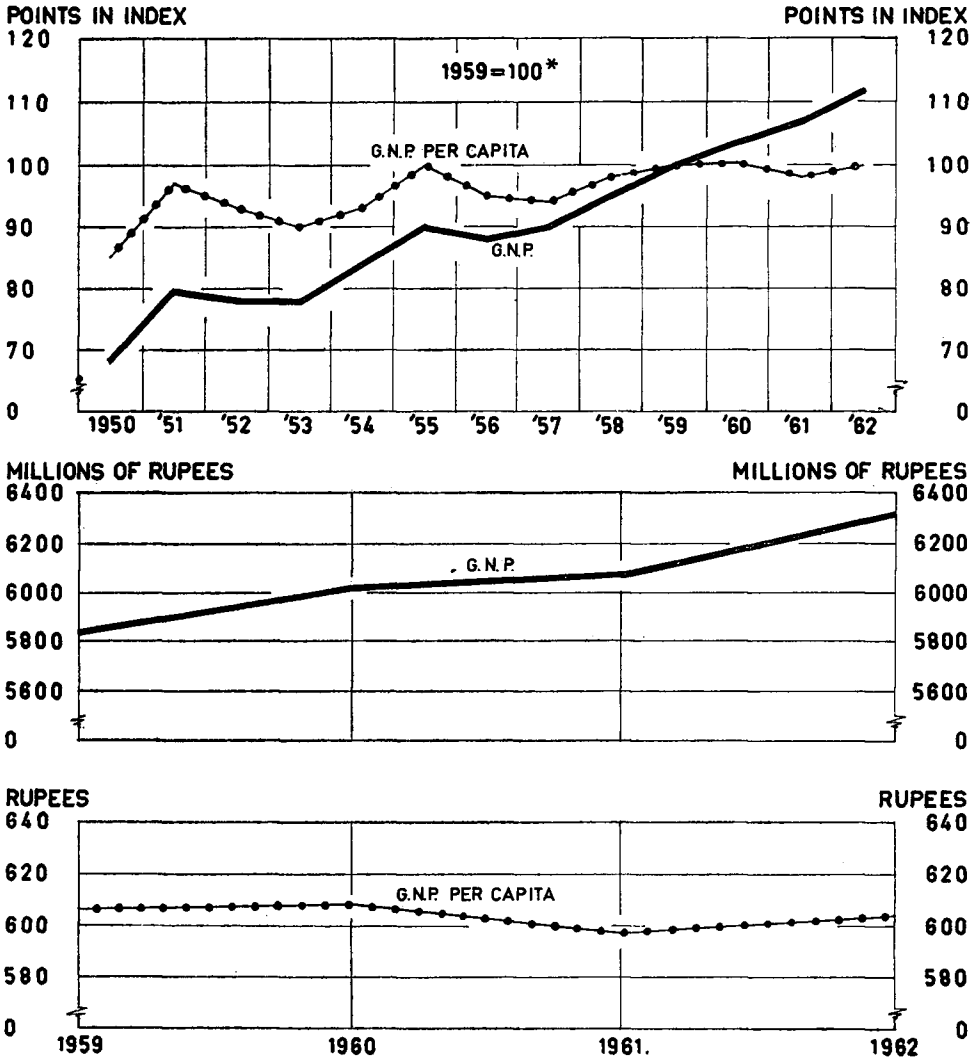

ANNUALLY

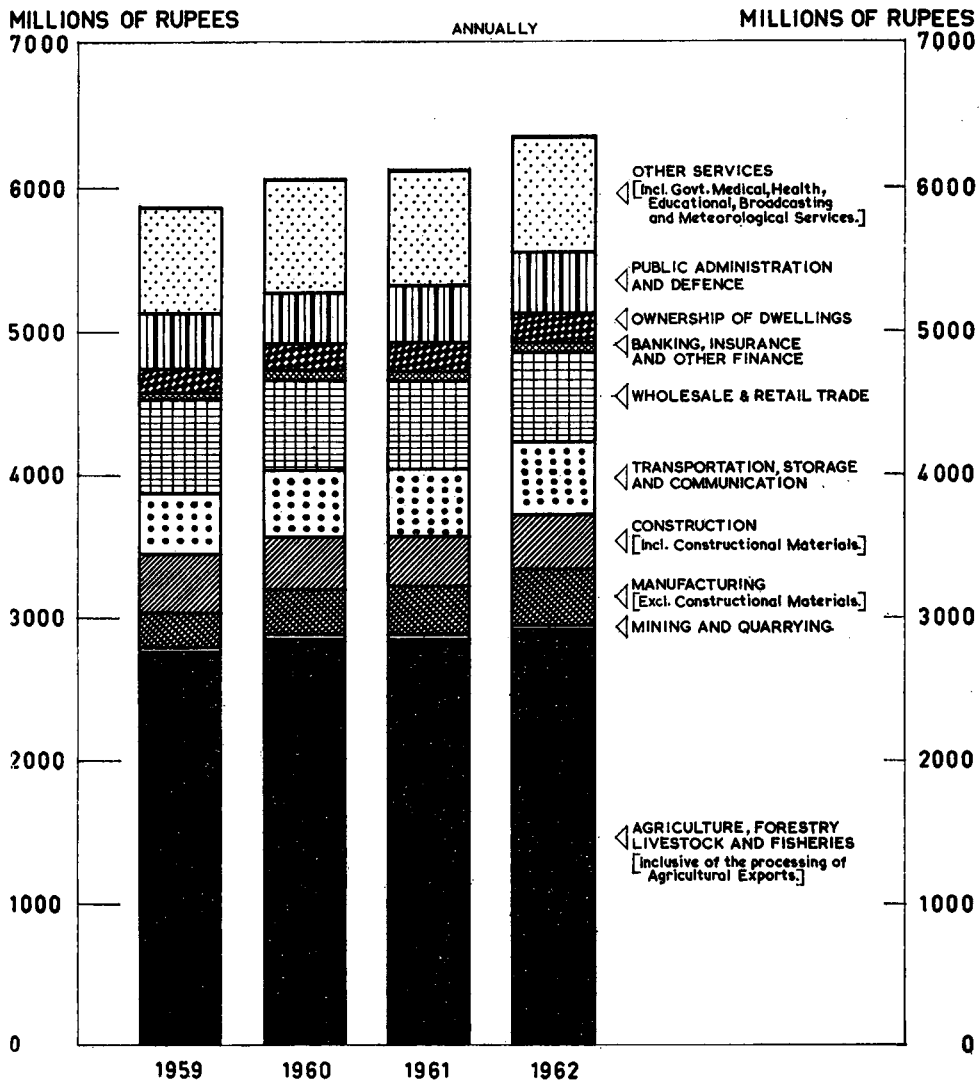

GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT BY INDUSTRIAL ORIGIN AT CURRENT FACTOR COST PRICES

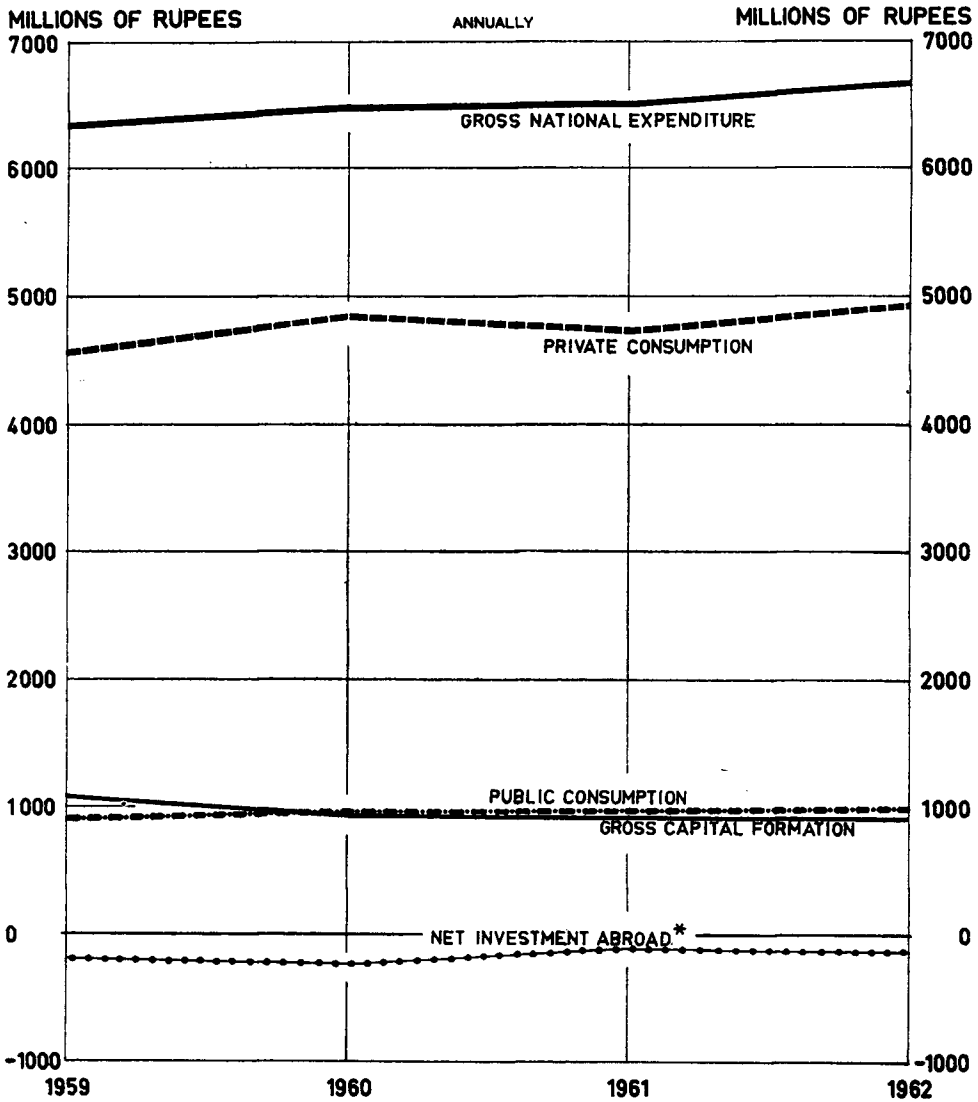

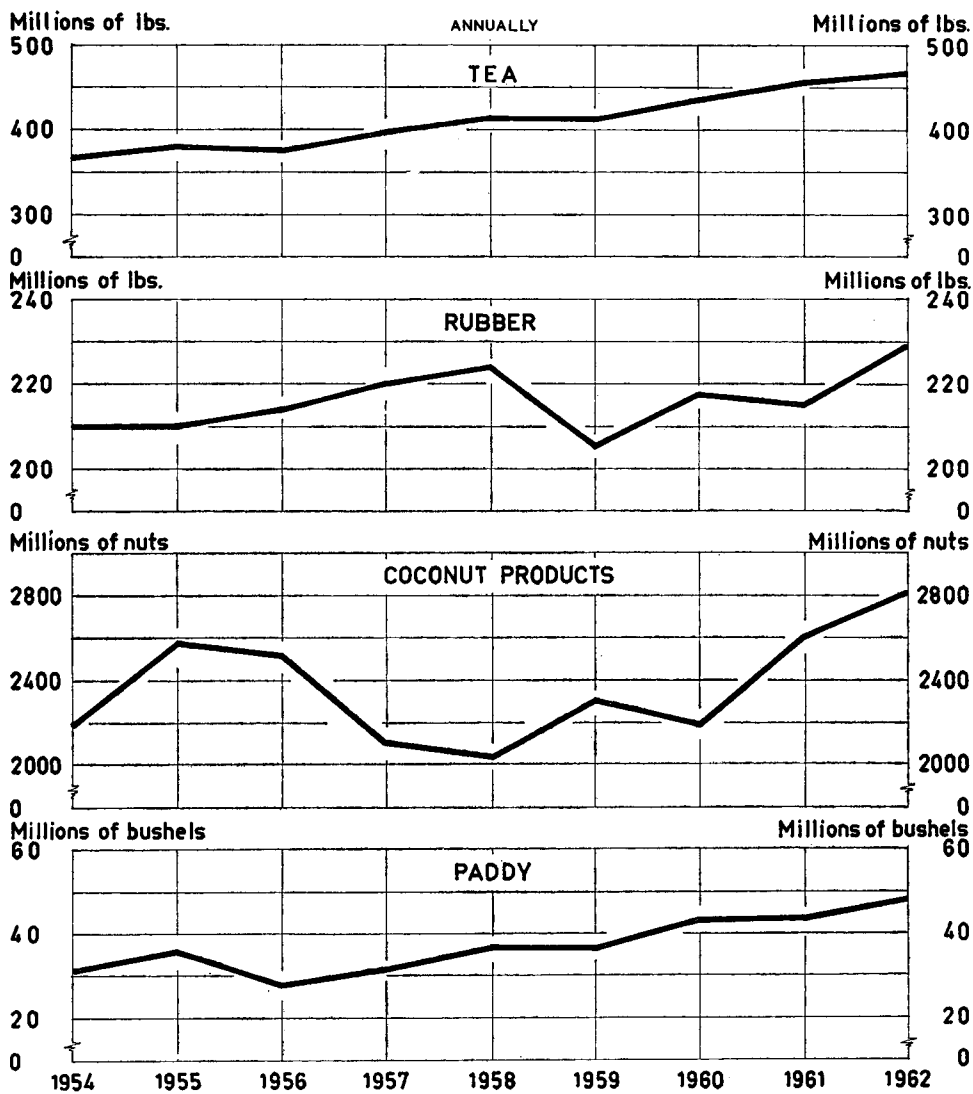
GROSS NATIONAL EXPENDITURE

AT CURRENT MARKET PRICES



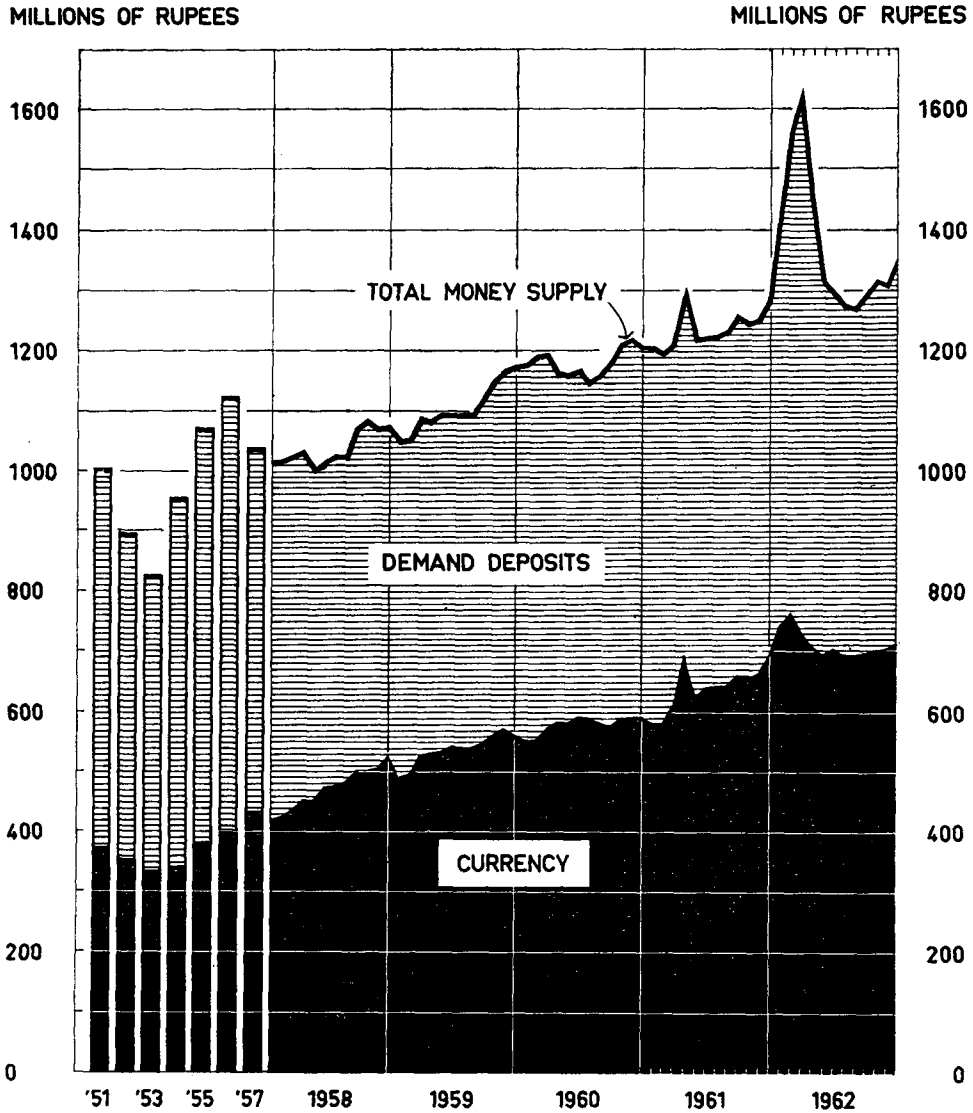

END OF YEAR 1951-1957; END OF MONTH JANUARY 1958-



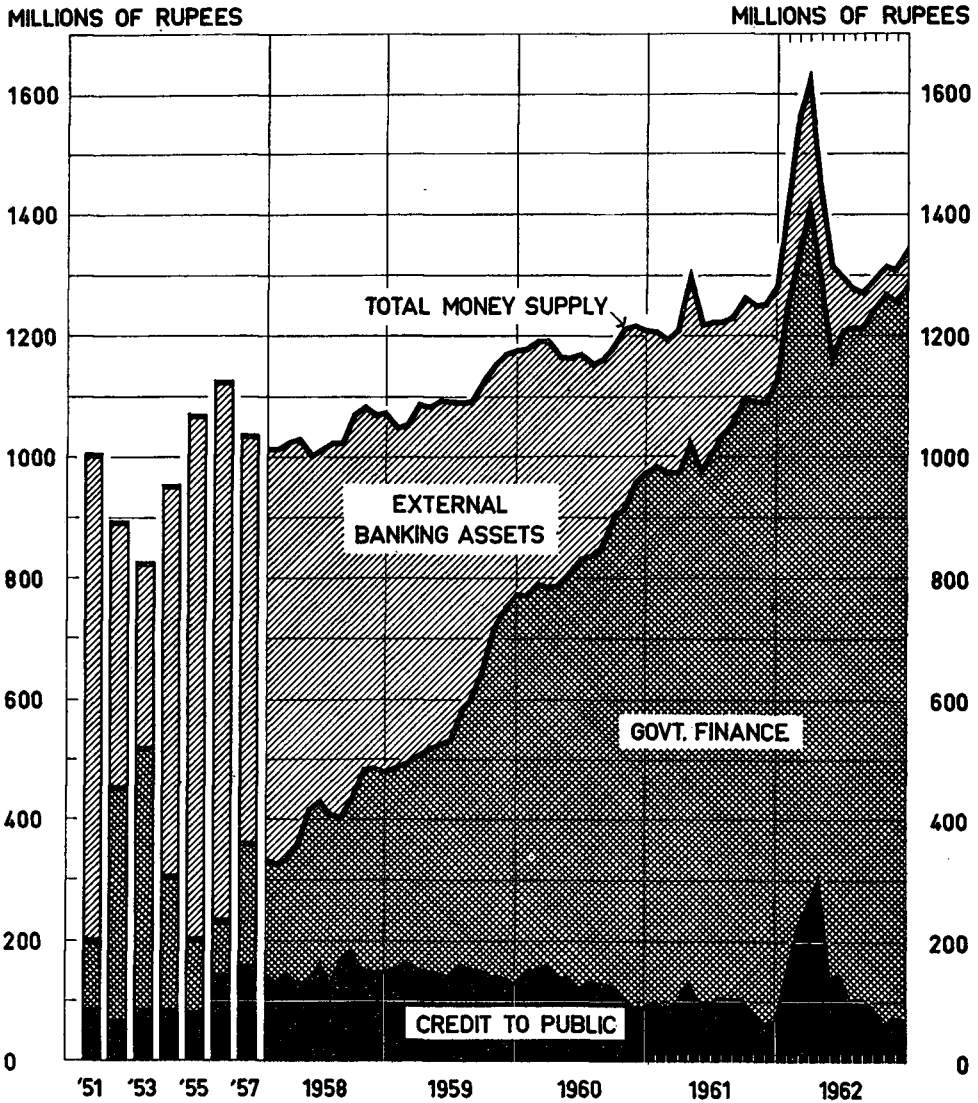

END OF YEAR 1951 - 1957 : END OF MONTH, JANUARY 1958



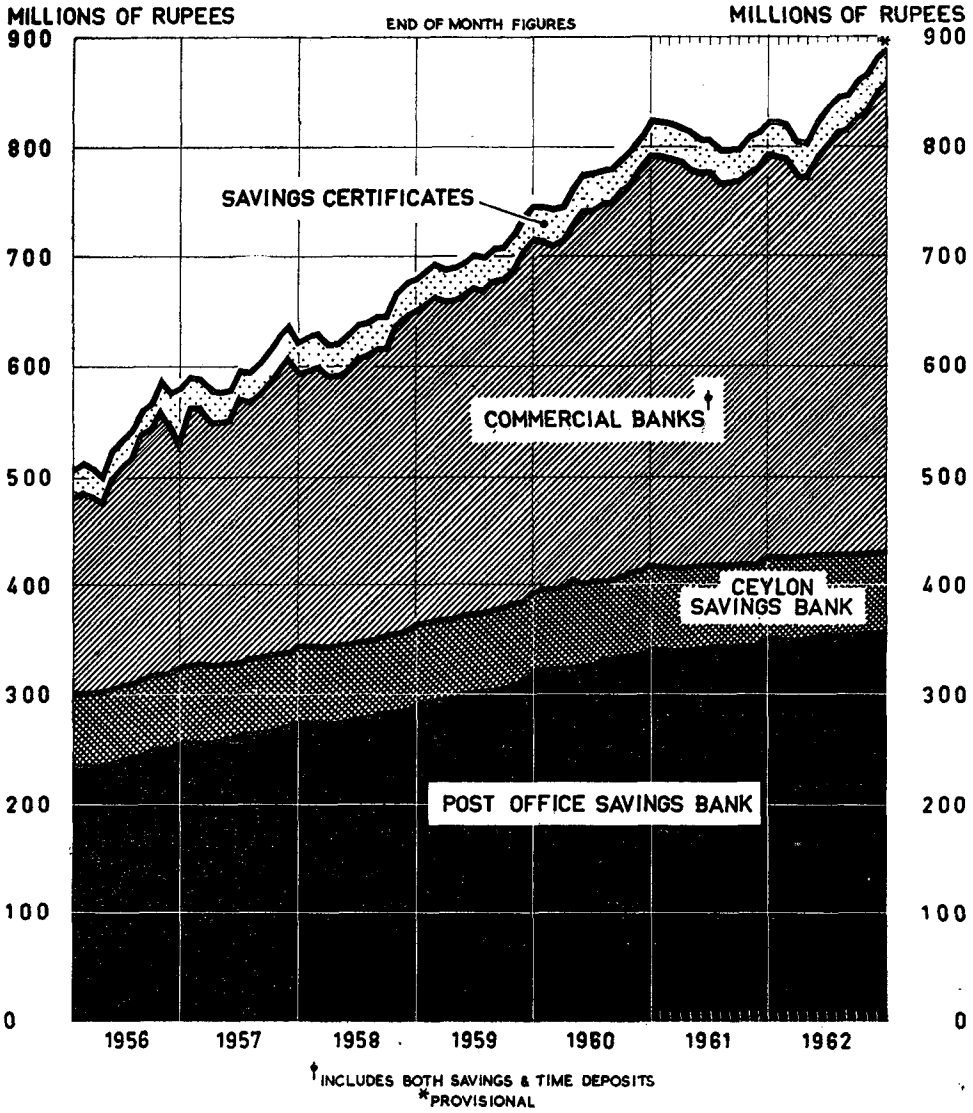

- (b) "Credit to Public"—shows the claims of the banking system on the private sector net of change in Time and Savings deposits.

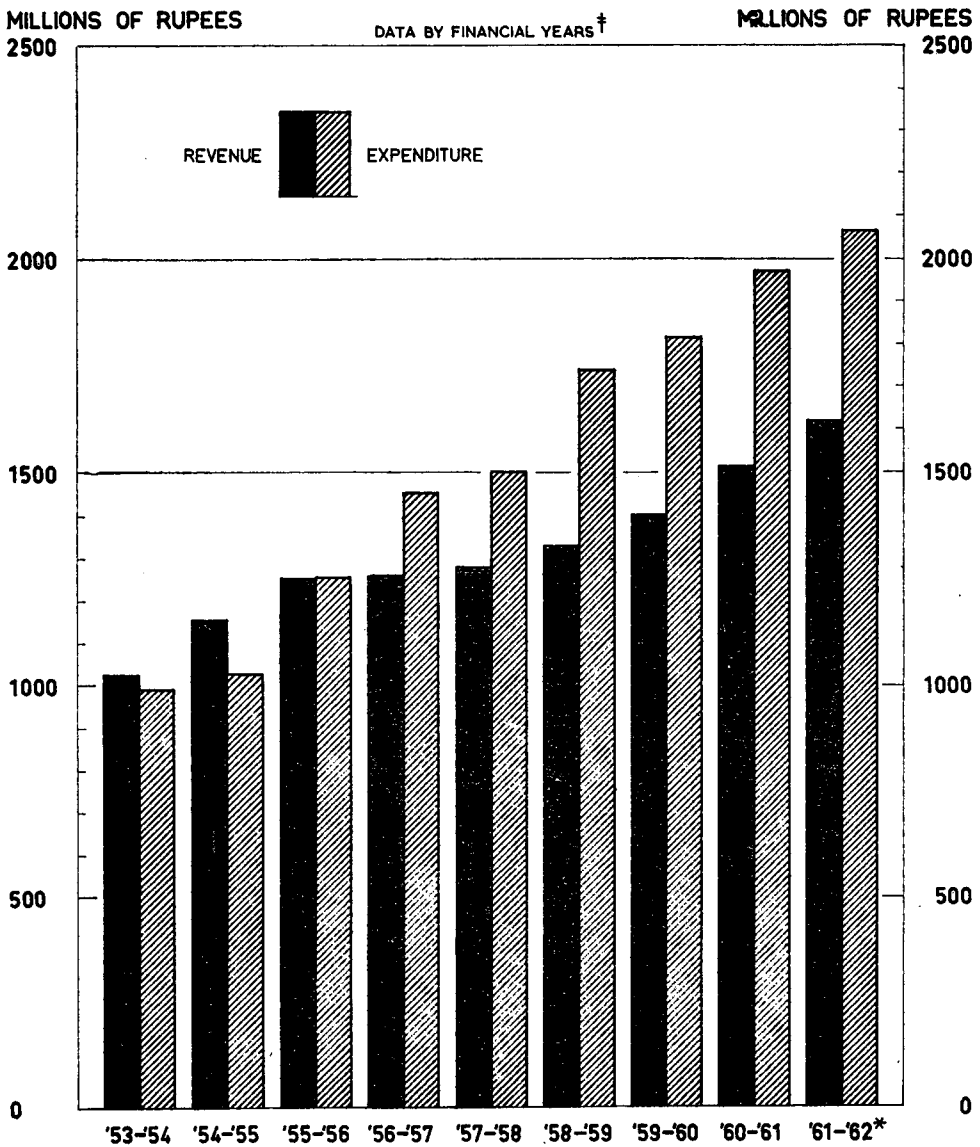
SAVINGS DEPOSITS & SAVINGS CERTIFICATES

GOVERNMENT REVENUE & EXPENDITURE



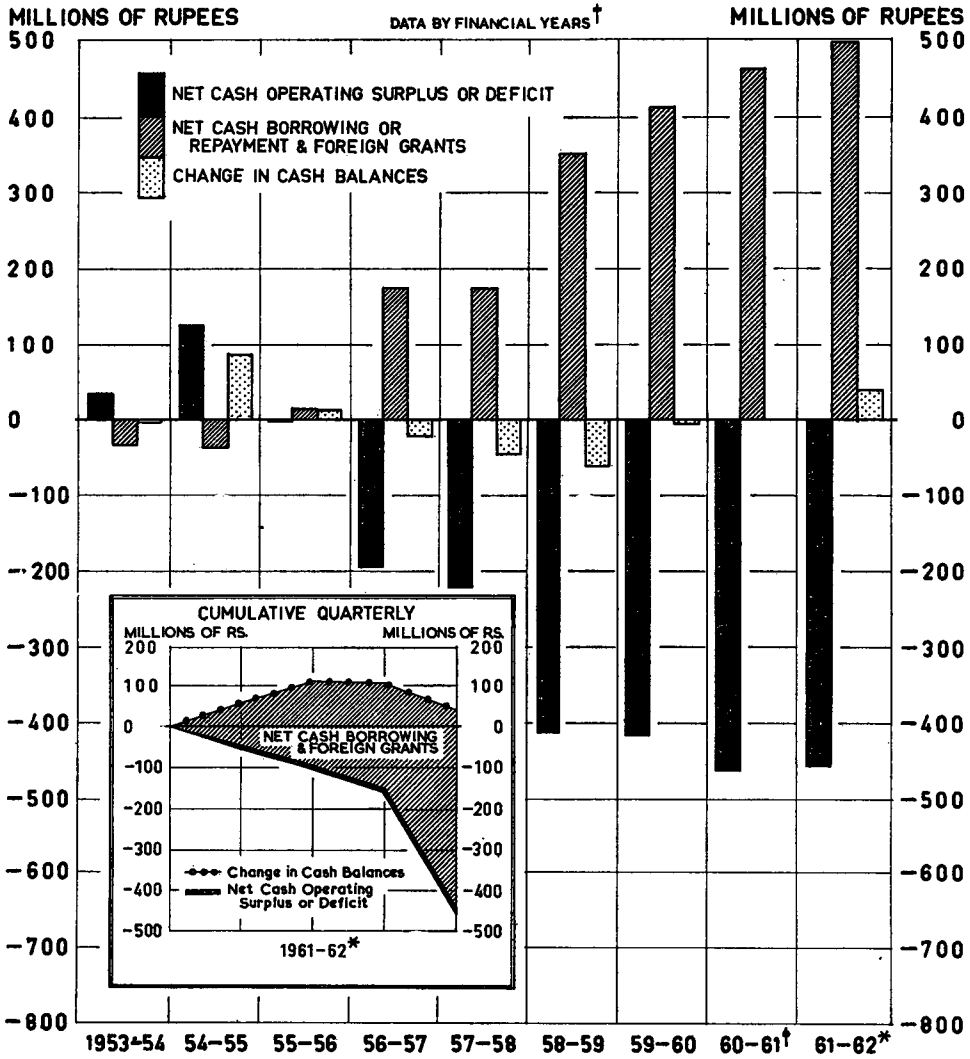

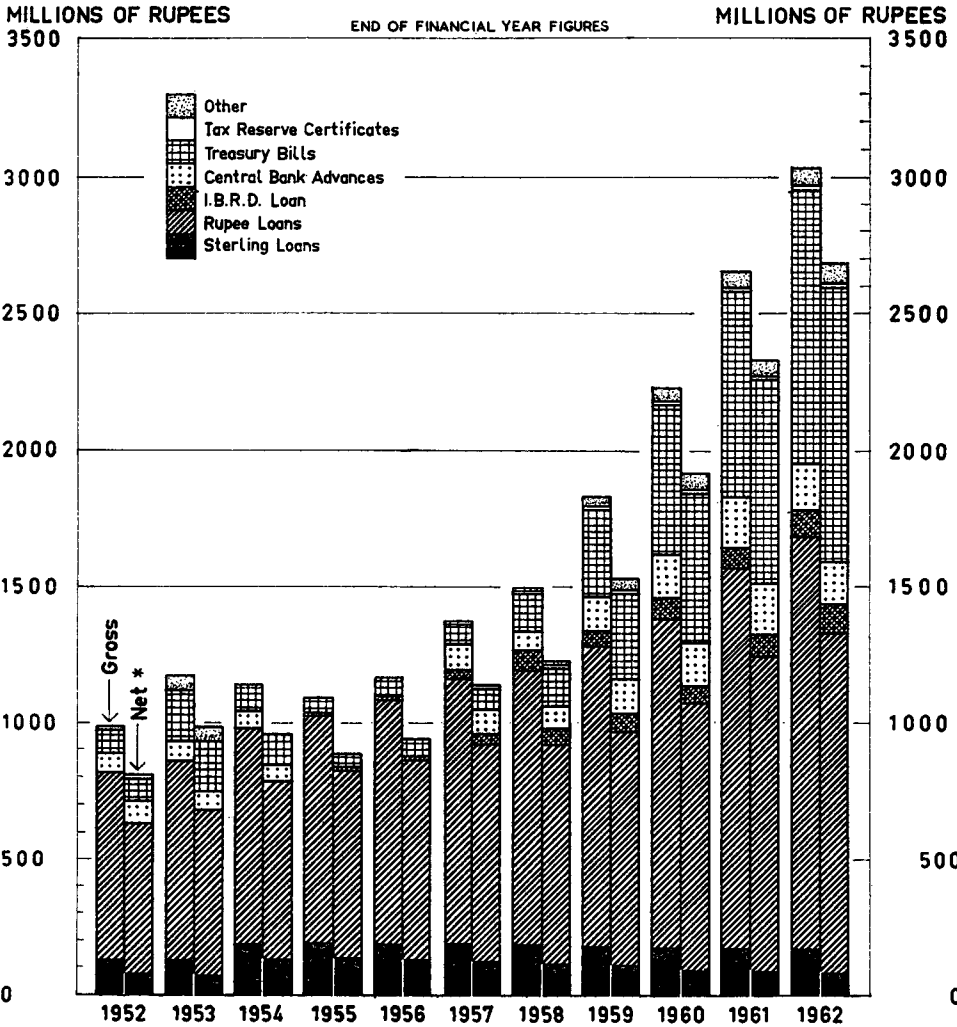
GOVT. NET CASH OPERATING SURPLUS OR DEFICIT

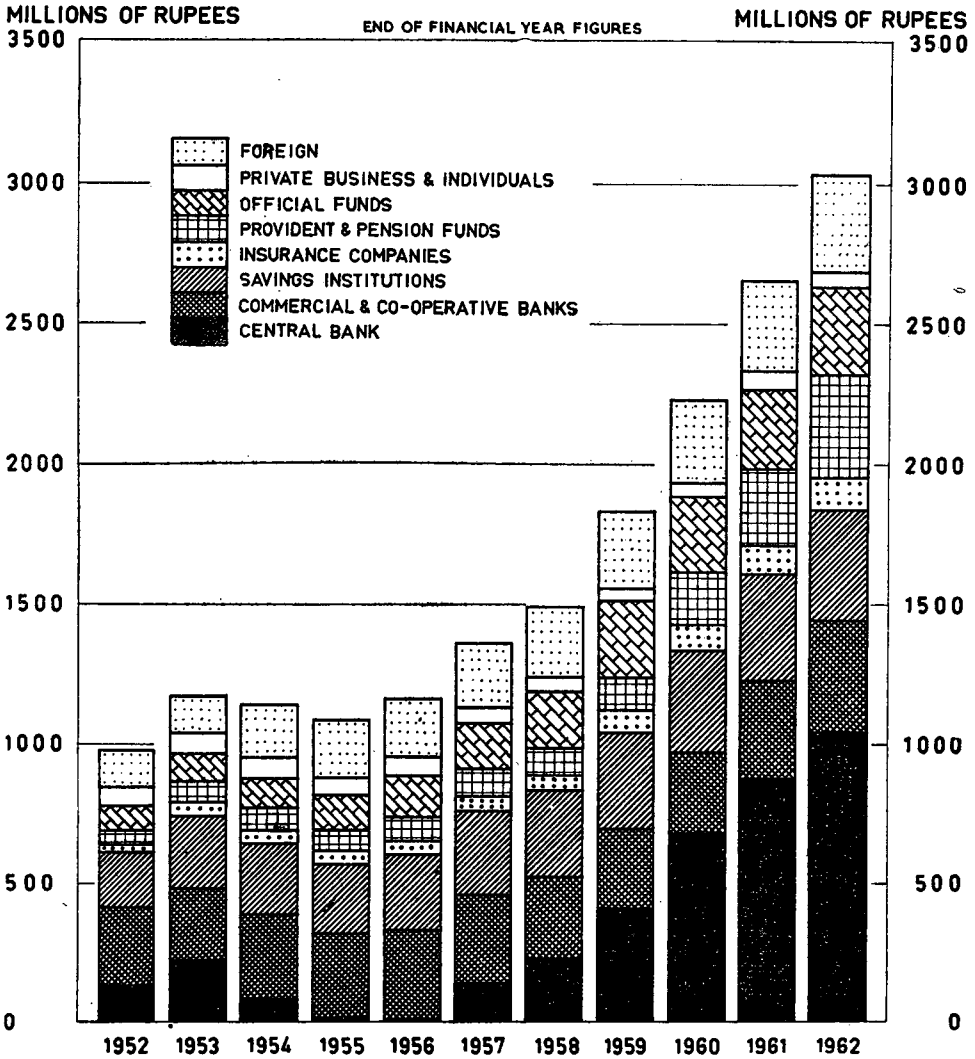

COMPOSITION OF PUBLIC DEBT (SHOWING GROSS & NET* PUBLIC DEBT)

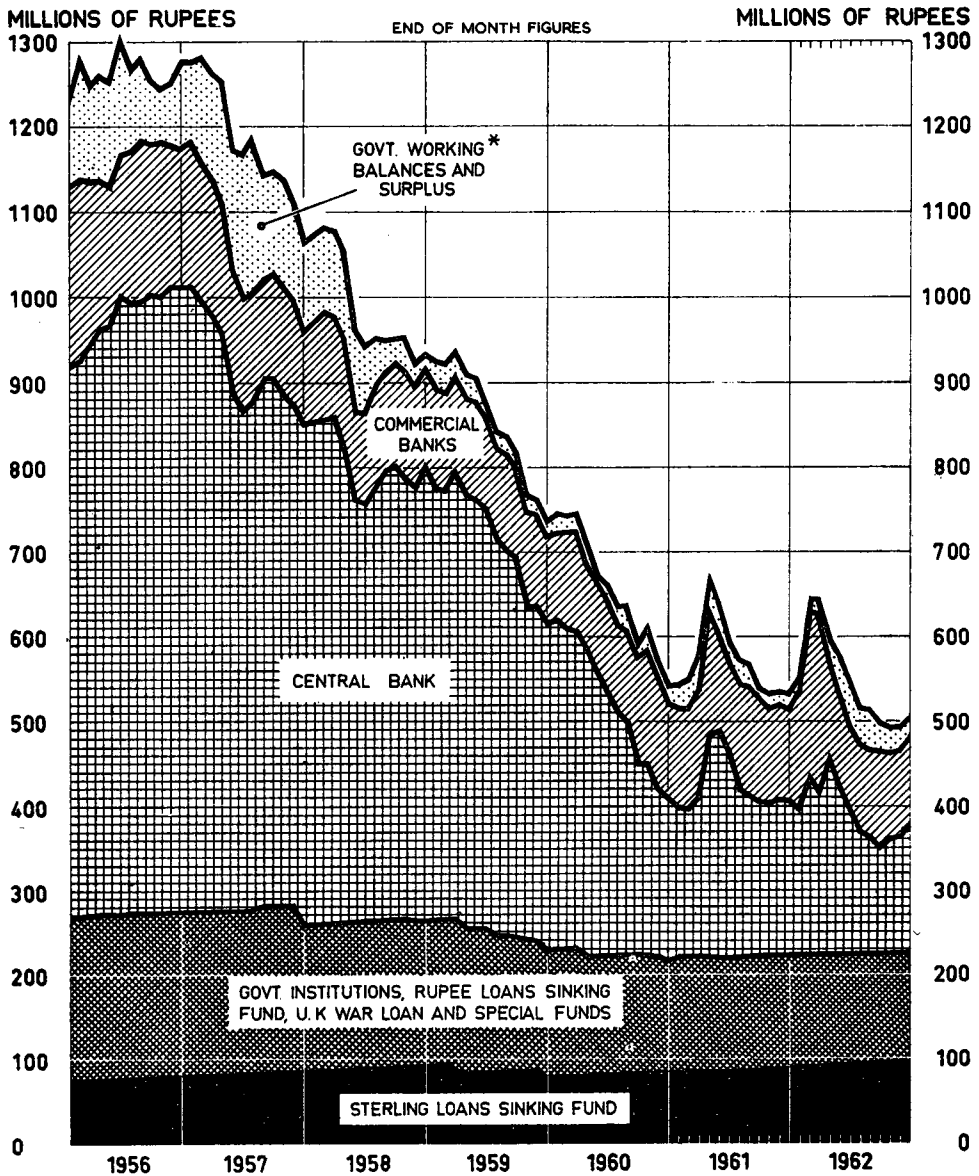


* GROSS PUBLIC DEBT LESS SINKING FUND

OWNERSHIP OF PUBLIC DEBT



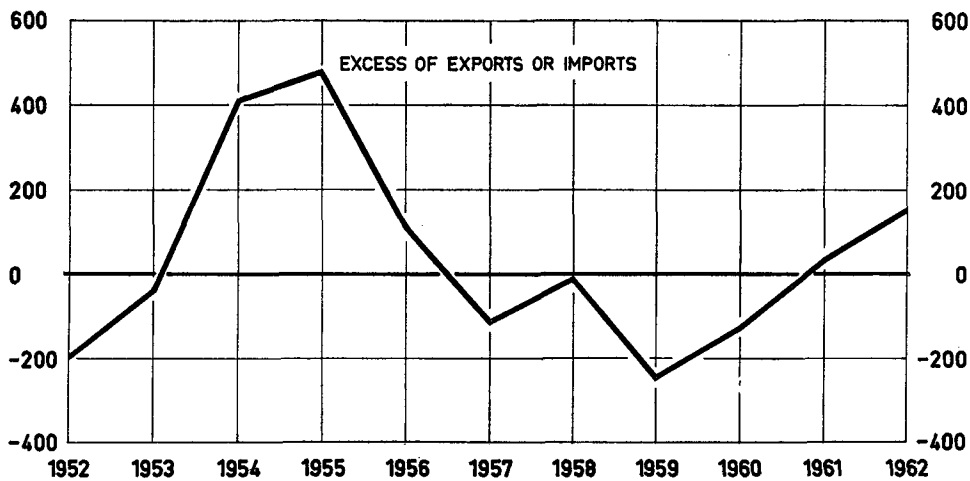
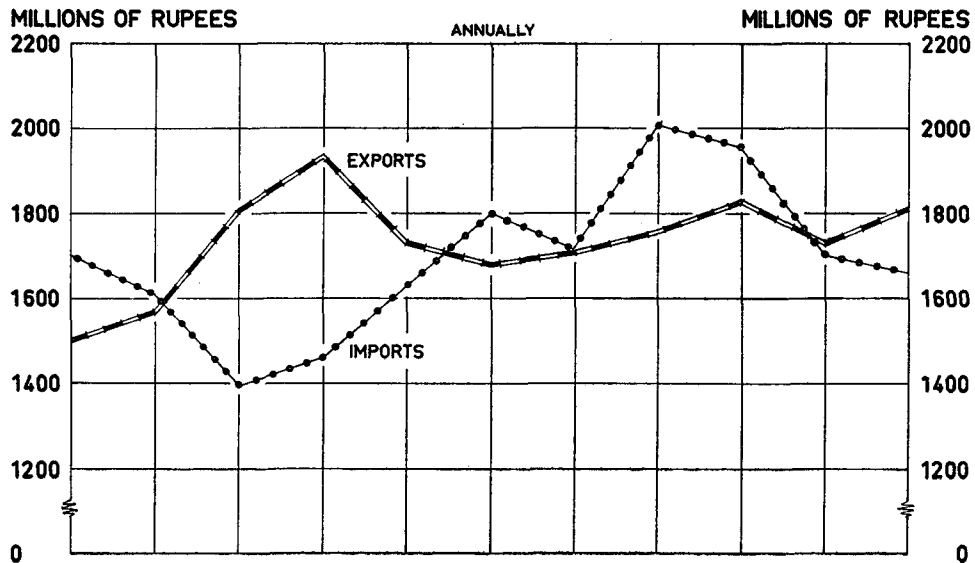
EXTERNAL ASSETS OF CEYLON

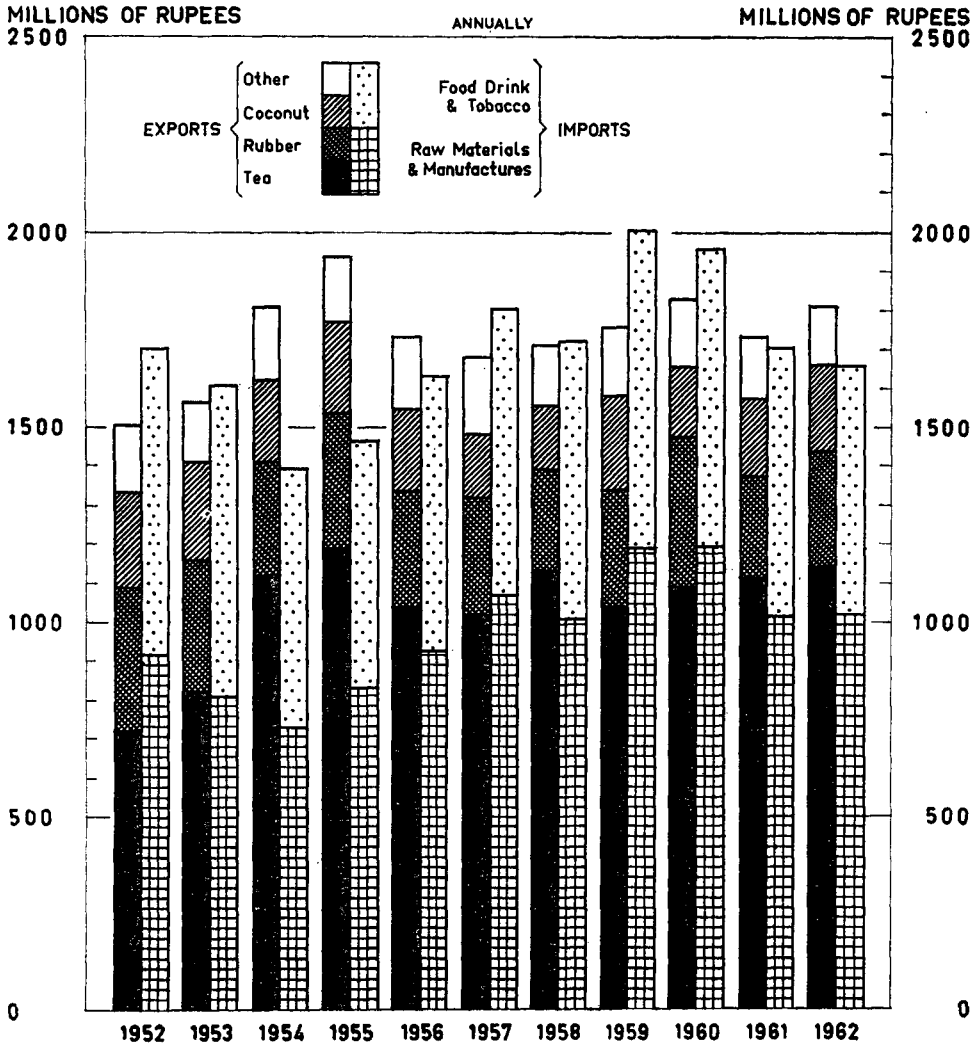
MERCHANDISE EXPORTS & IMPORTS

VALUE OF EXPORTS & IMPORTS BY COMMODITY GROUPS



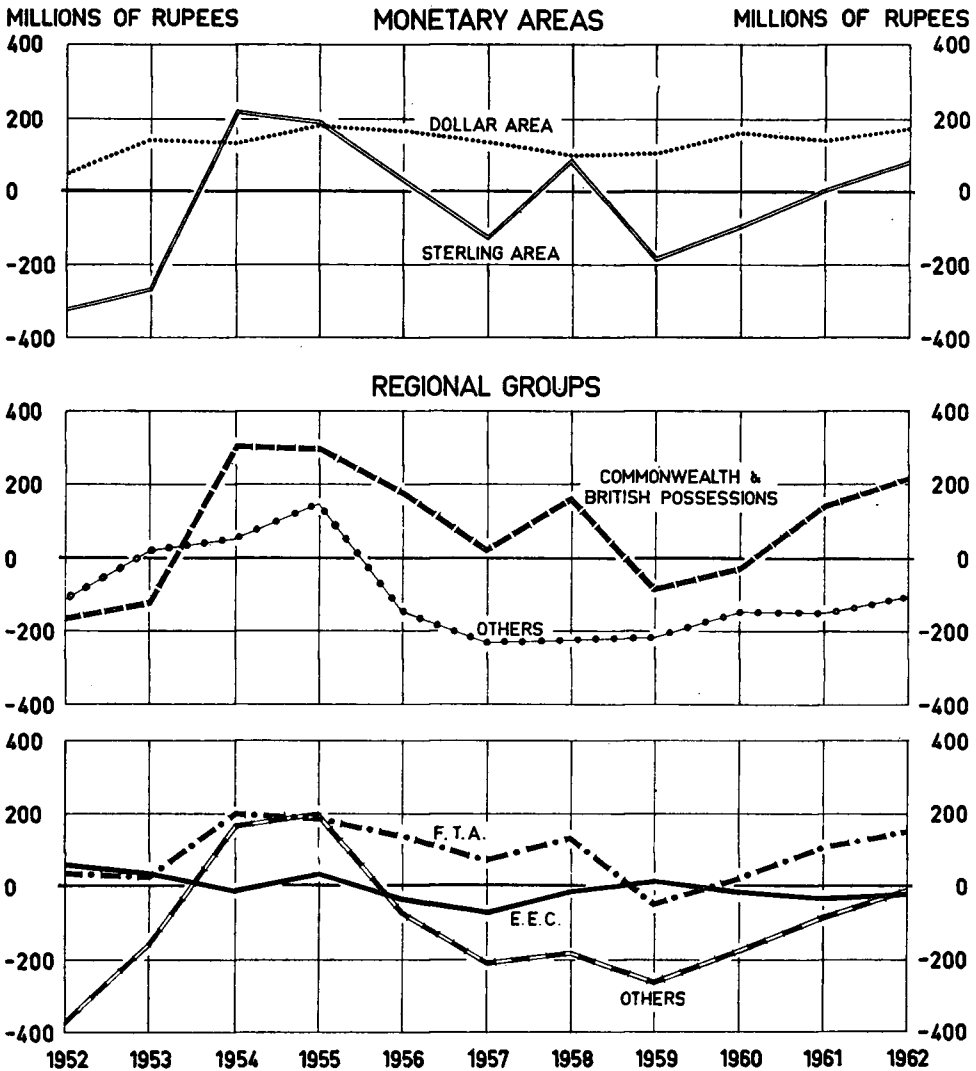

END OF YEAR FIGURES



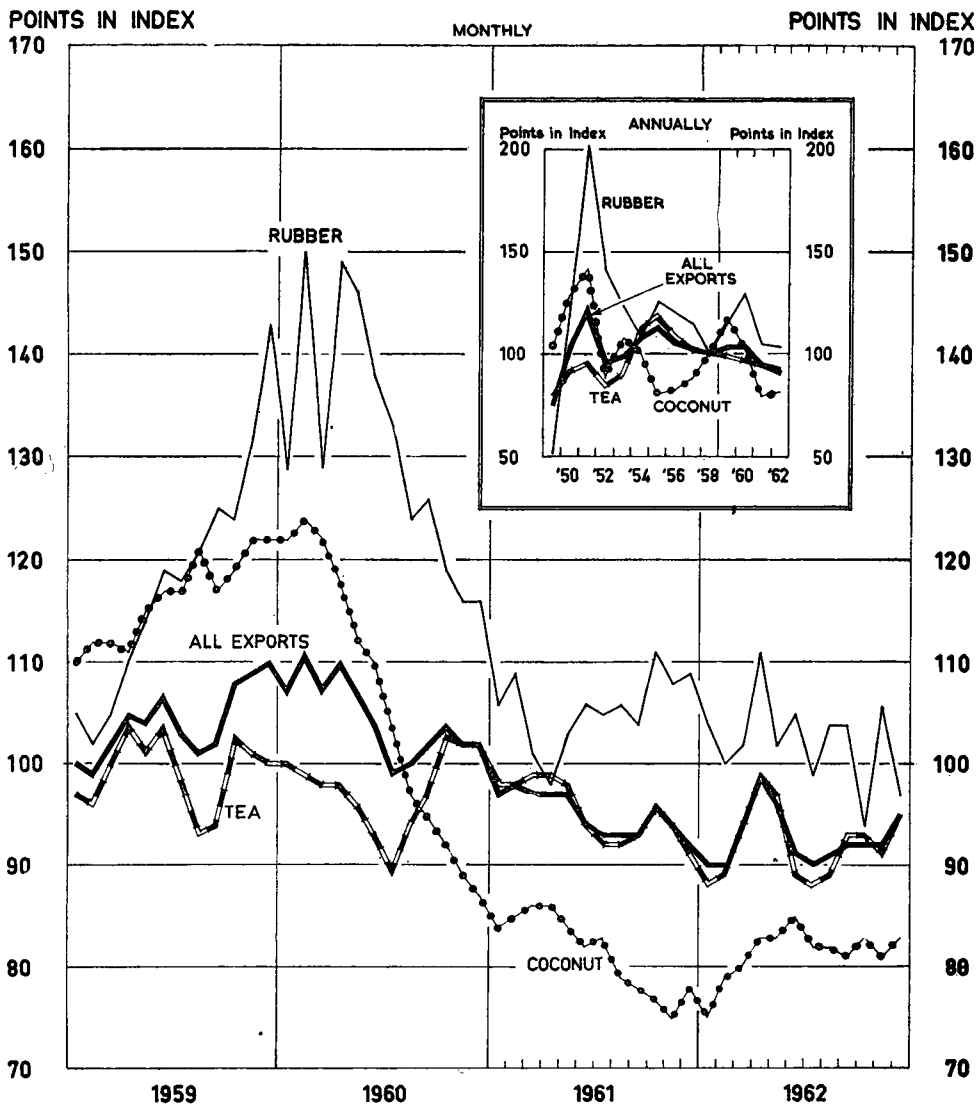

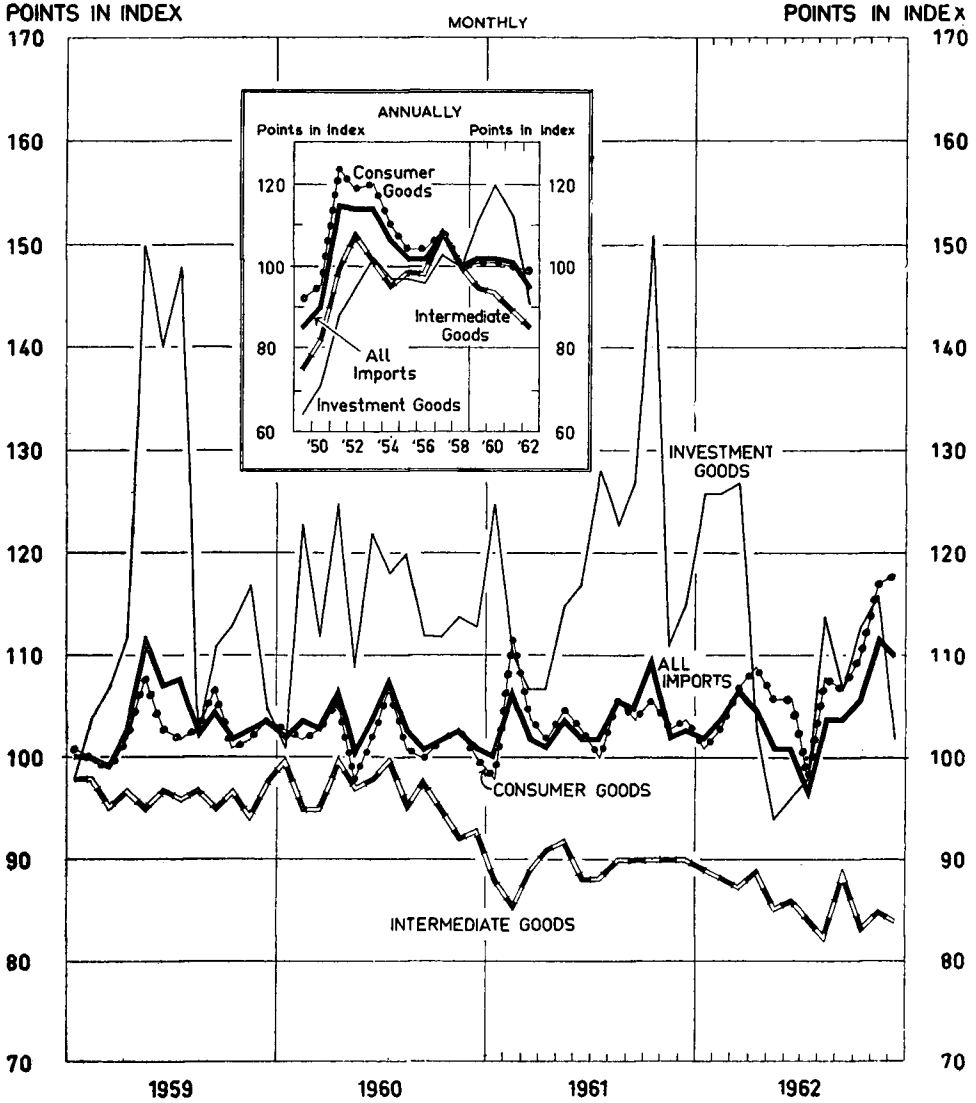
EXPORT PRICES

1958 = 100



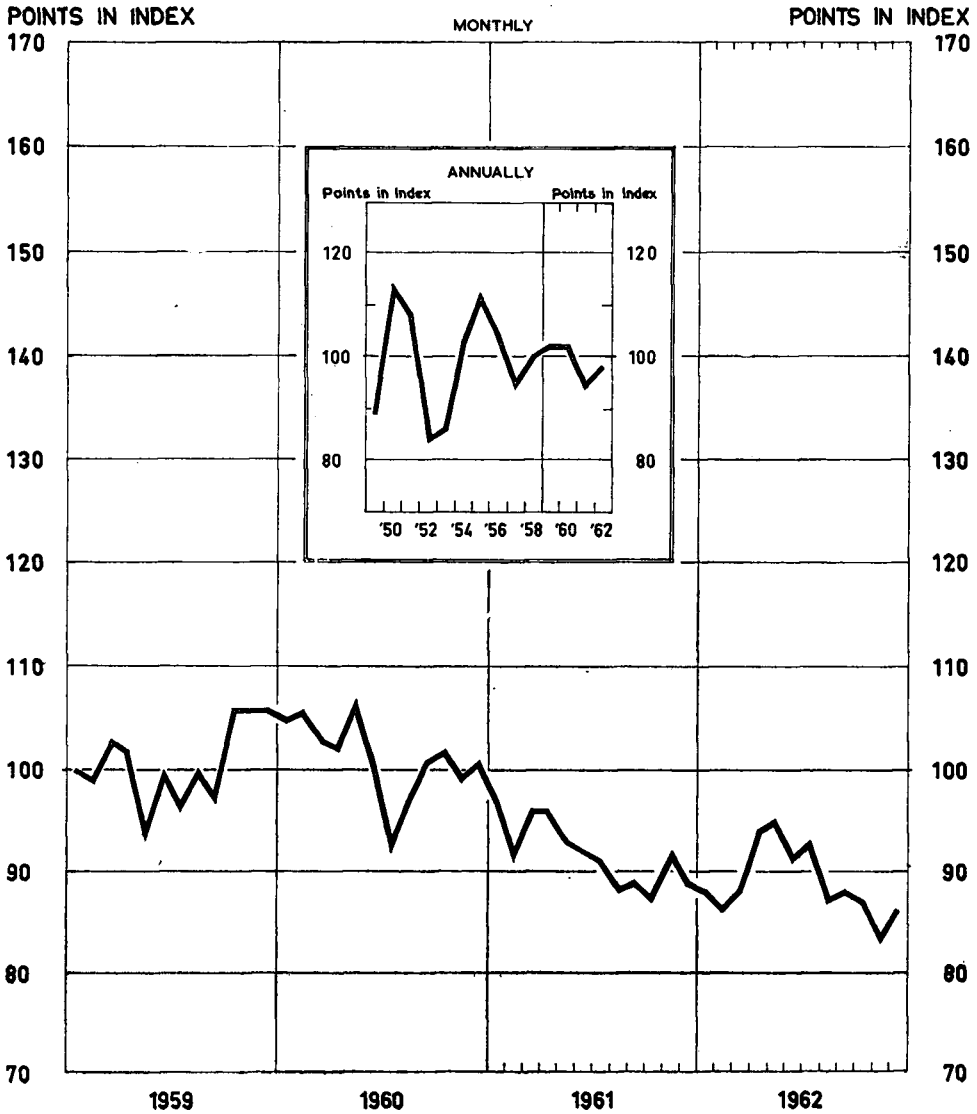
IMPORT PRICES

1958 = 100



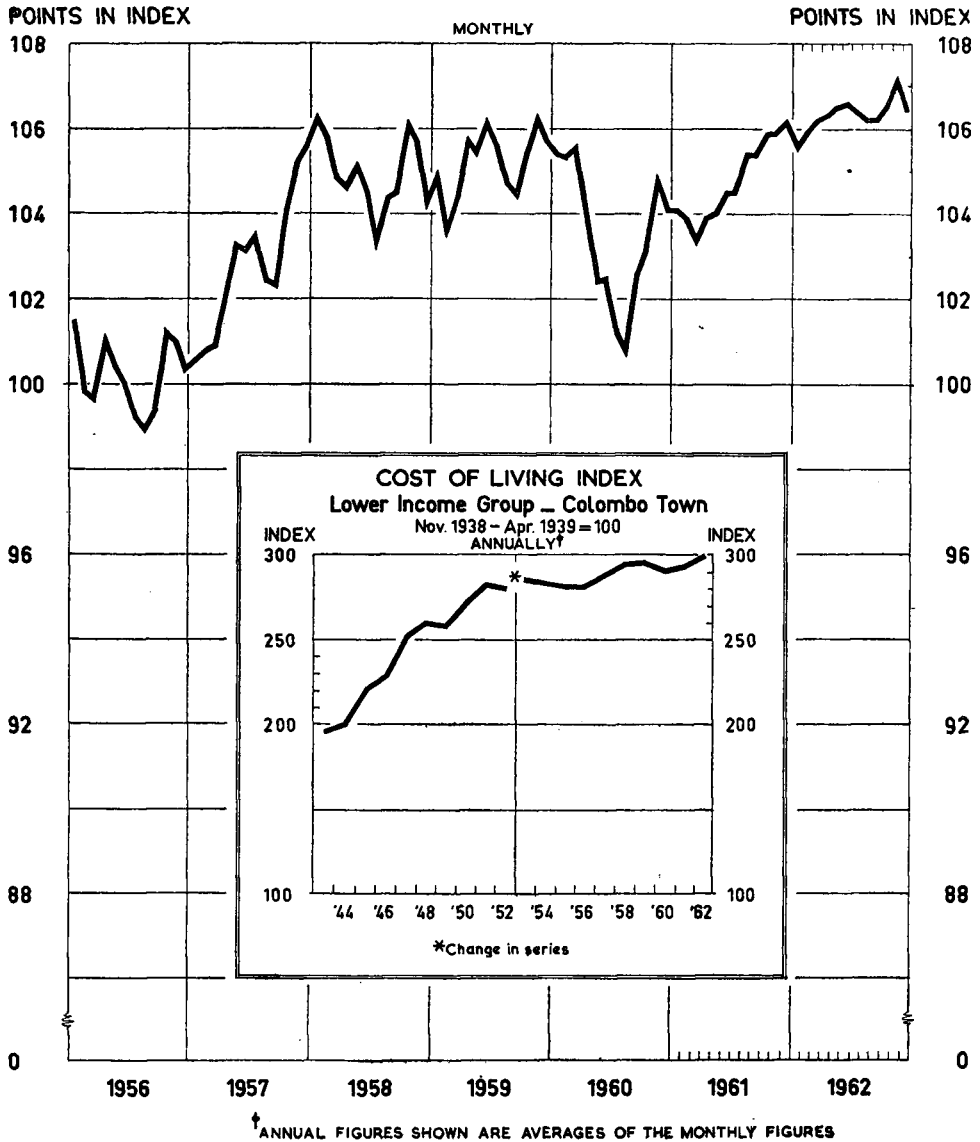

1952 = 100

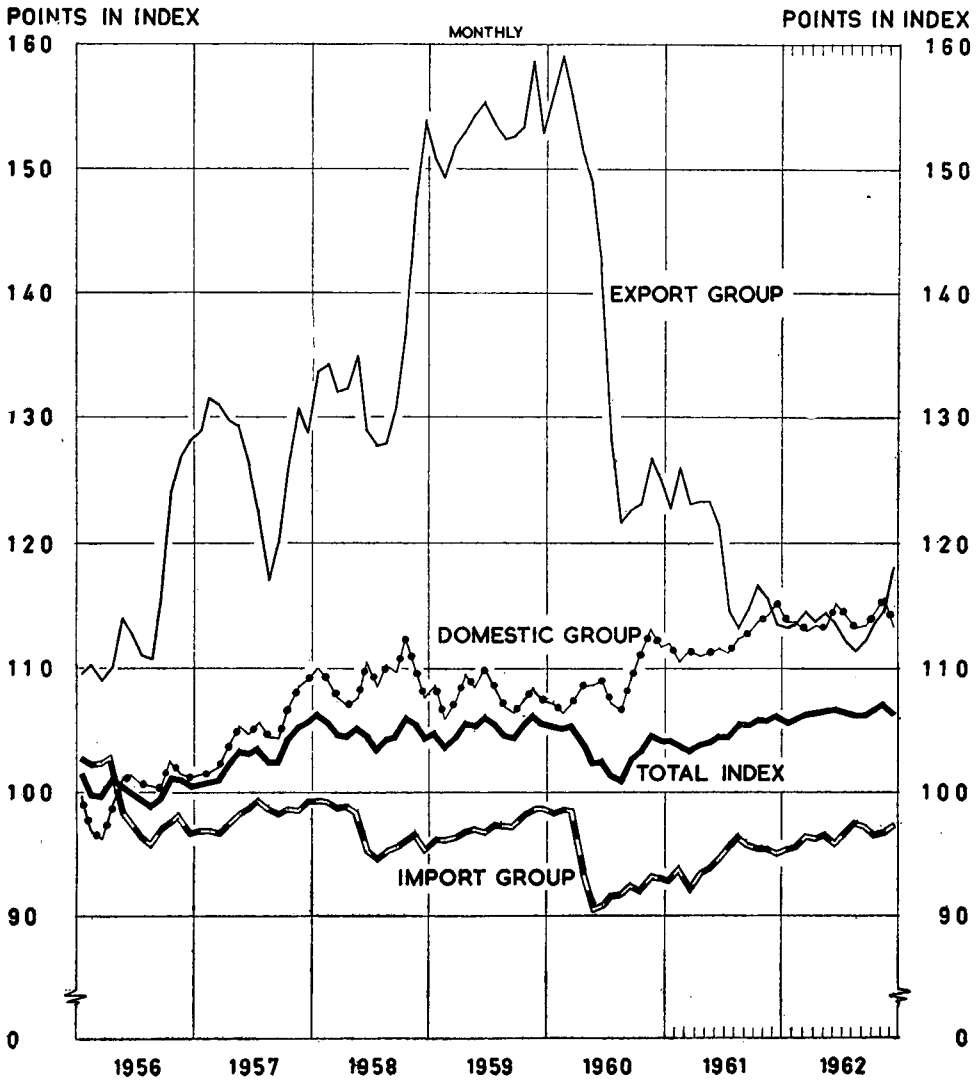

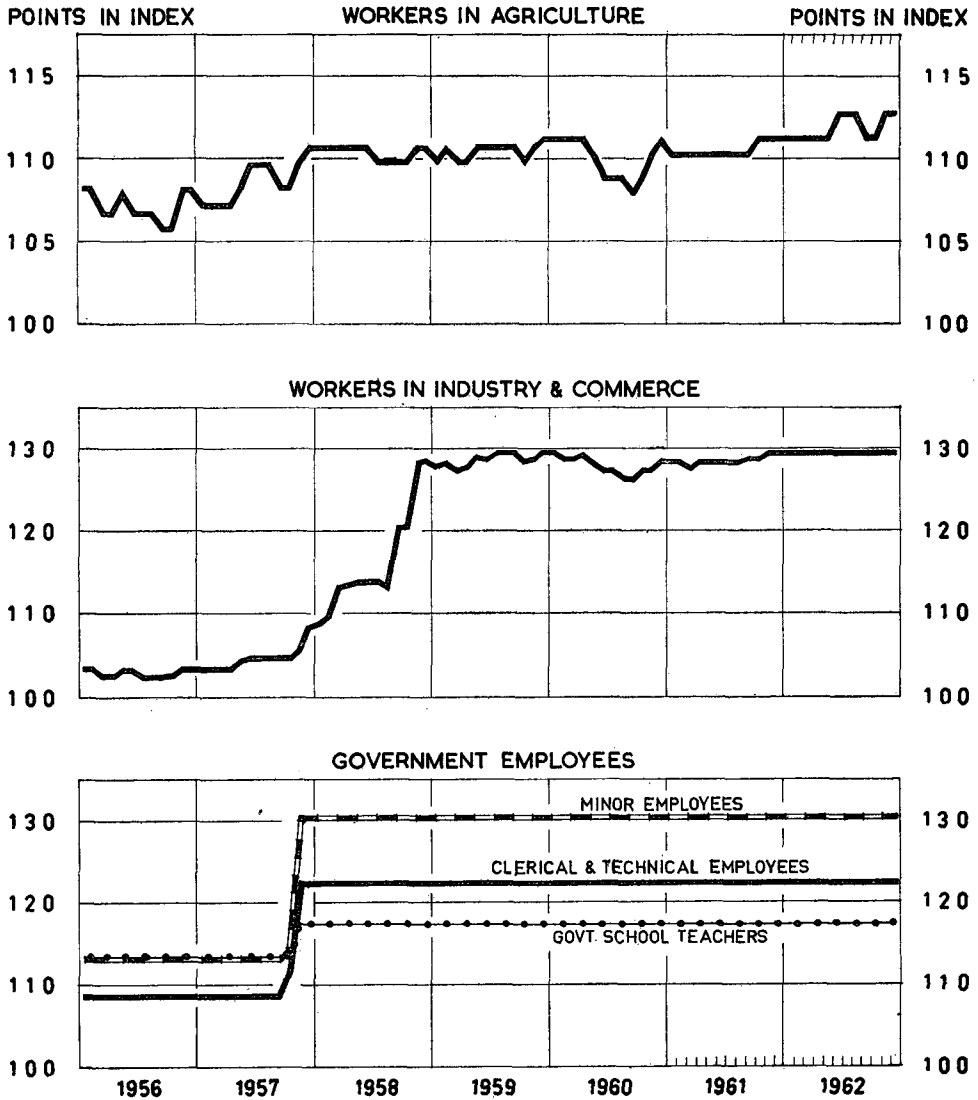

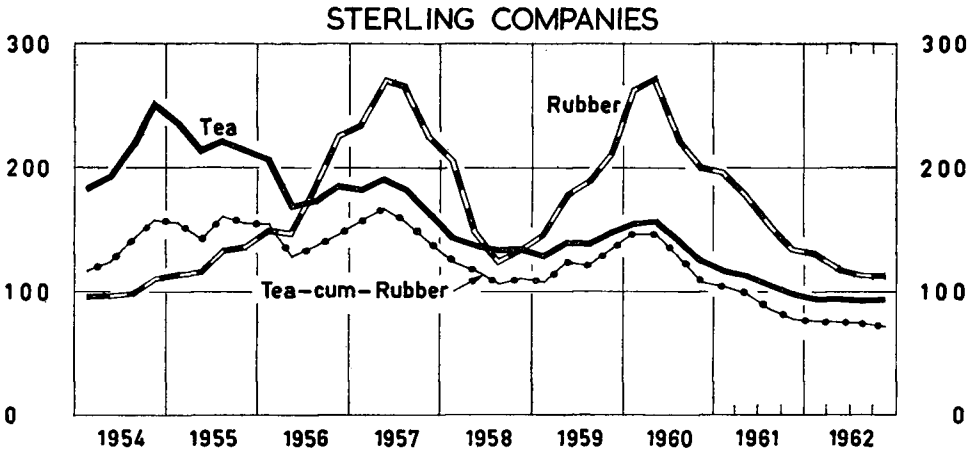
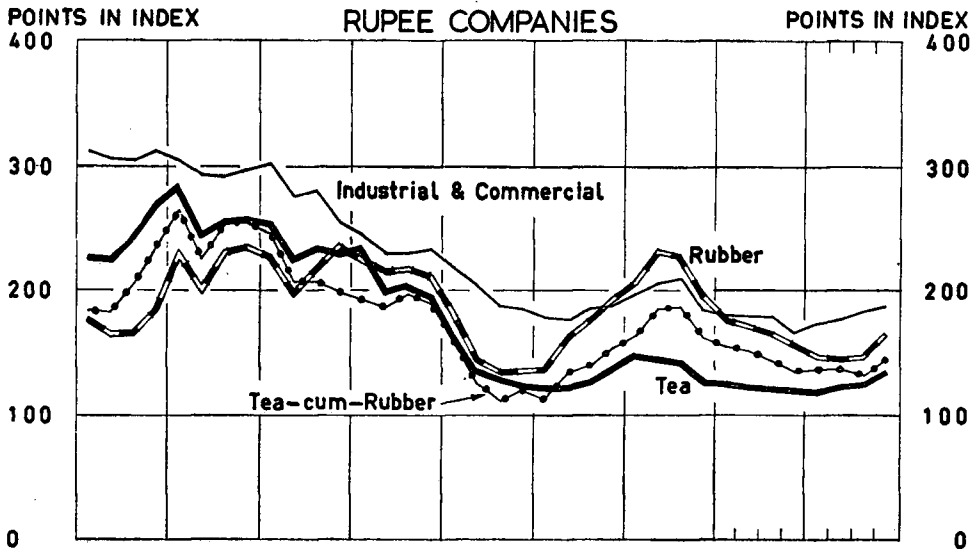
WAGE RATE INDEX NUMBERS
