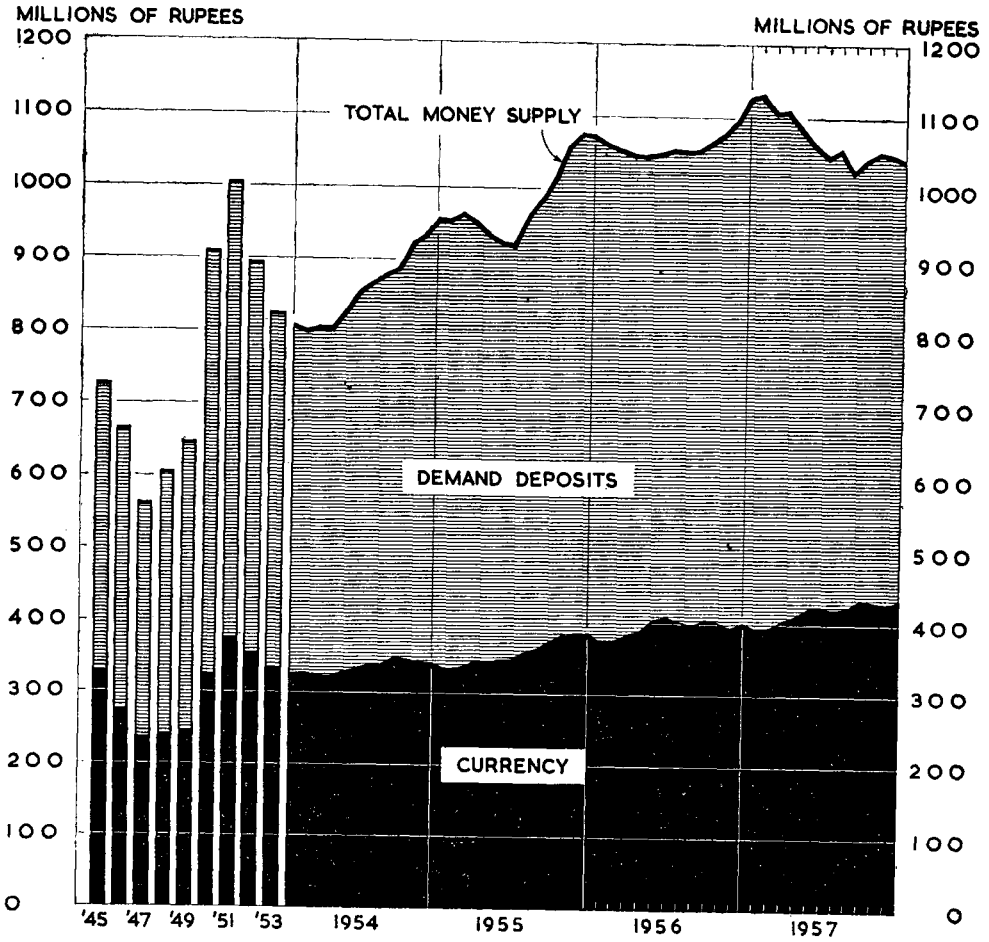

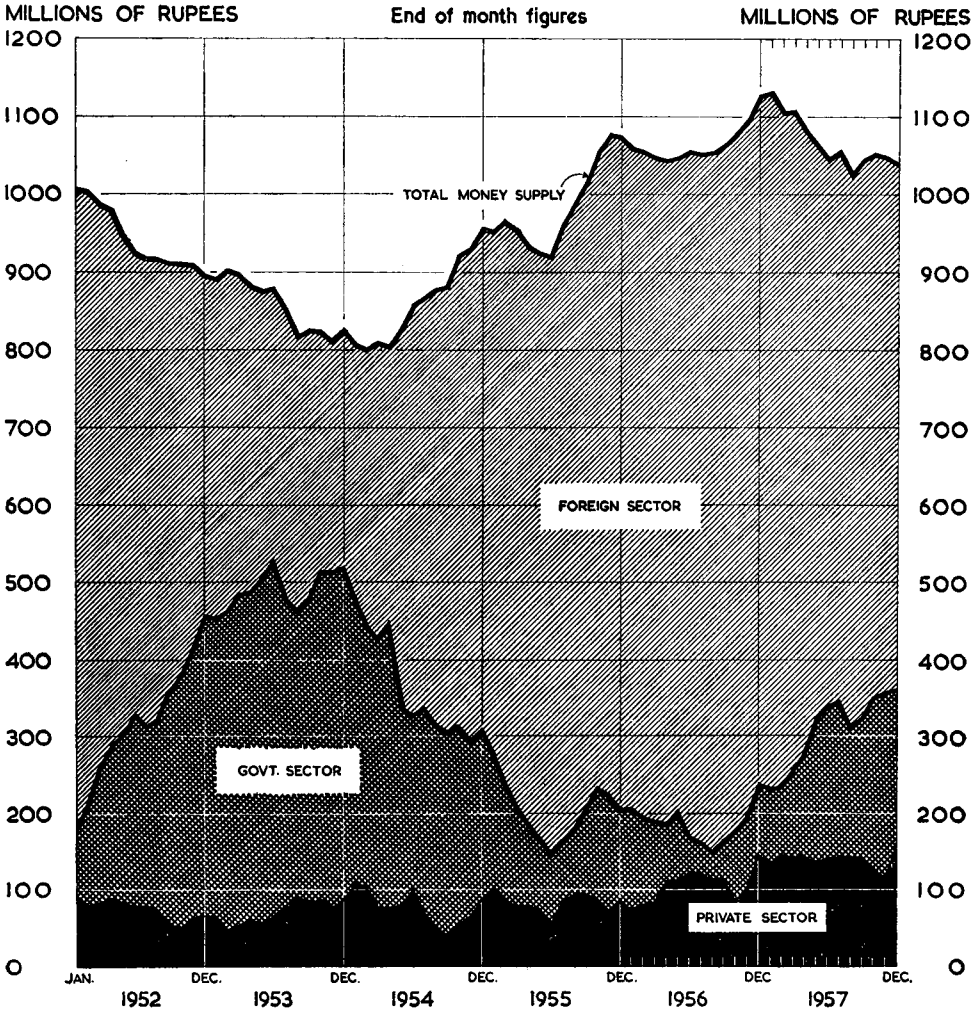

End of year 1945-1953; End of month January, 1954-

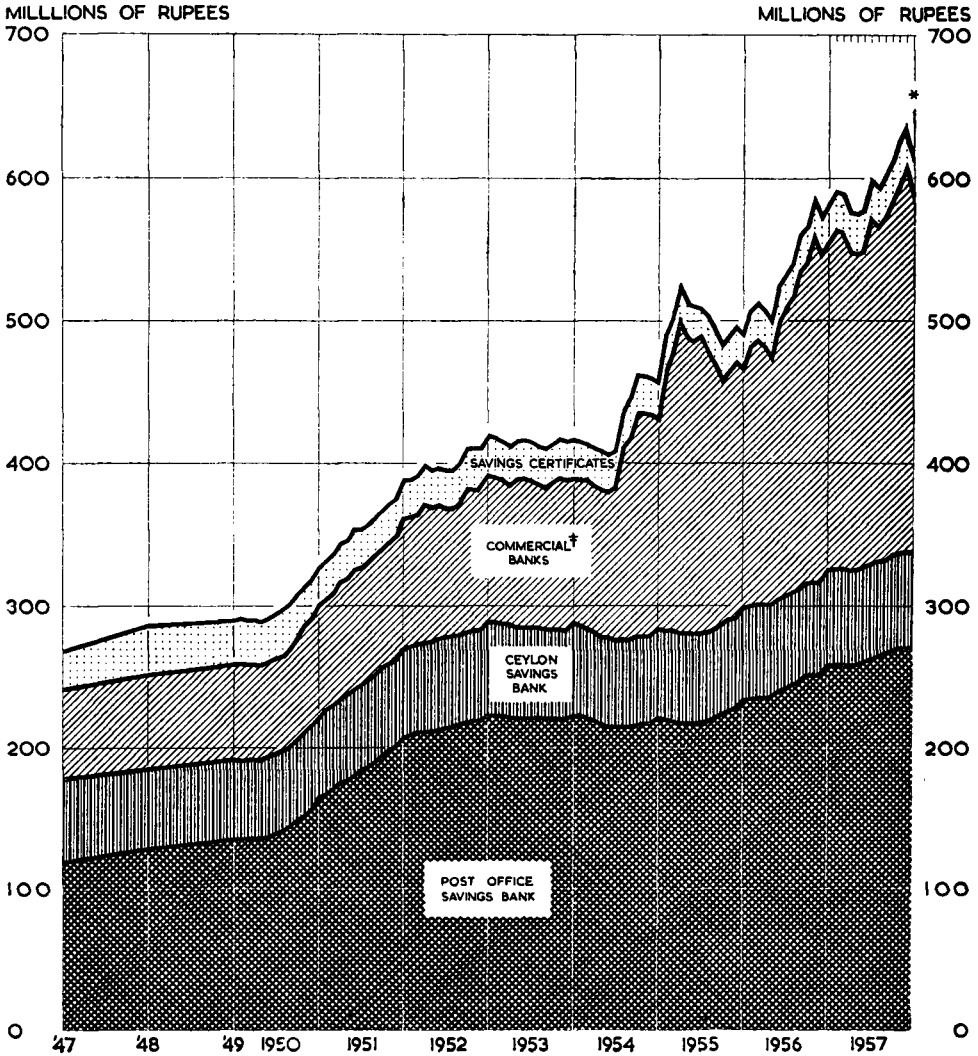


SECTORAL ANALYSIS OF MONEY SUPPLY

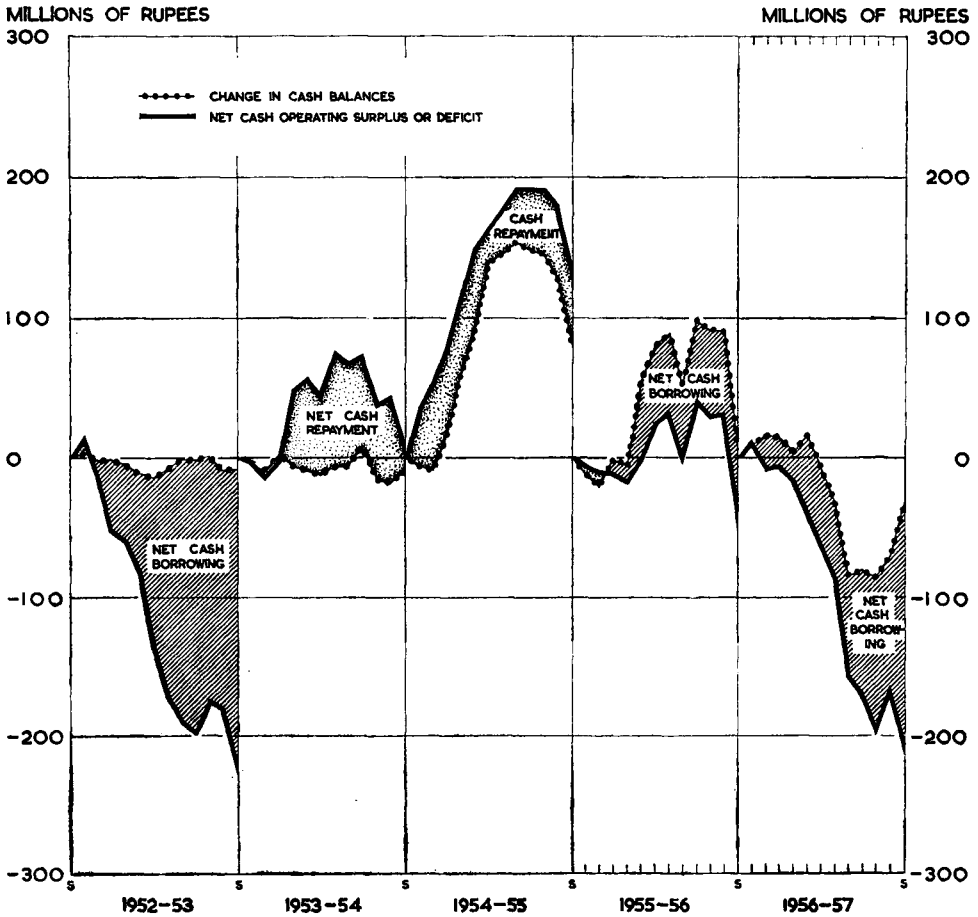

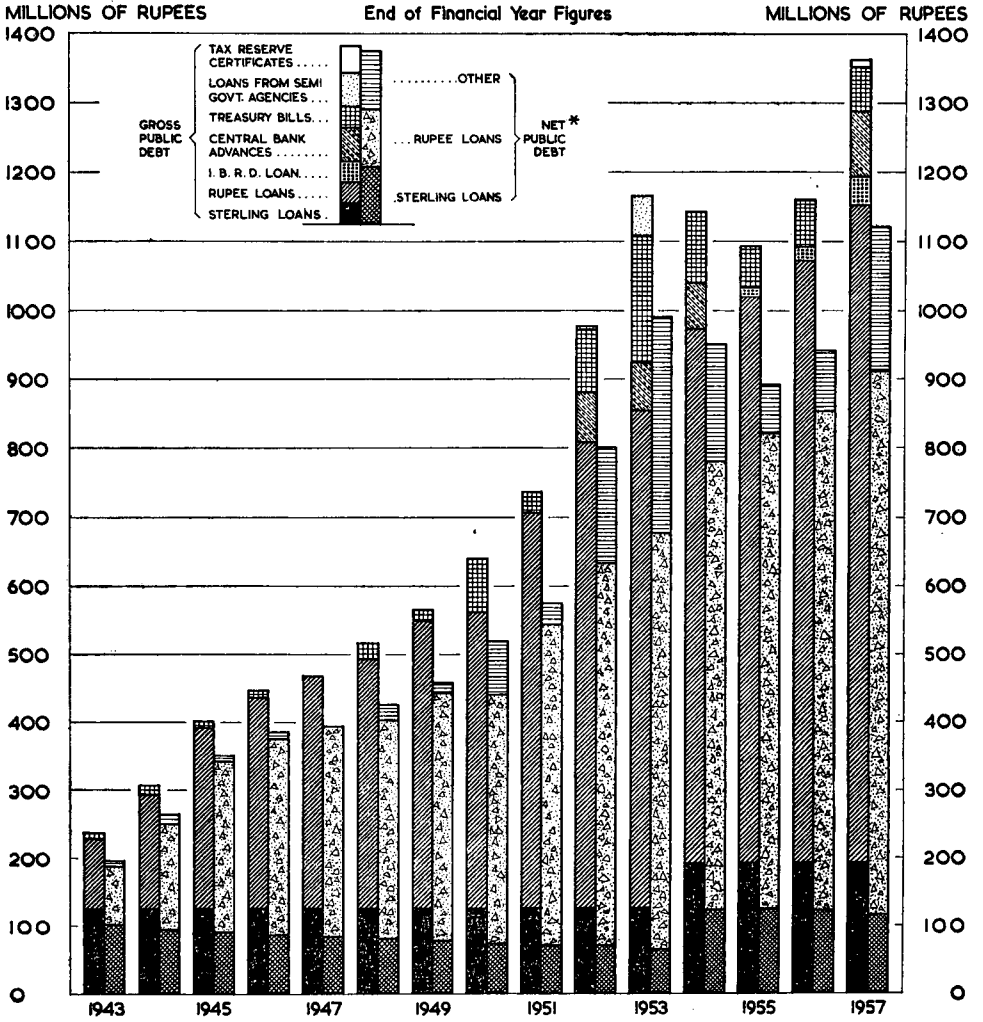

Cumulative data, by Financial Years.

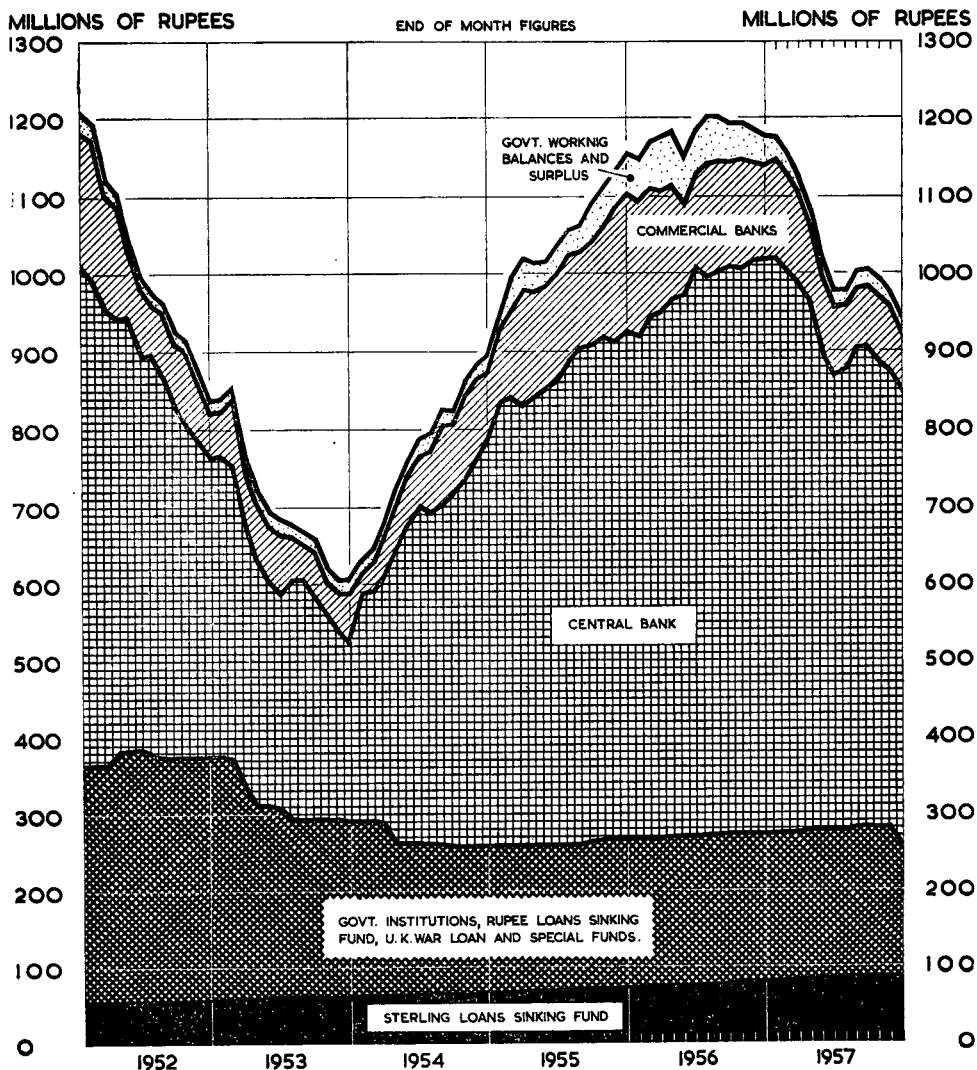


PUBLIC DEBT



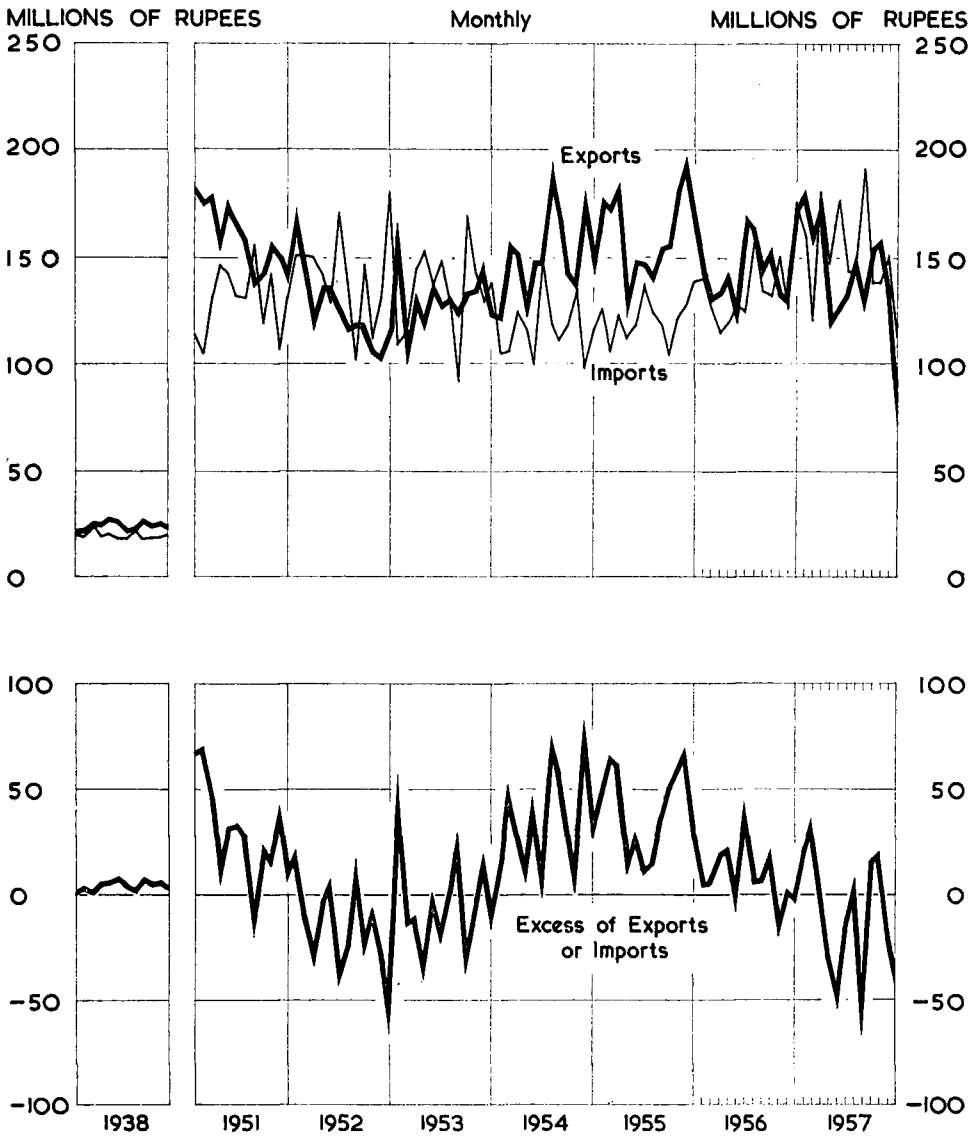
* GROSS PUBLIC DEBT LESS SINKING FUNDS

EXTERNAL ASSETS OF CEYLON



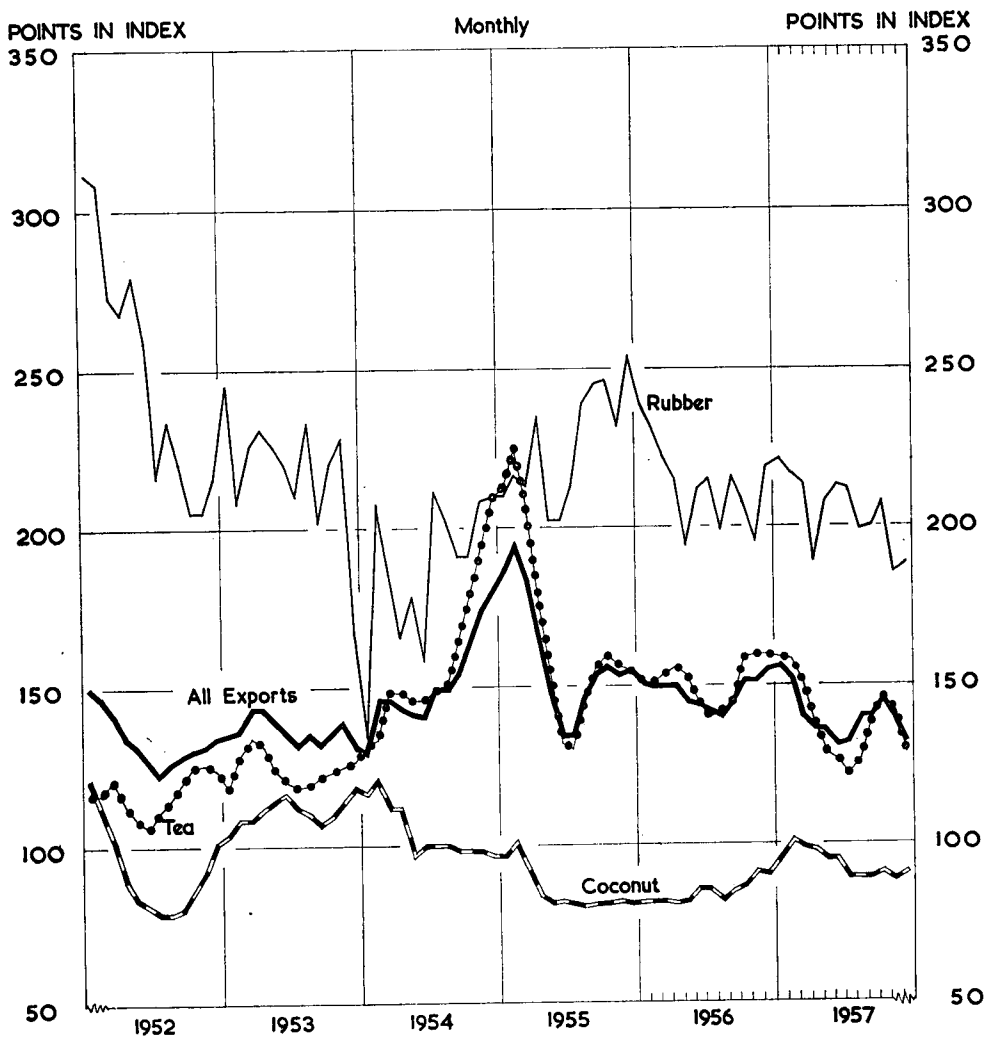

MERCHANDISE EXPORTS & IMPORTS



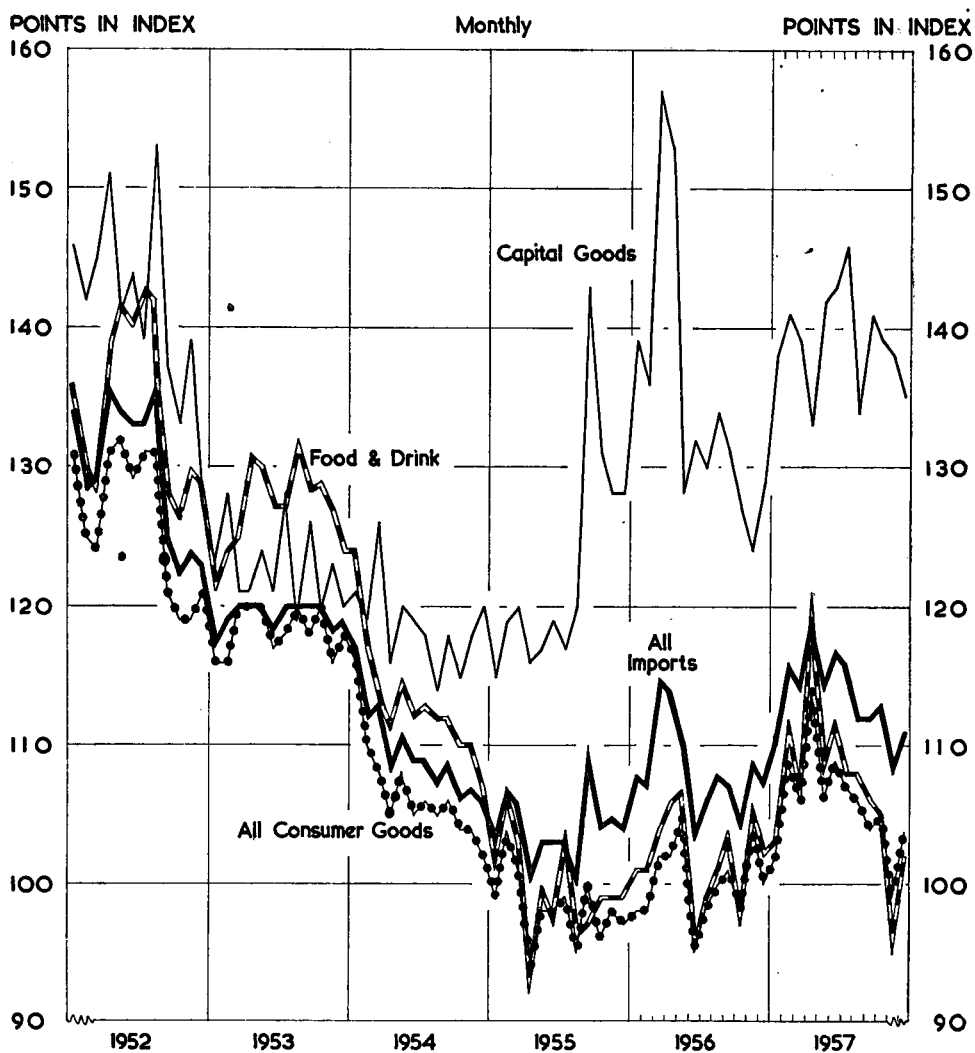
EXPORT PRICE INDEX

1948 = 100



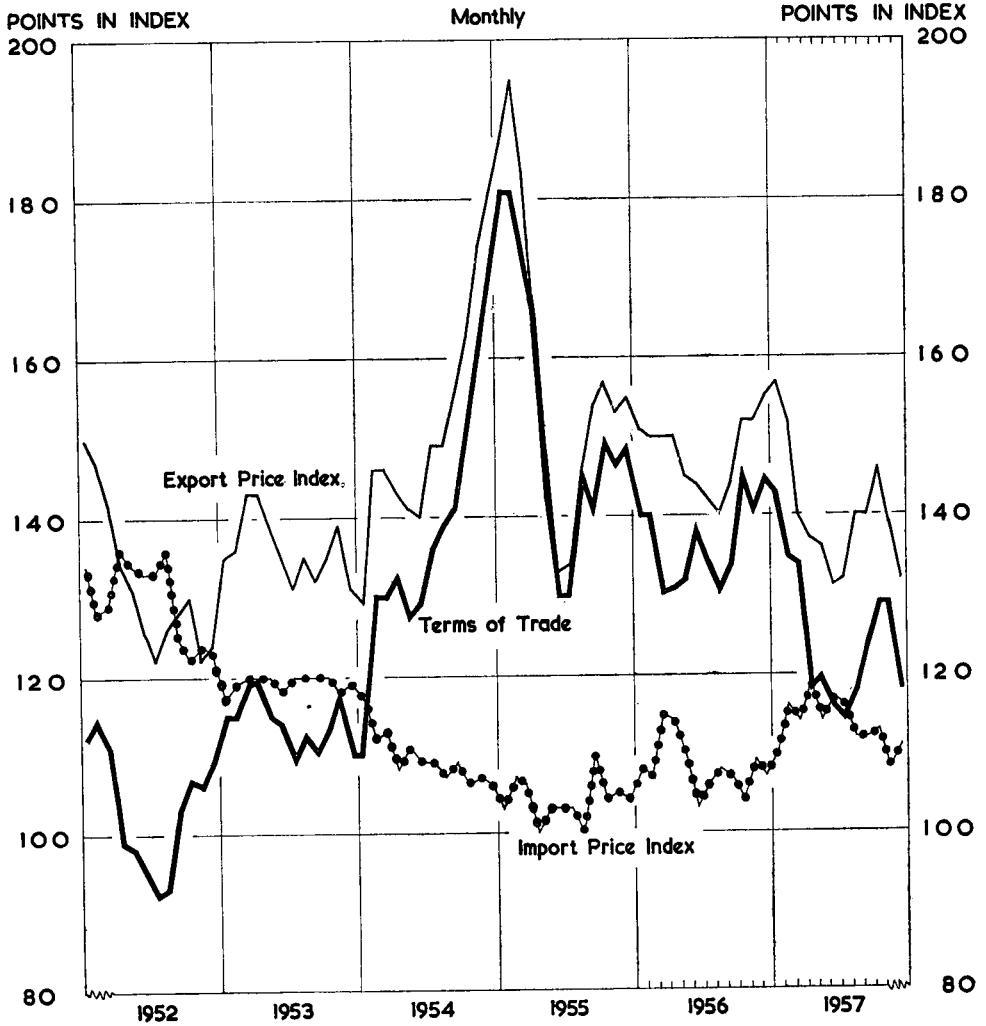
IMPORT PRICE INDEX

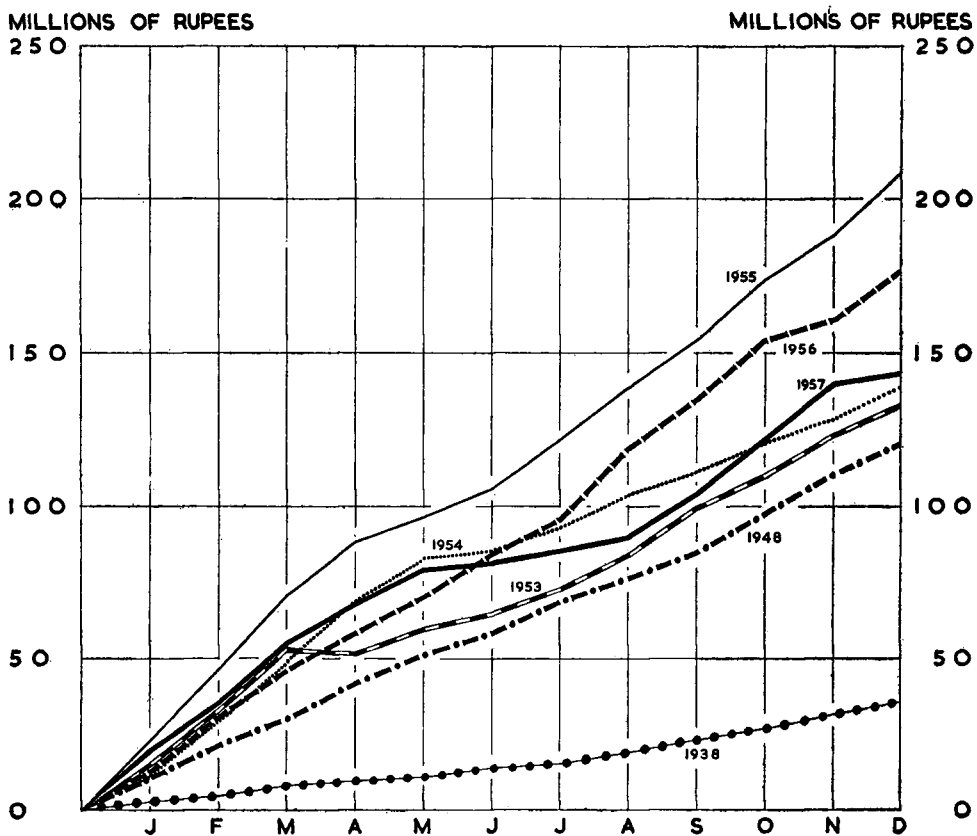
TERMS OF TRADE

Cumulative - monthly; Beginning of year equals Zero.

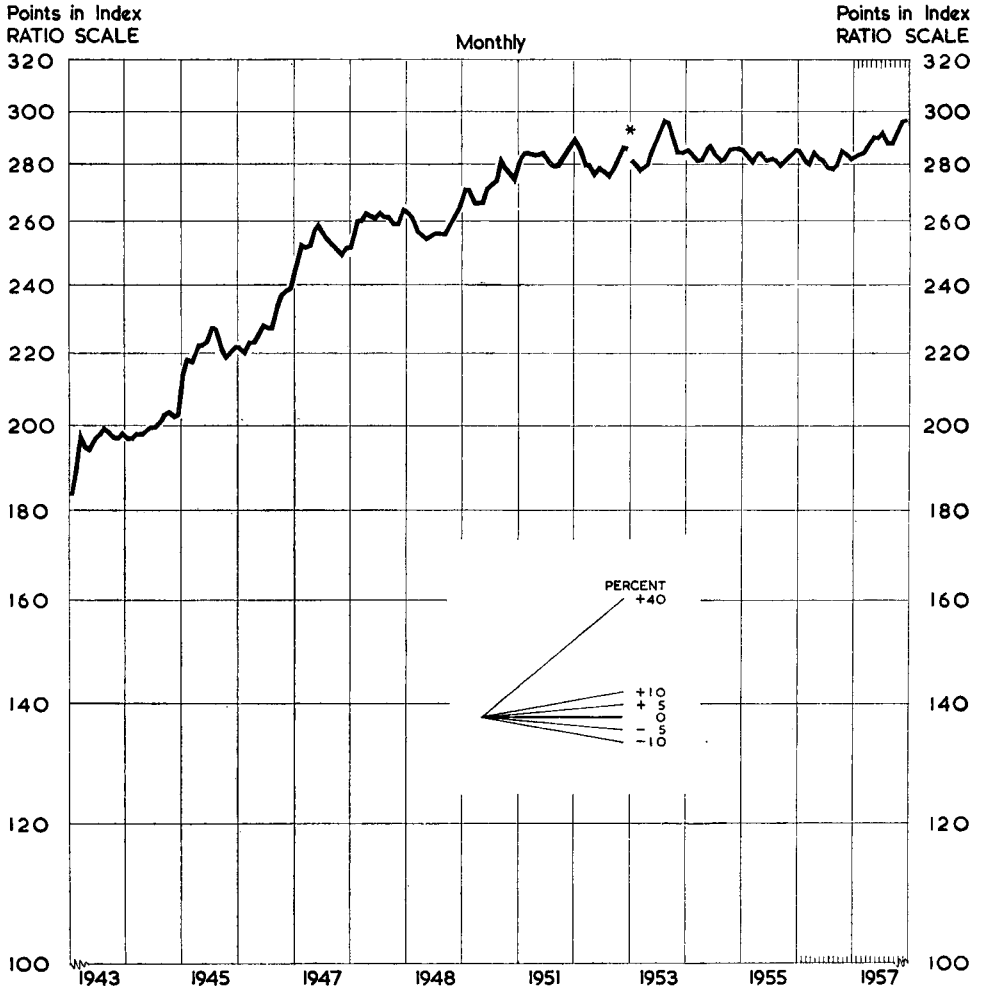

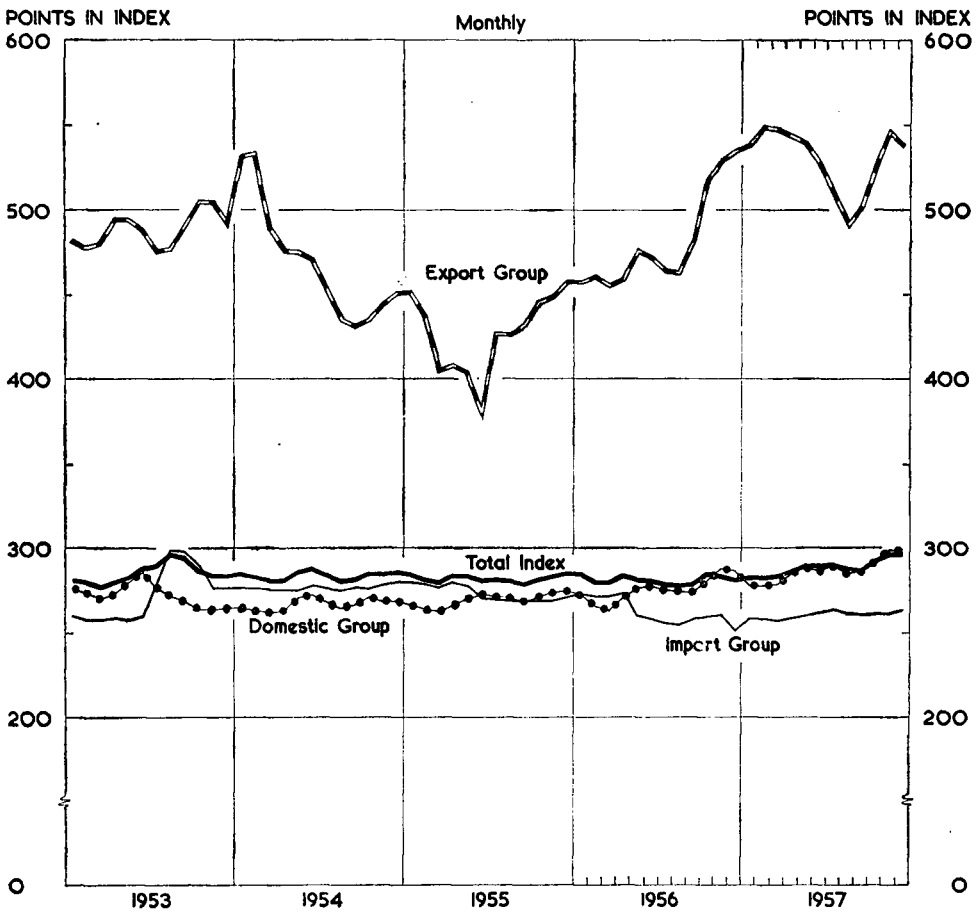

COST OF LIVING INDEX - LOWER INCOME GROUP COLOMBO TOWN BY COMMODITY GROUPS

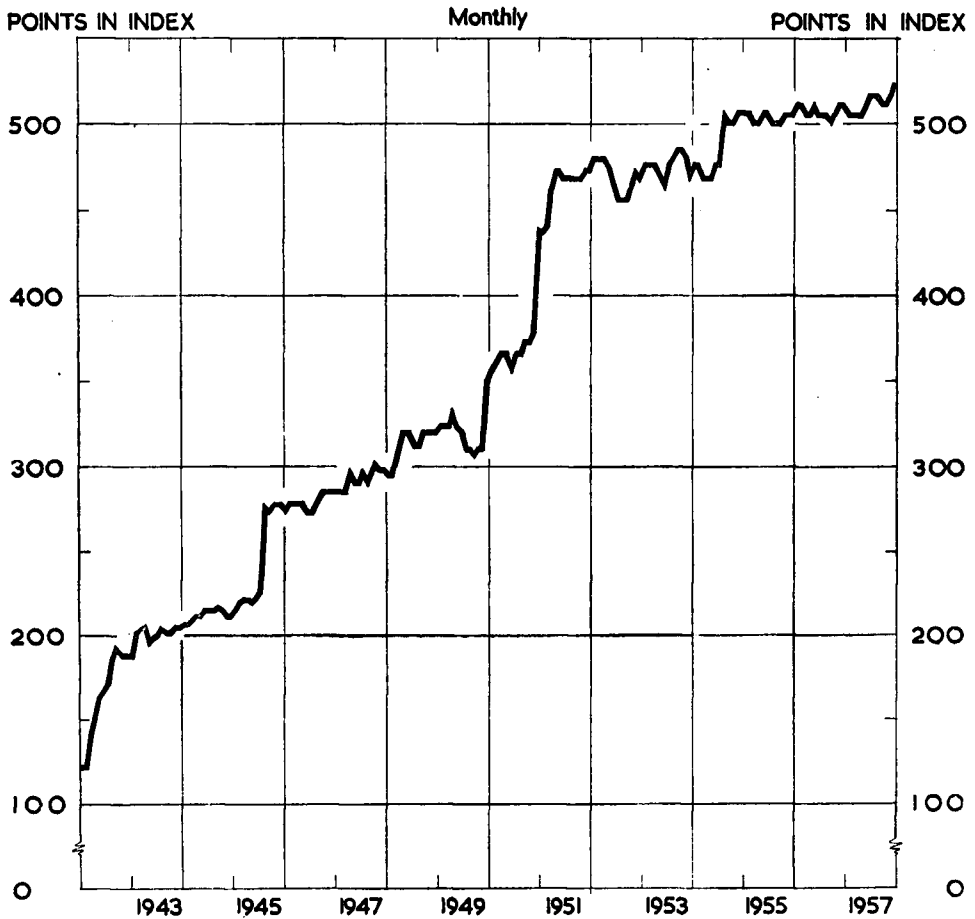
Average Price, Nov. 1938 - Apr. 1939 = 100

Average Wages, 1939 = 100



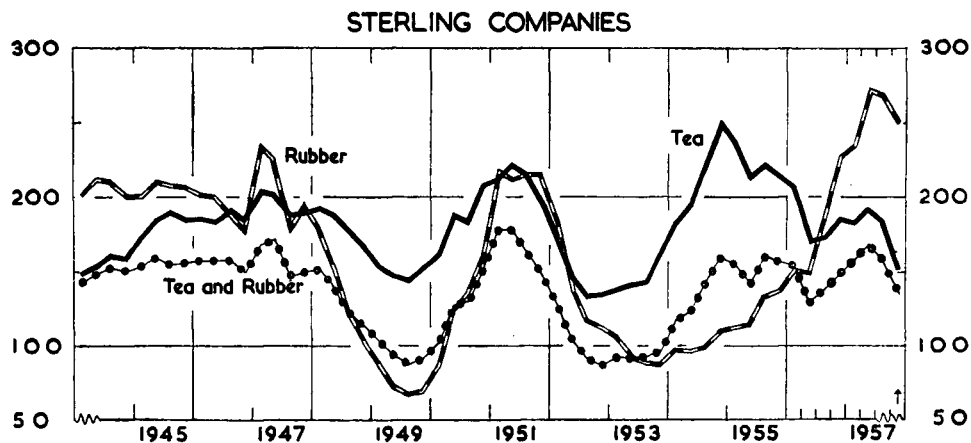
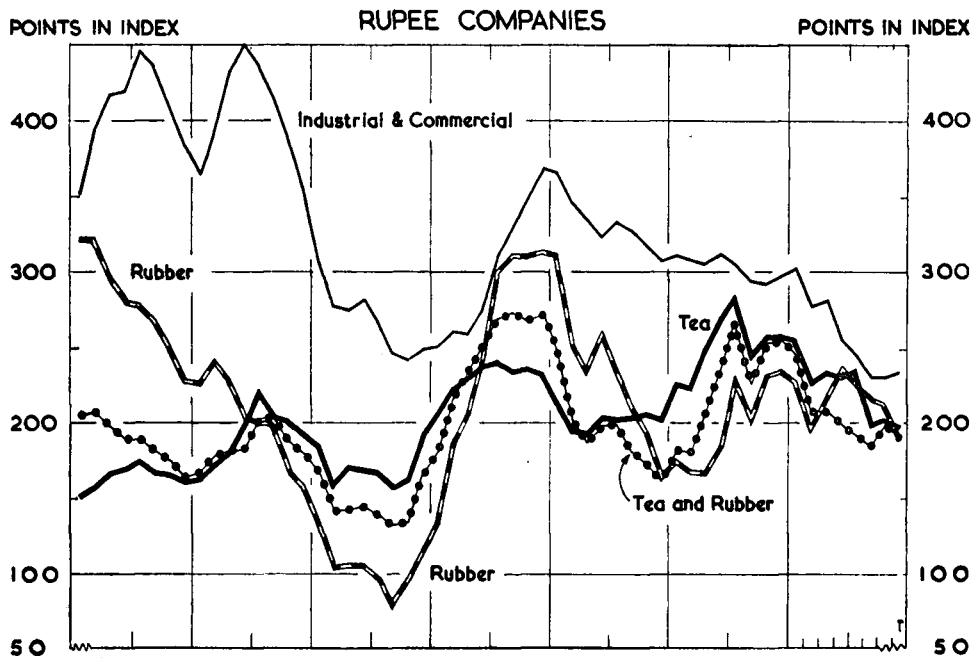
