THIS, THE FIFTEENTH ANNUAL REPORT OF THE MONETARY BOARD OF THE CENTRAL BANK OF CEYLON, IS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 35 OF THE MONETARY LAW ACT NO. 58 OF 1949.

THE BANK'S FINANCIAL YEAR IS THE CALENDAR YEAR. THE FOLLOWING REPORT IS CONCERNED PRIMARILY WITH THE YEAR 1964.
