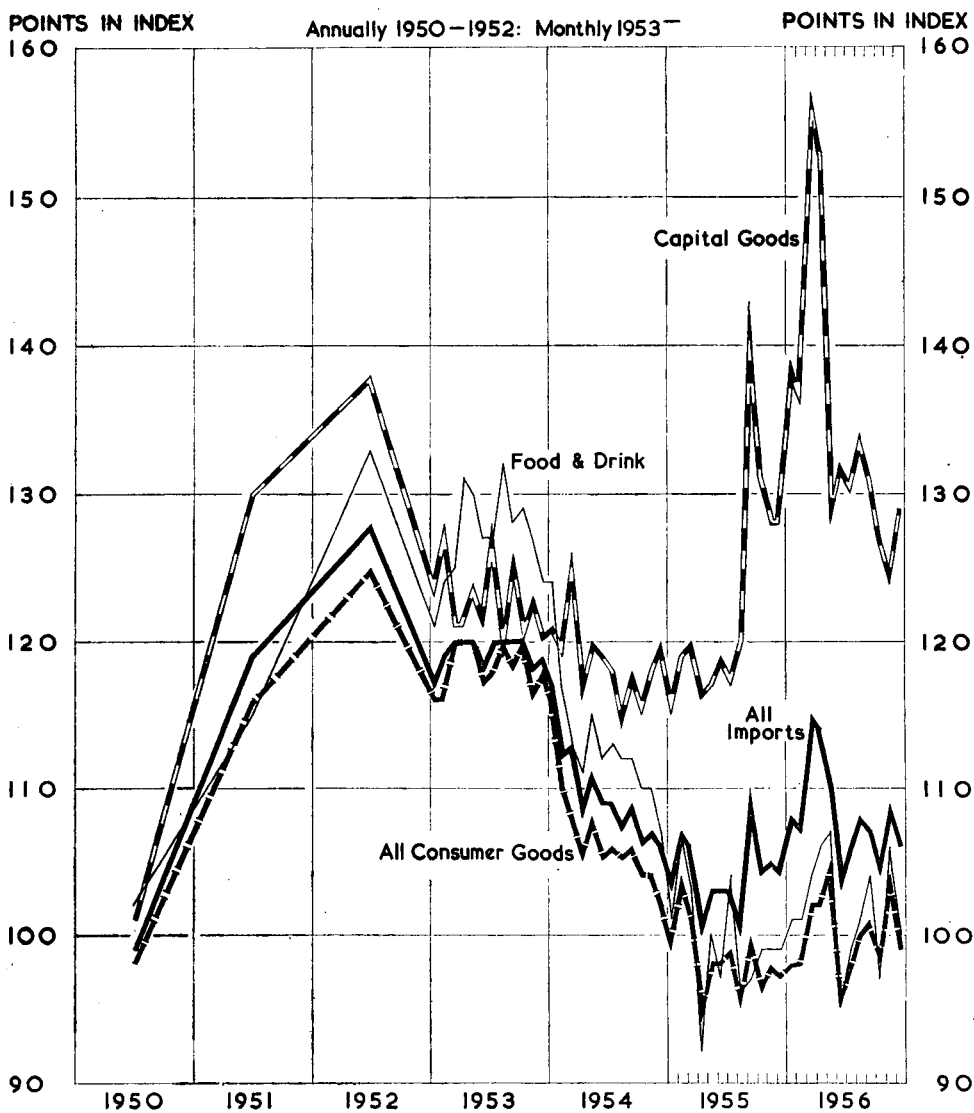


EXPORT PRICE INDEX 1948=100

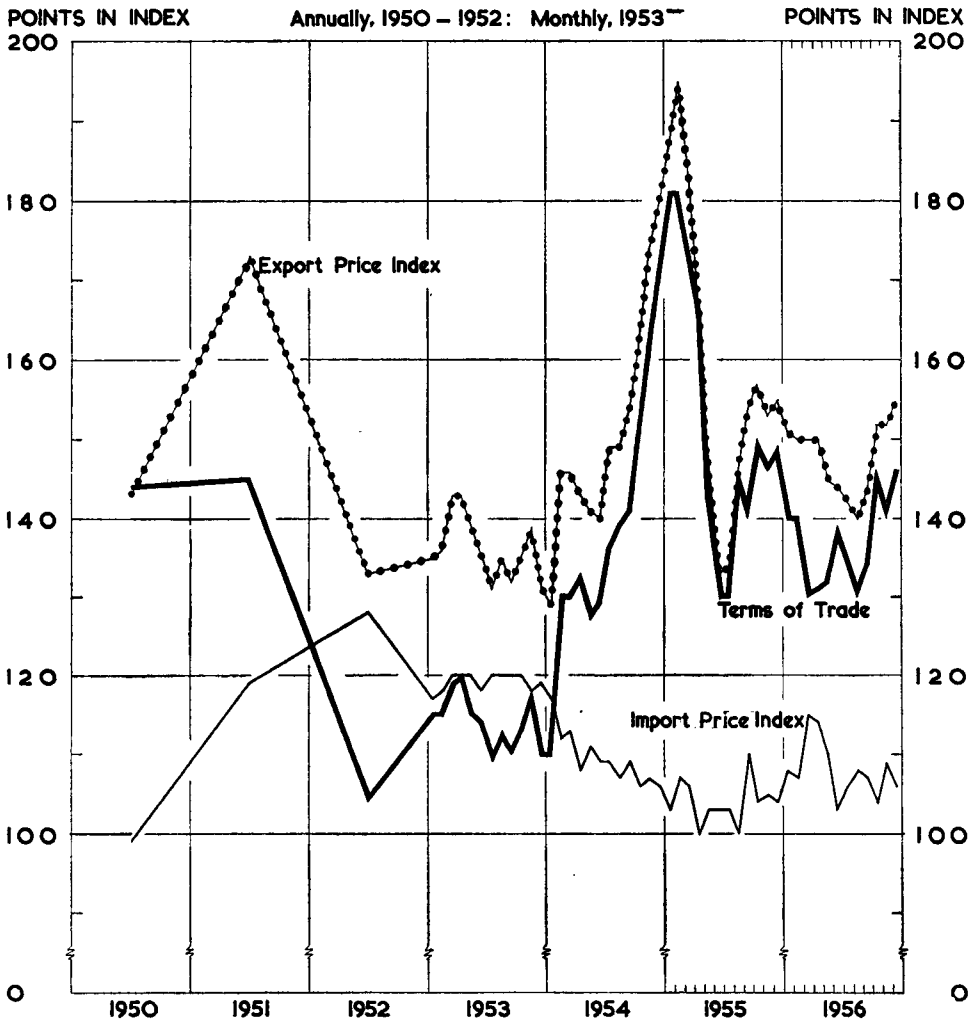


IMPORT PRICE INDEX

1948=100

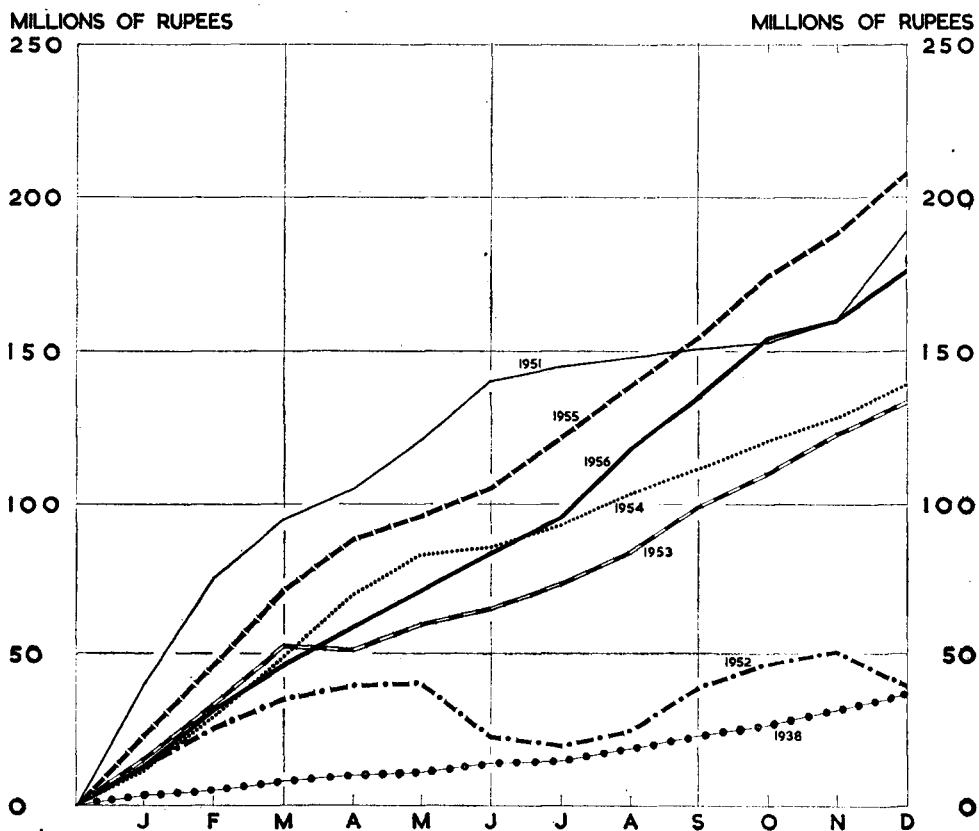


TERMS OF TRADE 1948 = 100

Cumulative - monthly; Beginning of year equals Zero.

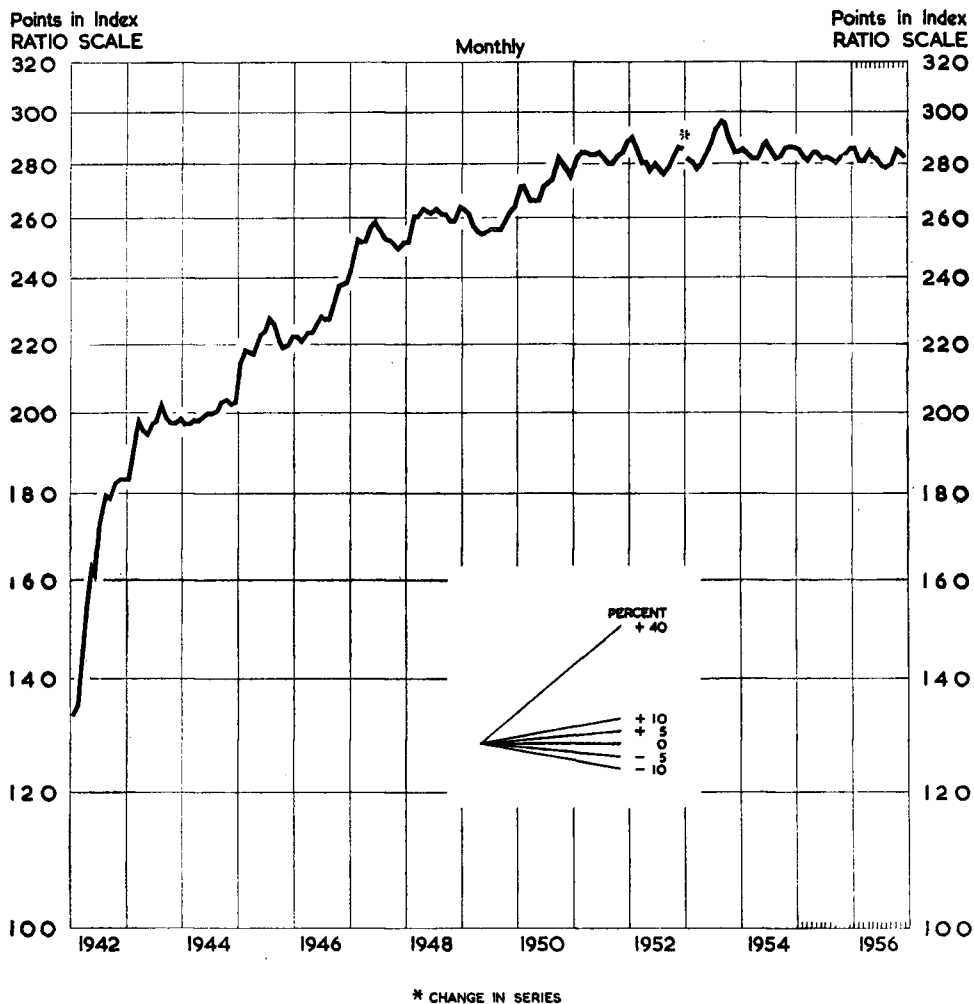

Average Price, November, 1938 to 1939 = 100



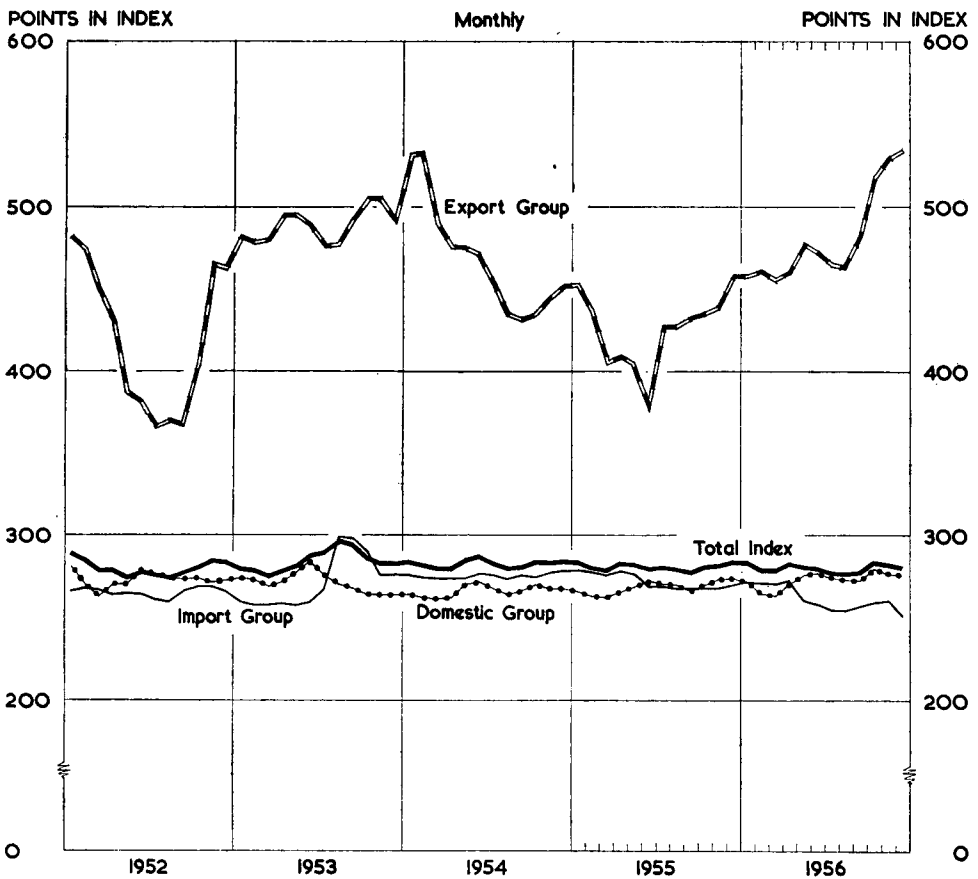

COST OF LIVING INDEX – LOWER INCOME GROUP COLOMBO TOWN BY COMMODITY GROUPS

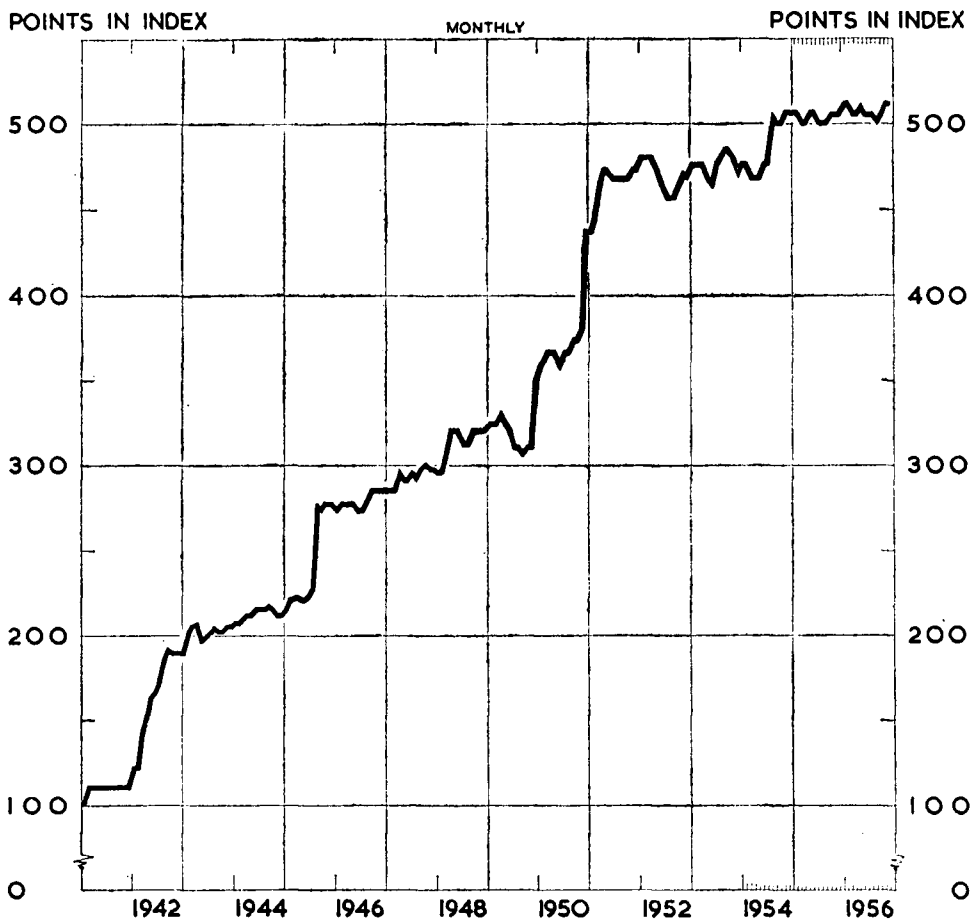
Average Price, Nov. 1938 – Apr. 1939=100
