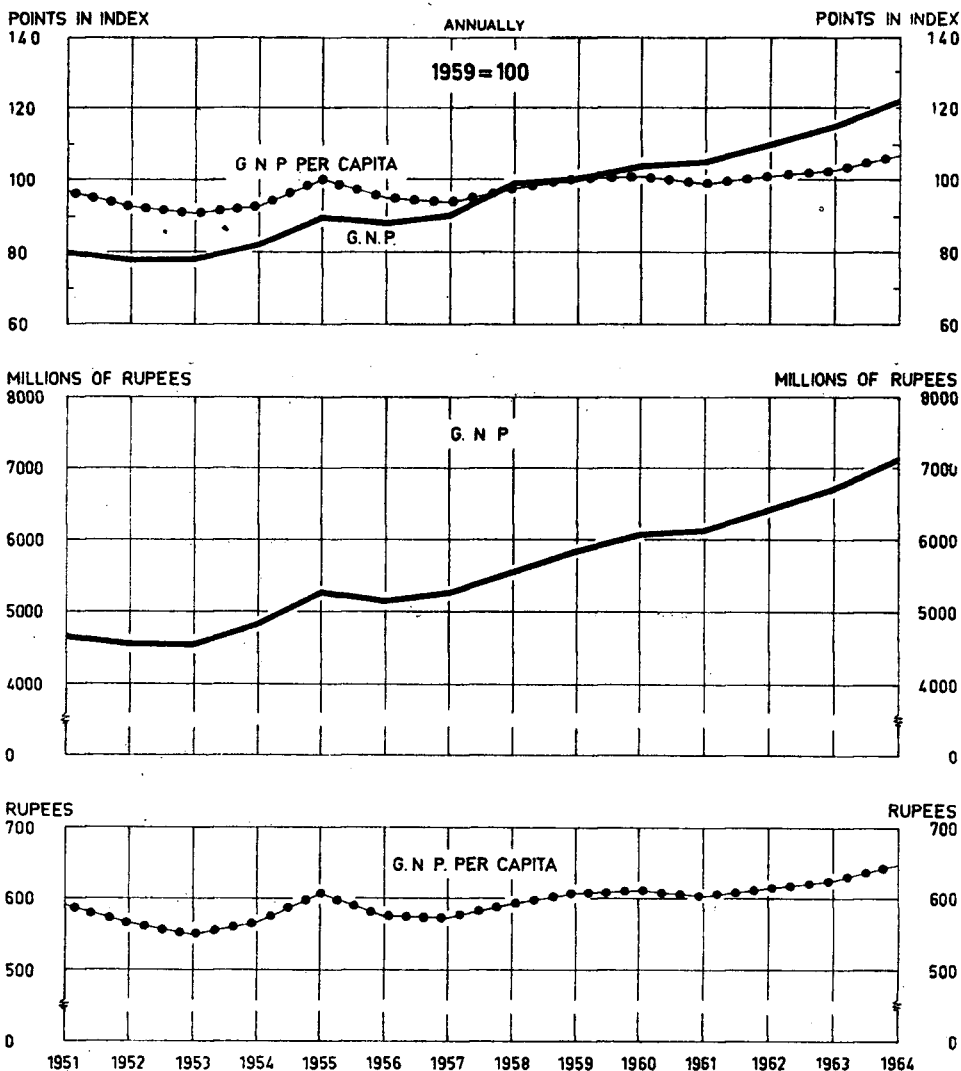

# GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT AT CURRENT FACTOR COST PRICES



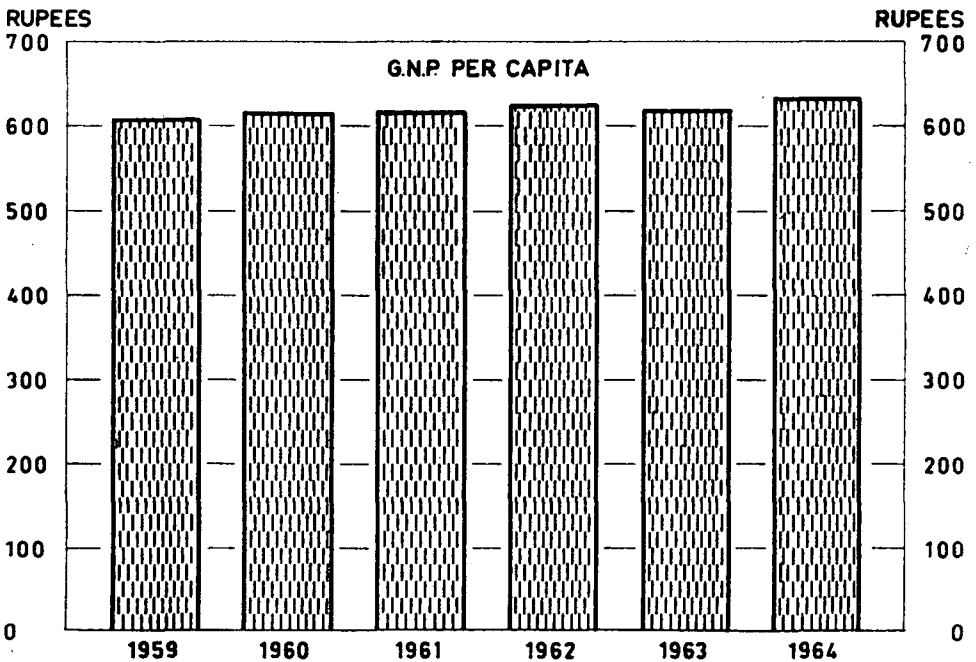
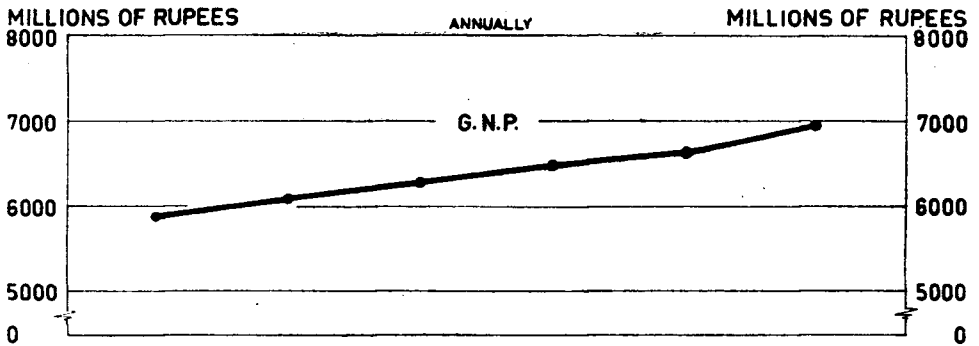

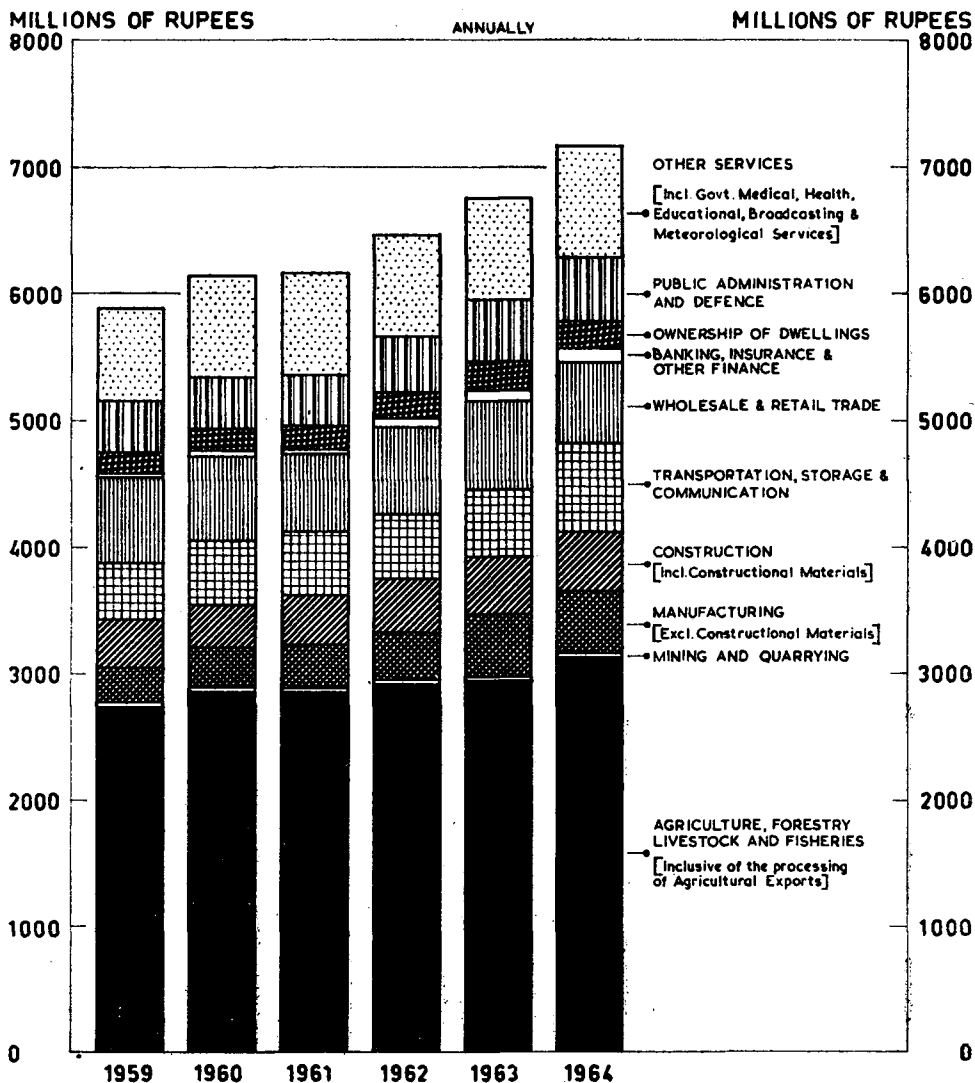

# GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT

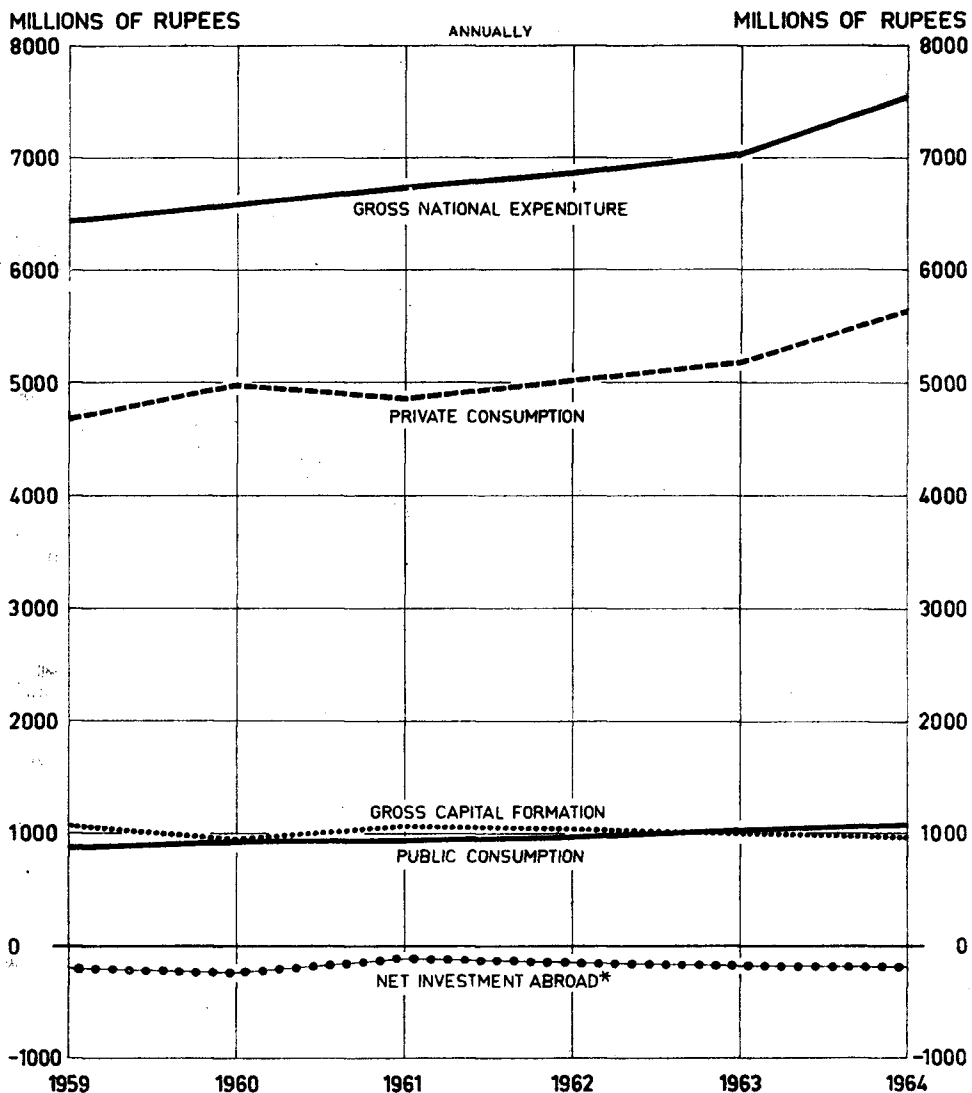
AT CONSTANT (1959) FACTOR COST PRICES



## GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT BY INDUSTRIAL ORIGIN AT CURRENT FACTOR COST PRICES

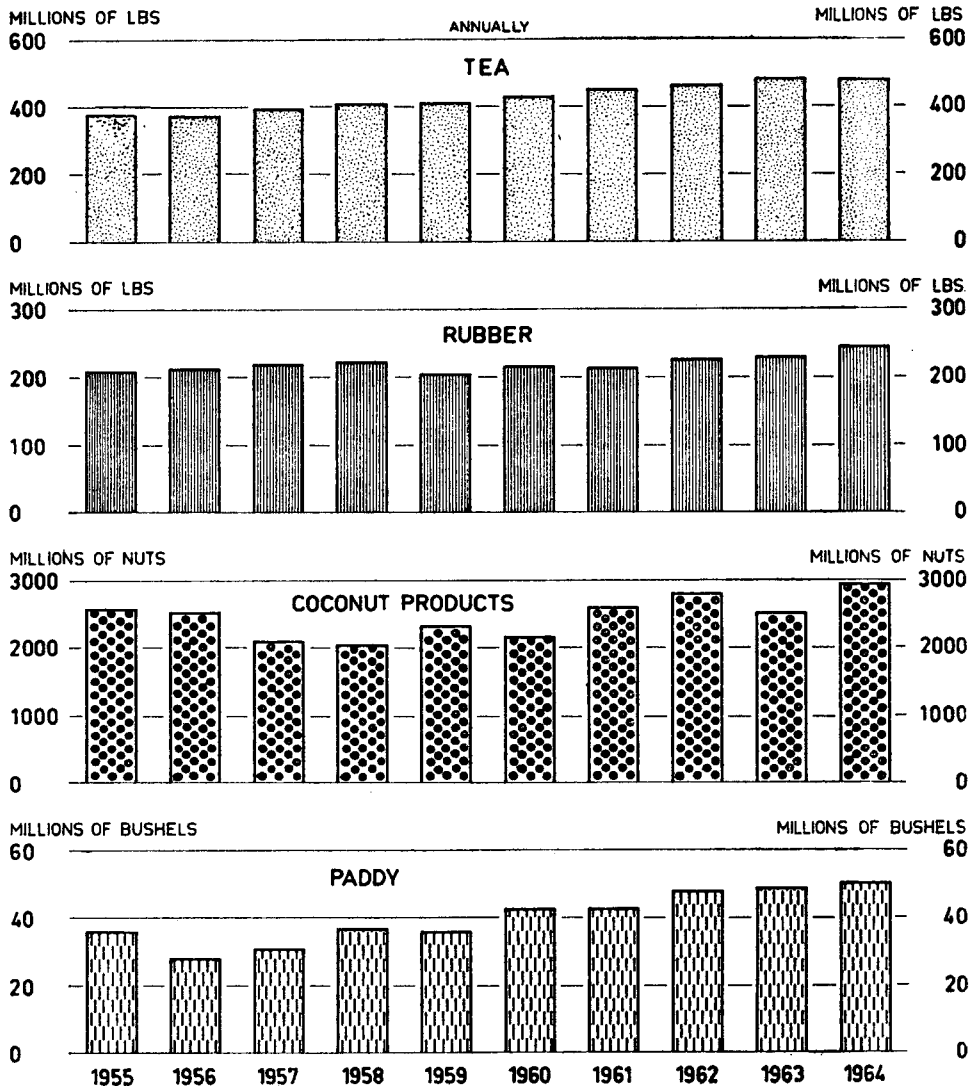


# GROSS NATIONAL EXPENDITURE AT CURRENT MARKET PRICES



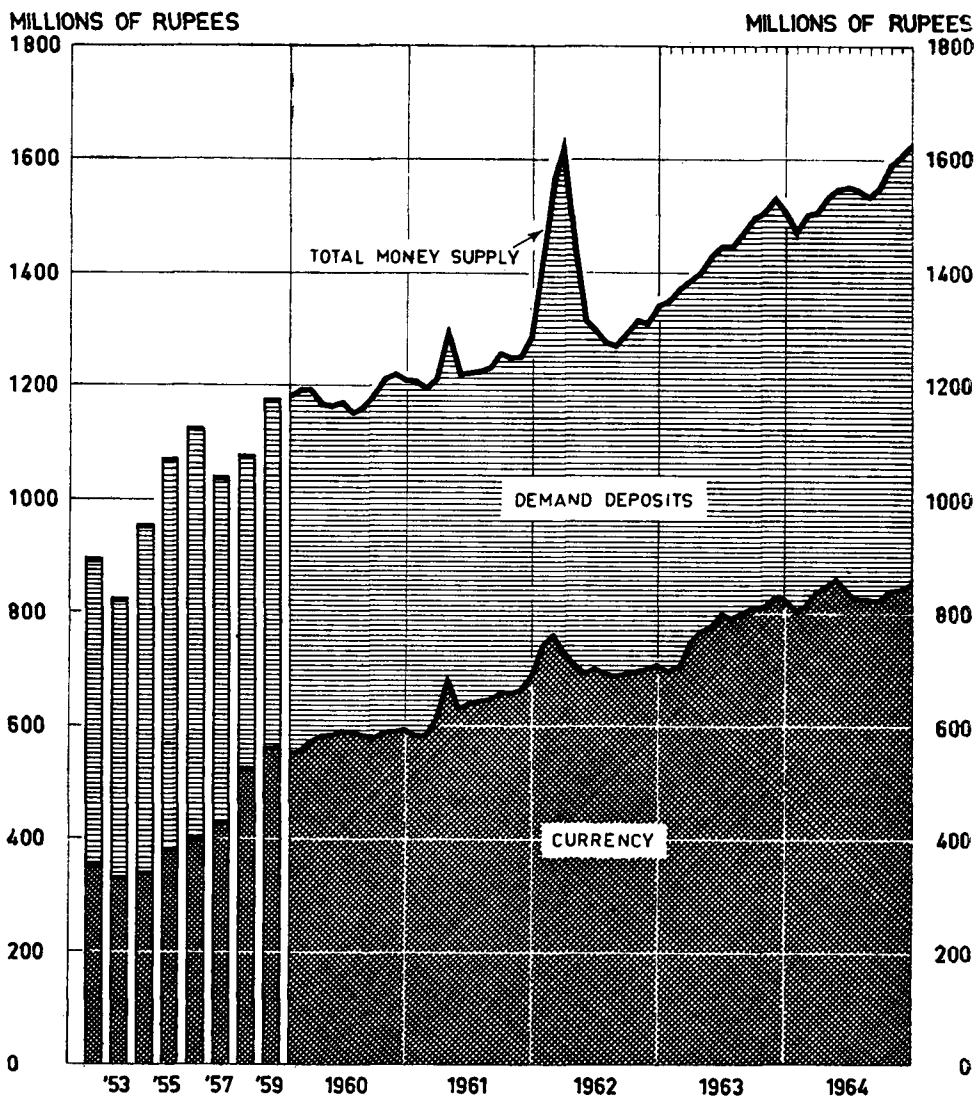

END OF YEAR 1952-1959; END OF MONTH JANUARY 1960



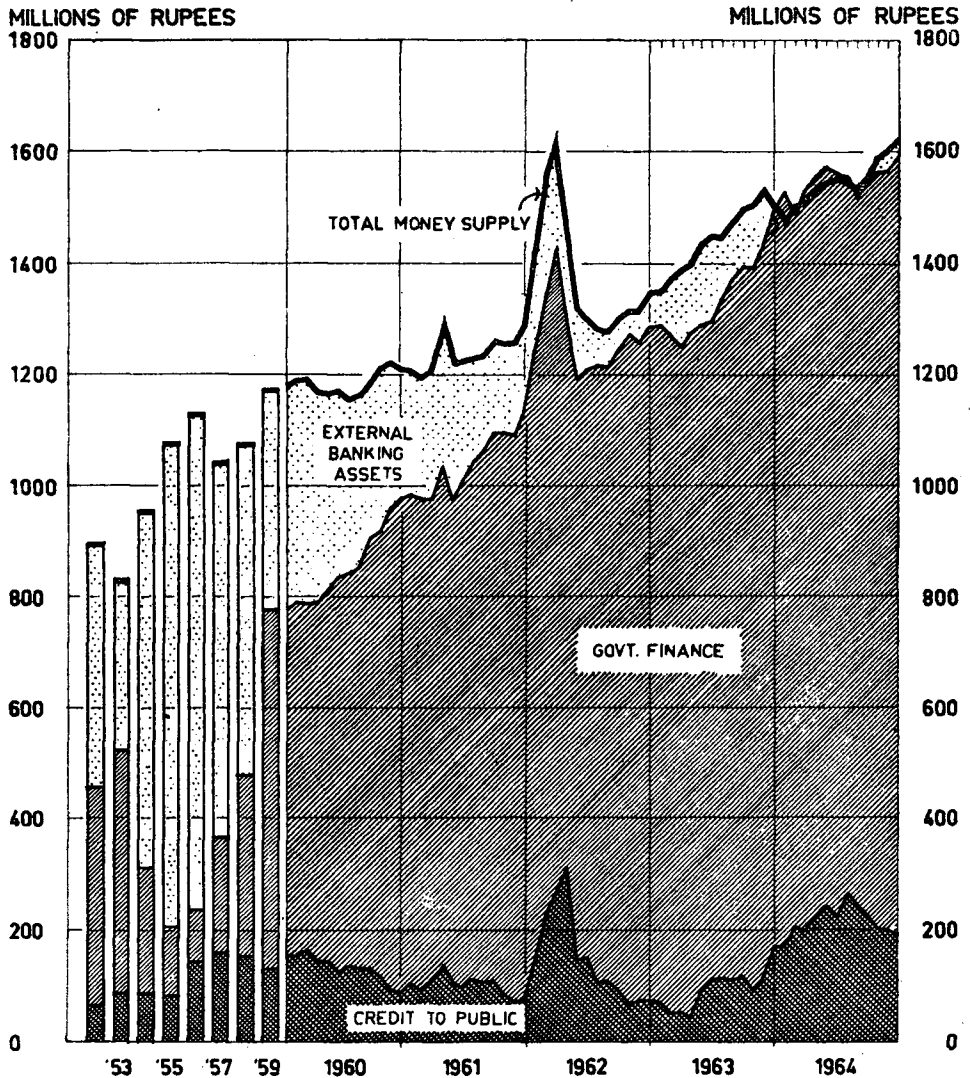

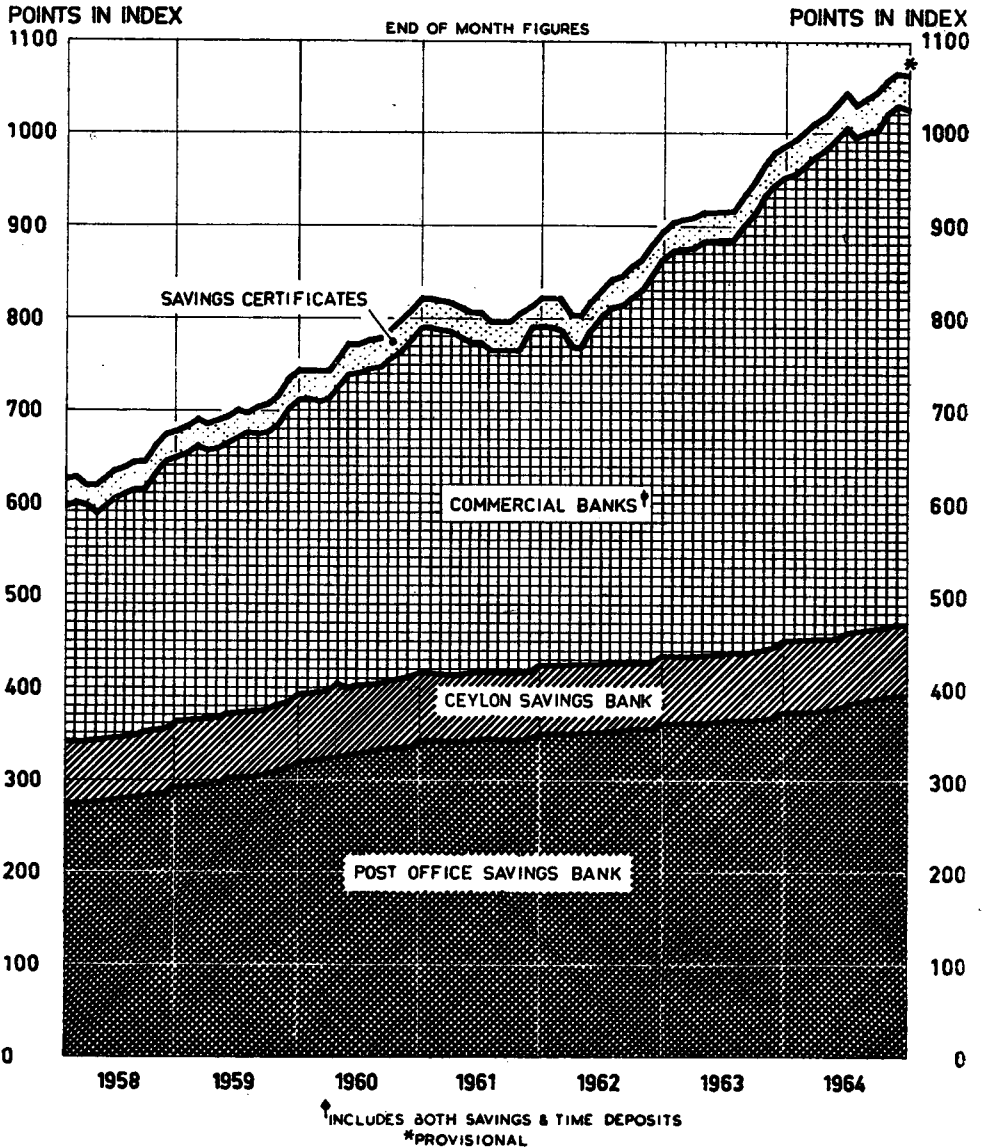
This chart indicates the origin of Money Supply in Ceylon.

- "Government Finance"—shows the claims of the Banking system on the Government net of the shift of rupee cash between the Government and the public.
- "Credit to Public"—shows the claims of the Banking system on the private sector net of change in Time and Savings deposits.

In 1964, external banking assets were negative in January, March to July and in September.



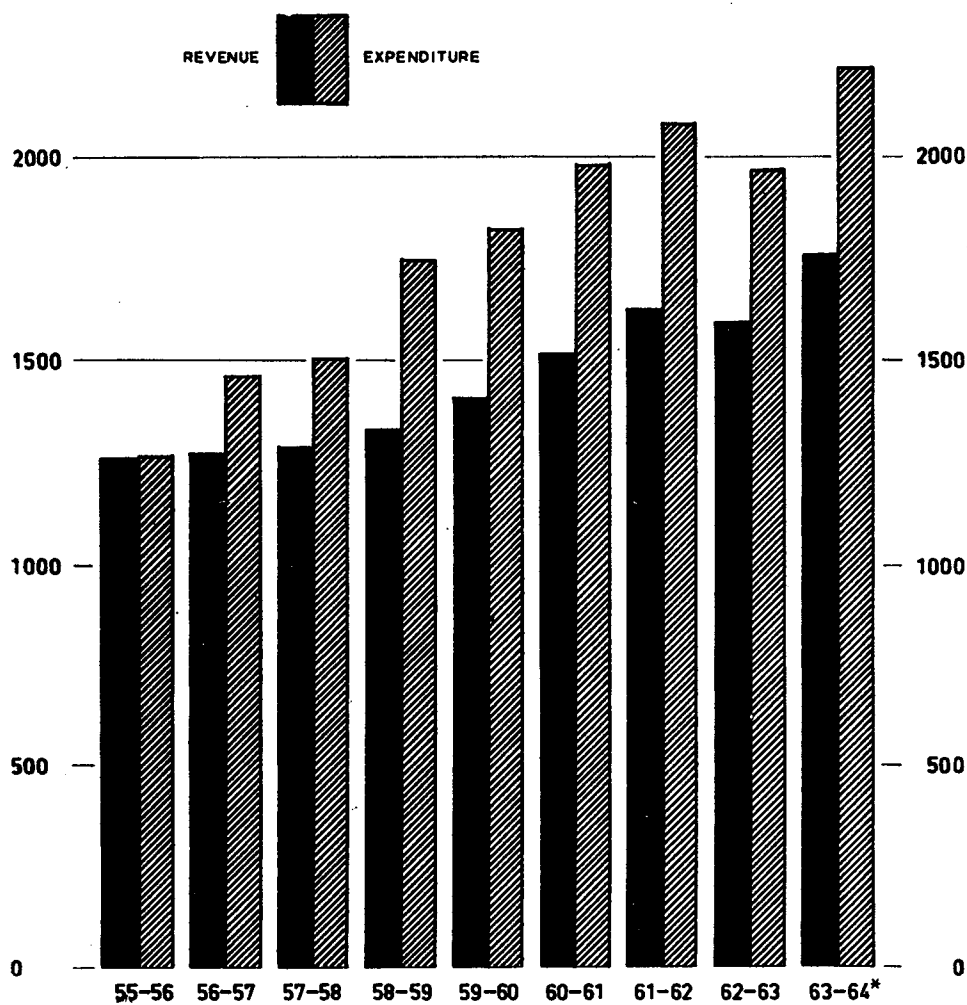

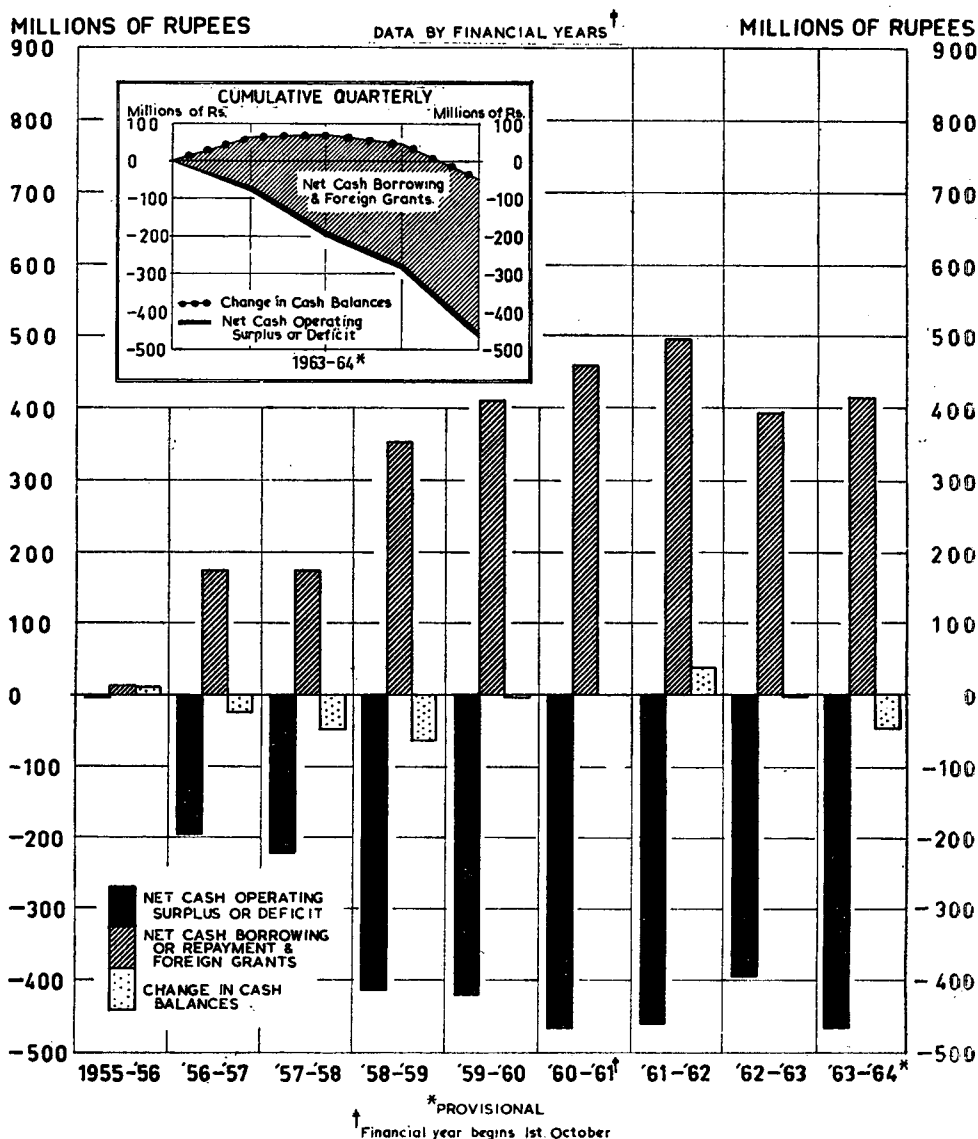

# GOVT. NET CASH OPERATING SURPLUS OR DEFICIT



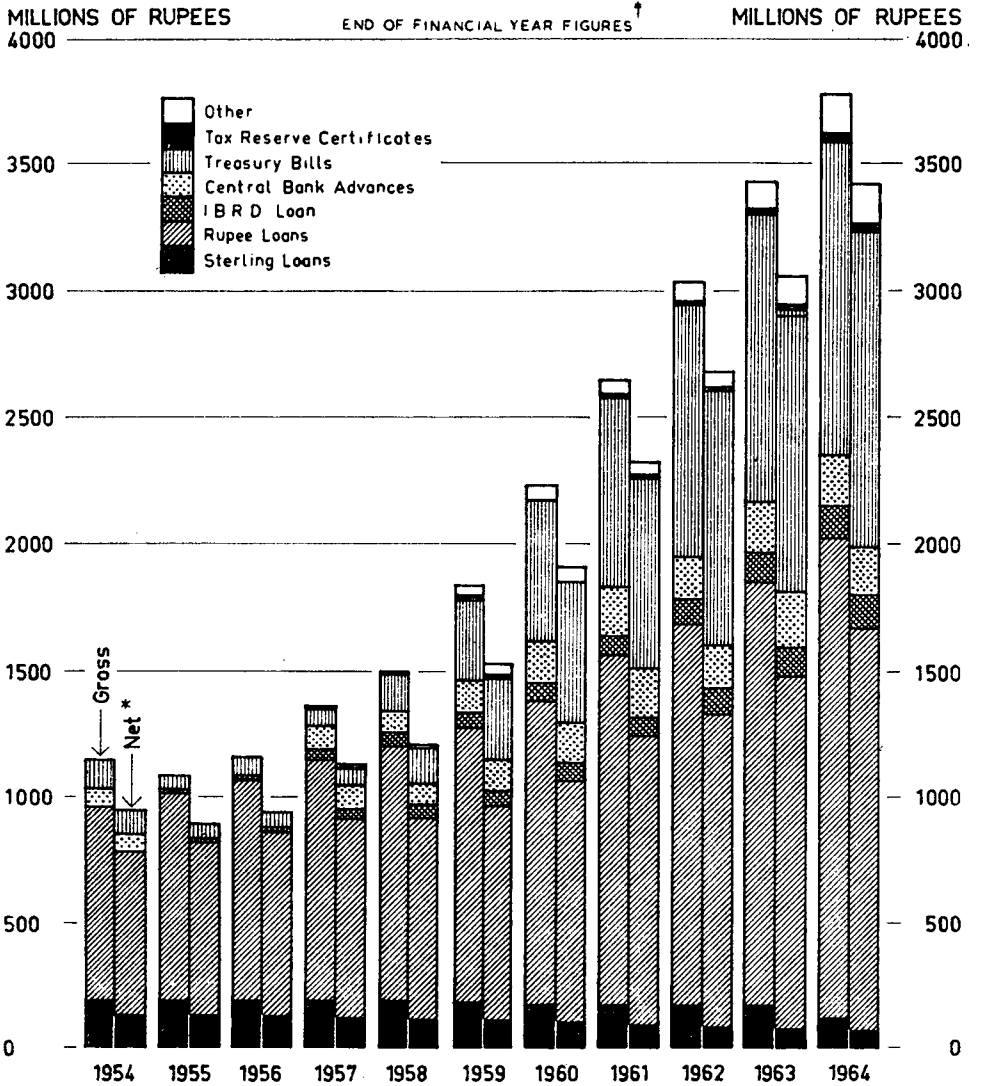

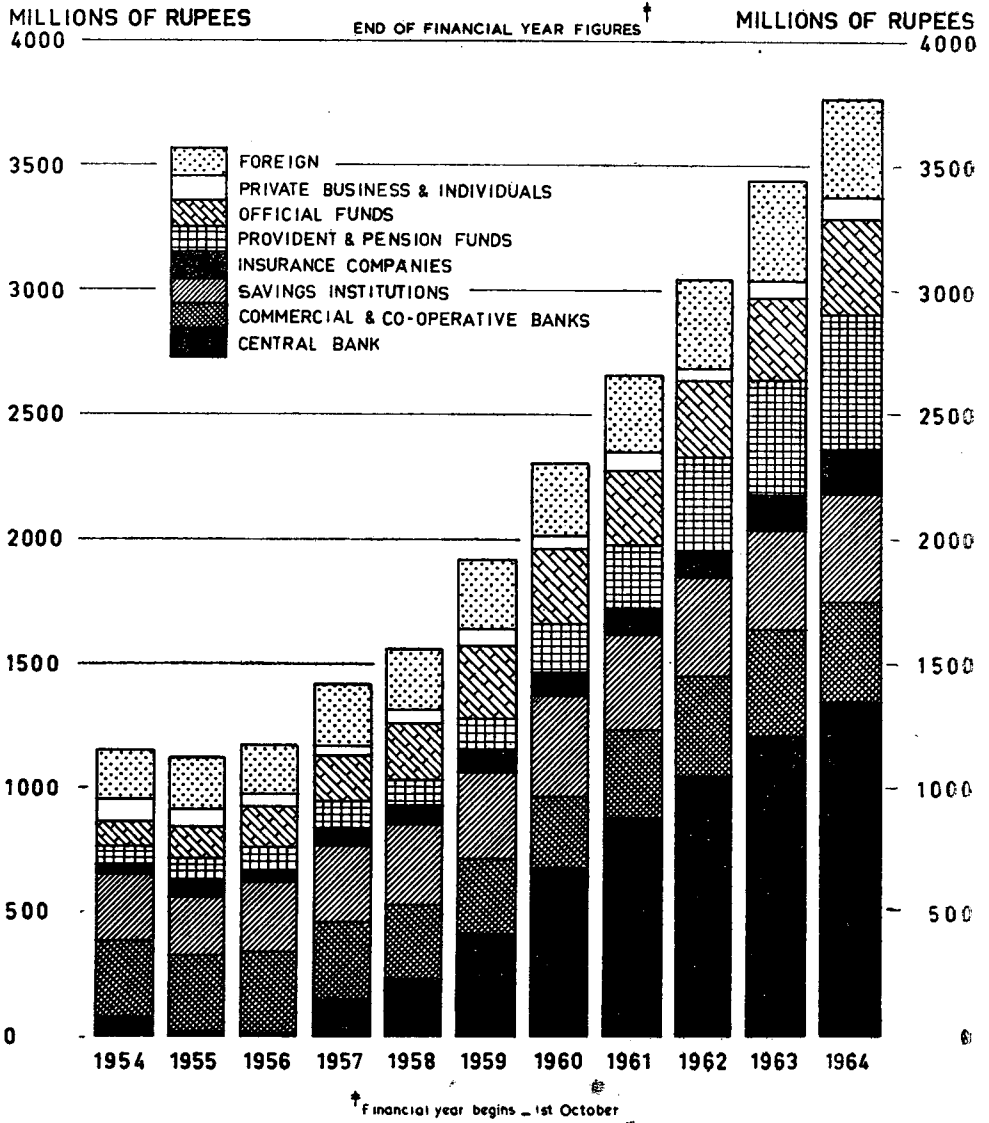
# COMPOSITION OF PUBLIC DEBT

(SHOWING GROSS & NET PUBLIC DEBT)

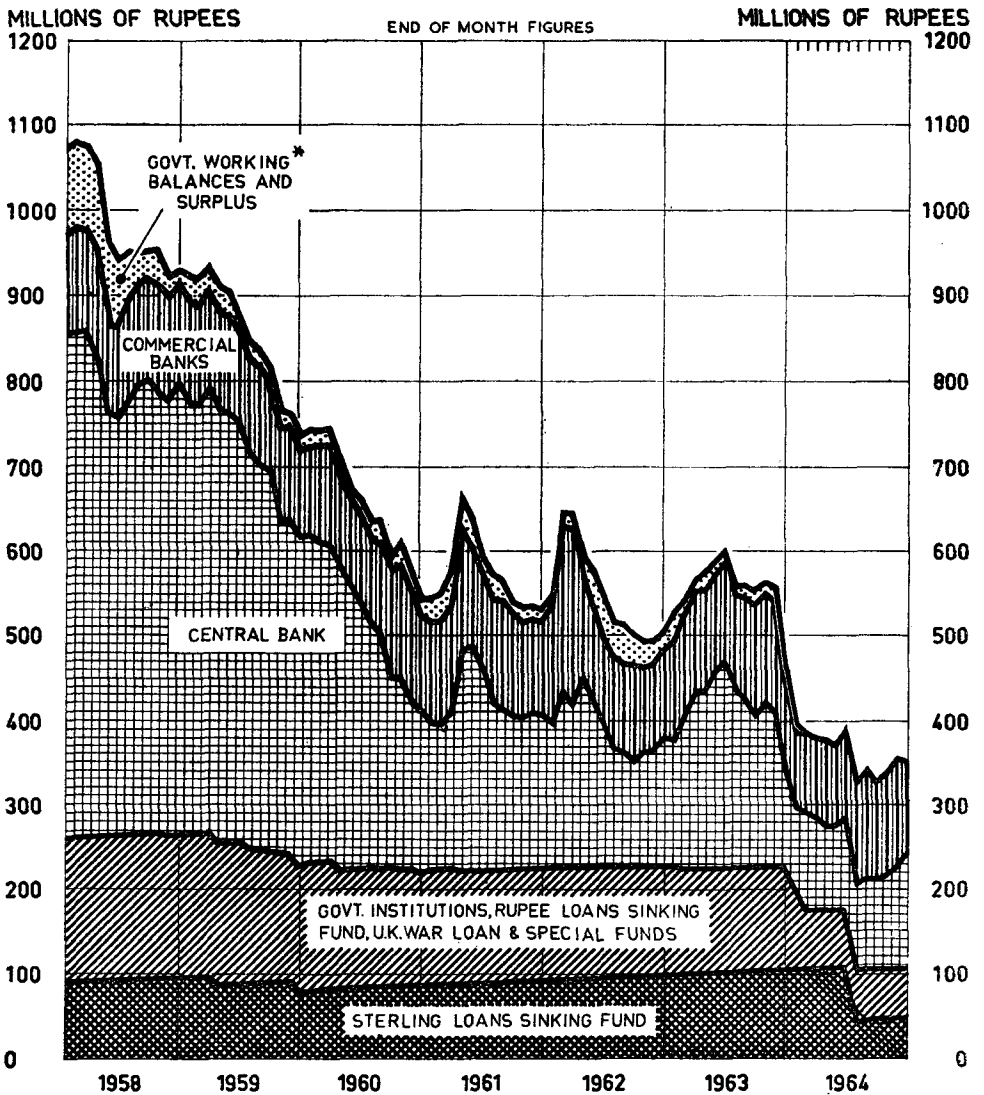

# OWNERSHIP OF PUBLIC DEBT



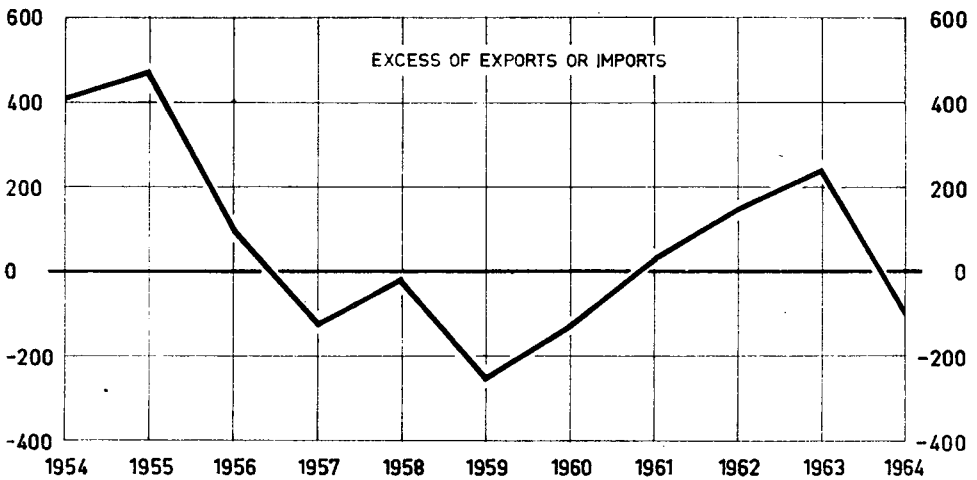
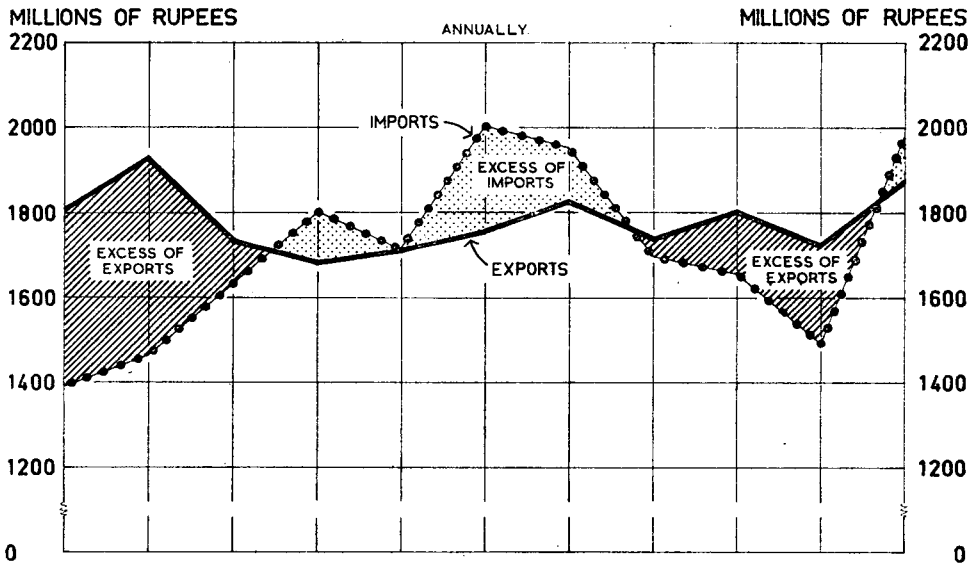

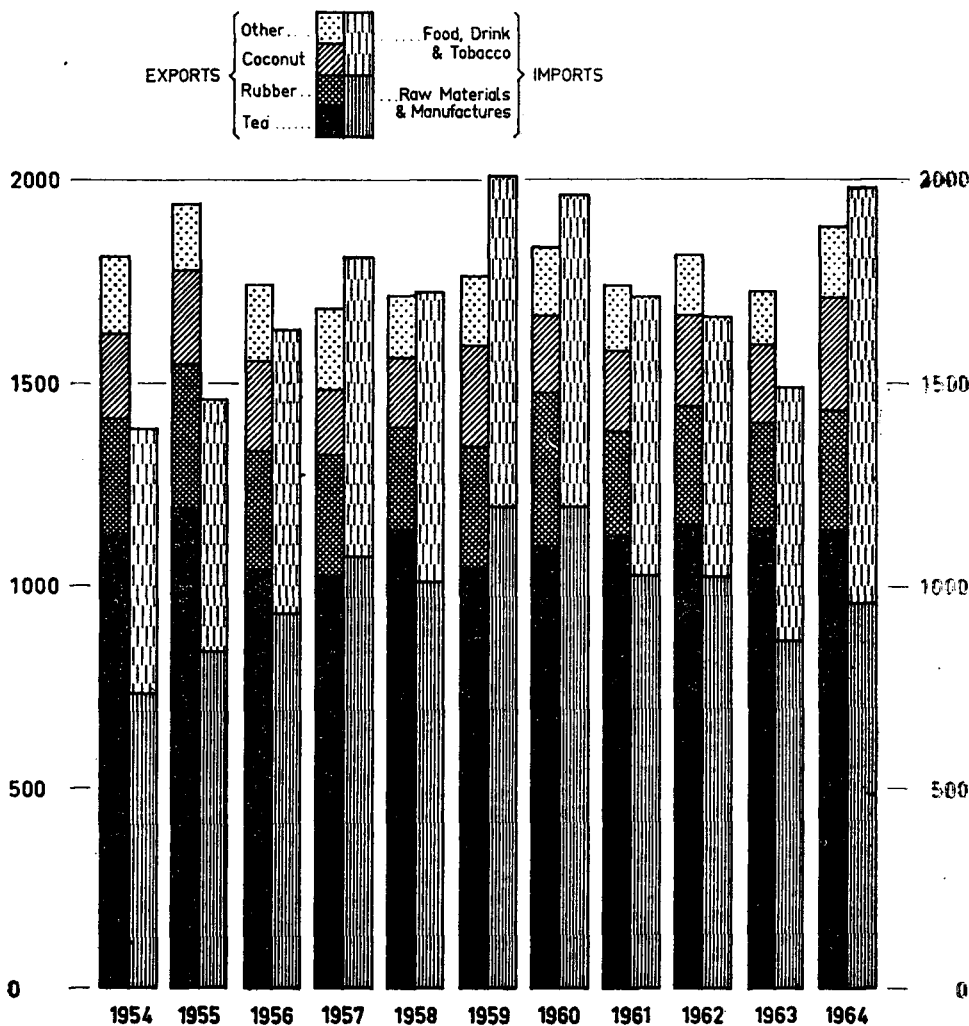

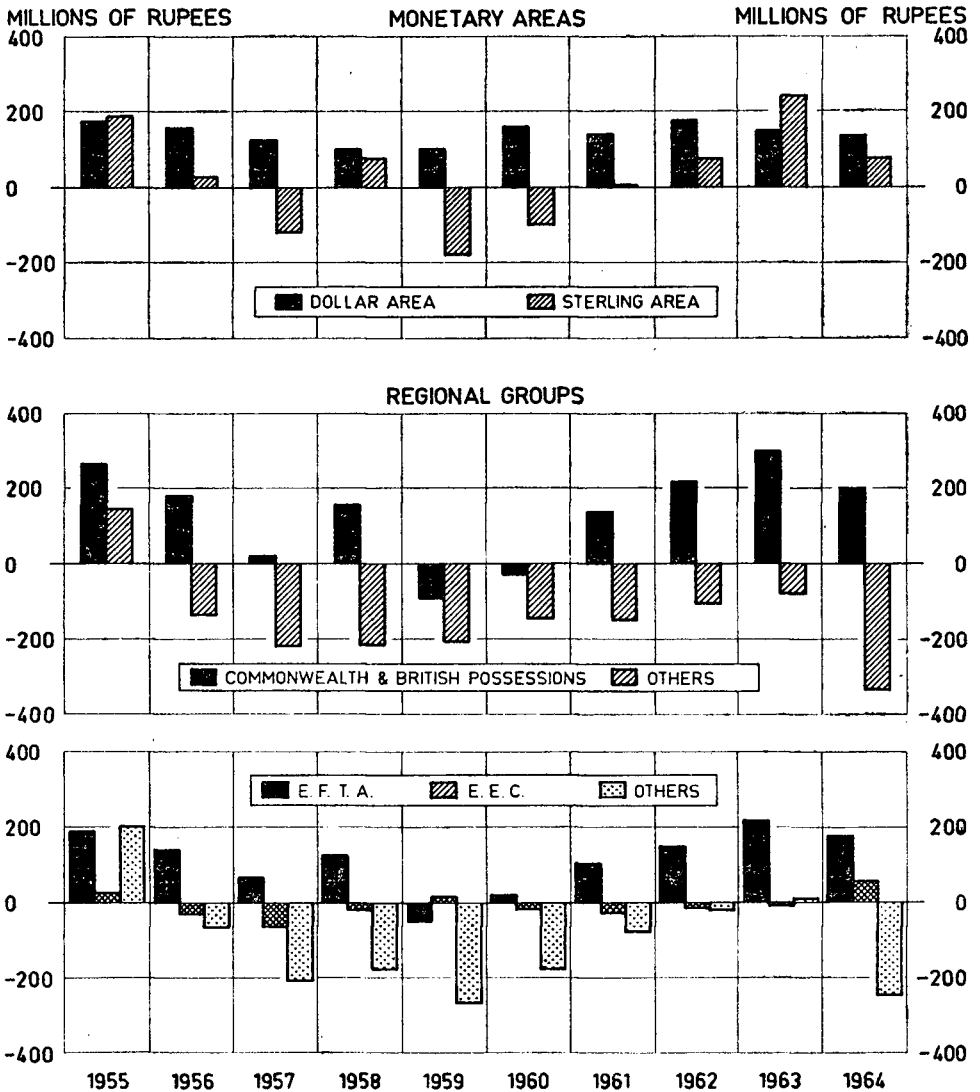




# BALANCE OF TRADE

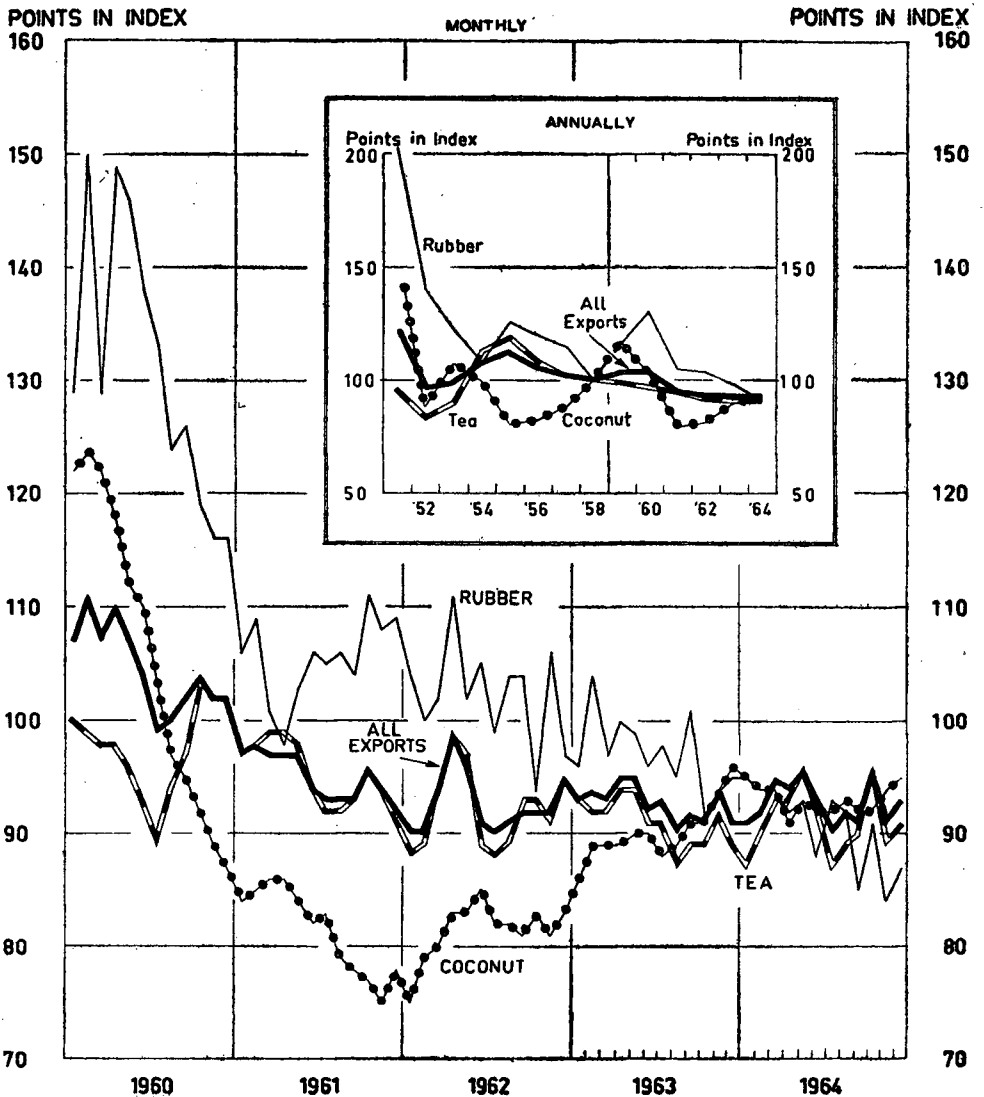

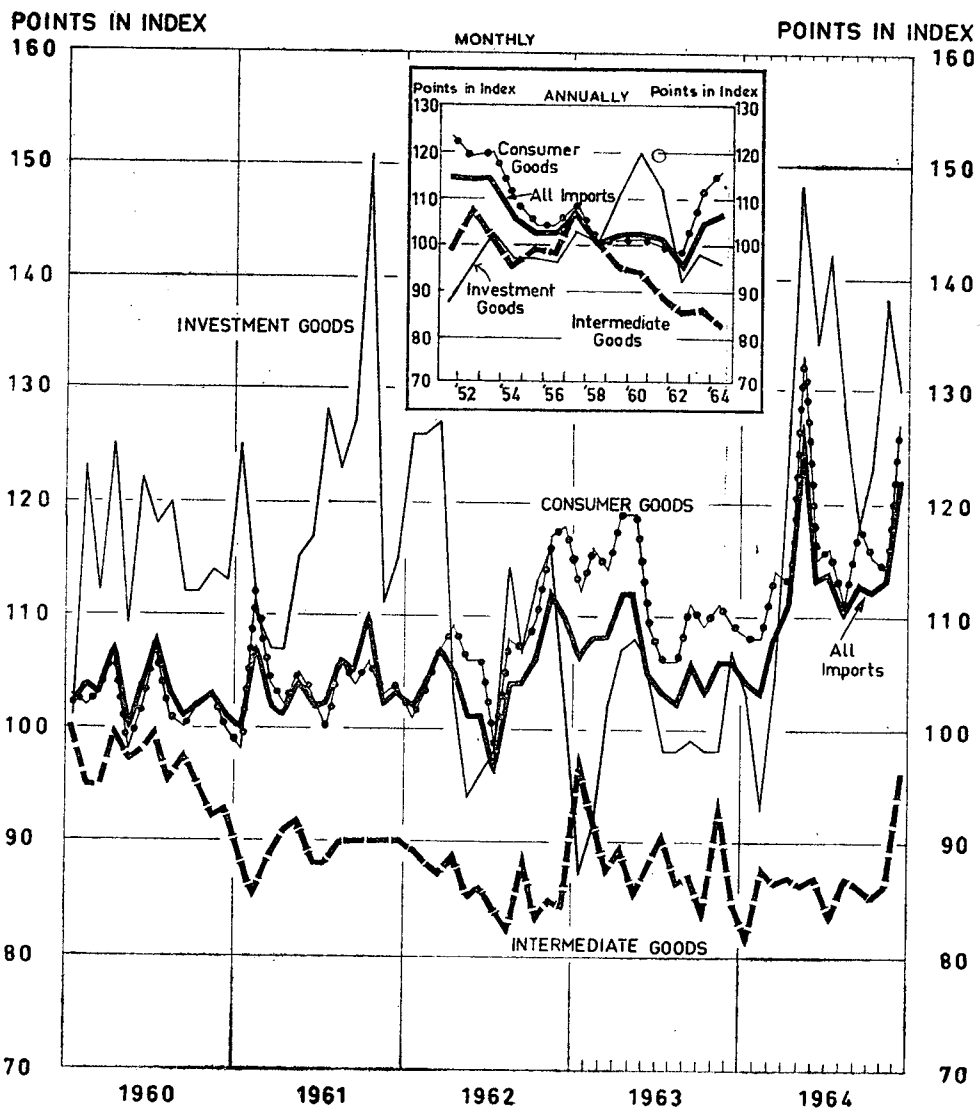
# EXPORT PRICES

1958=100



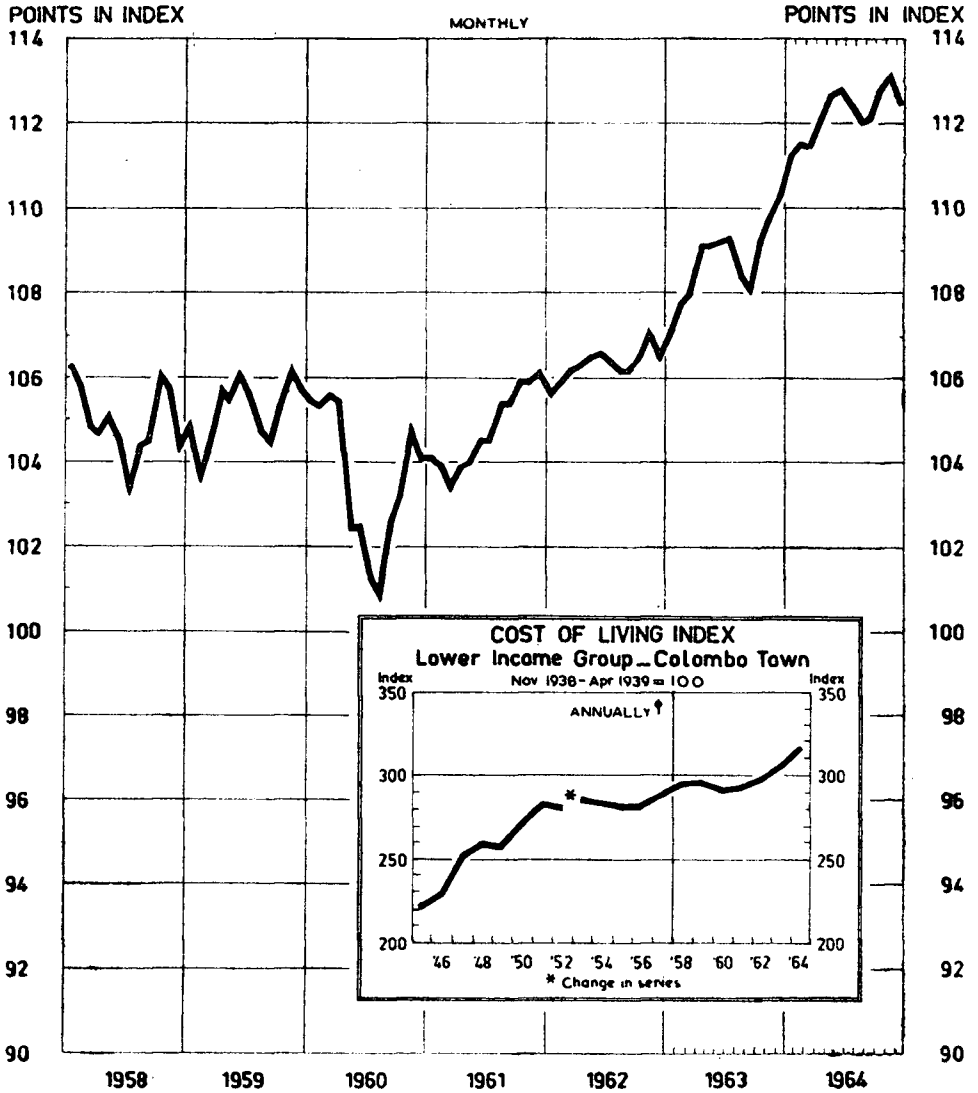

1952 = 100

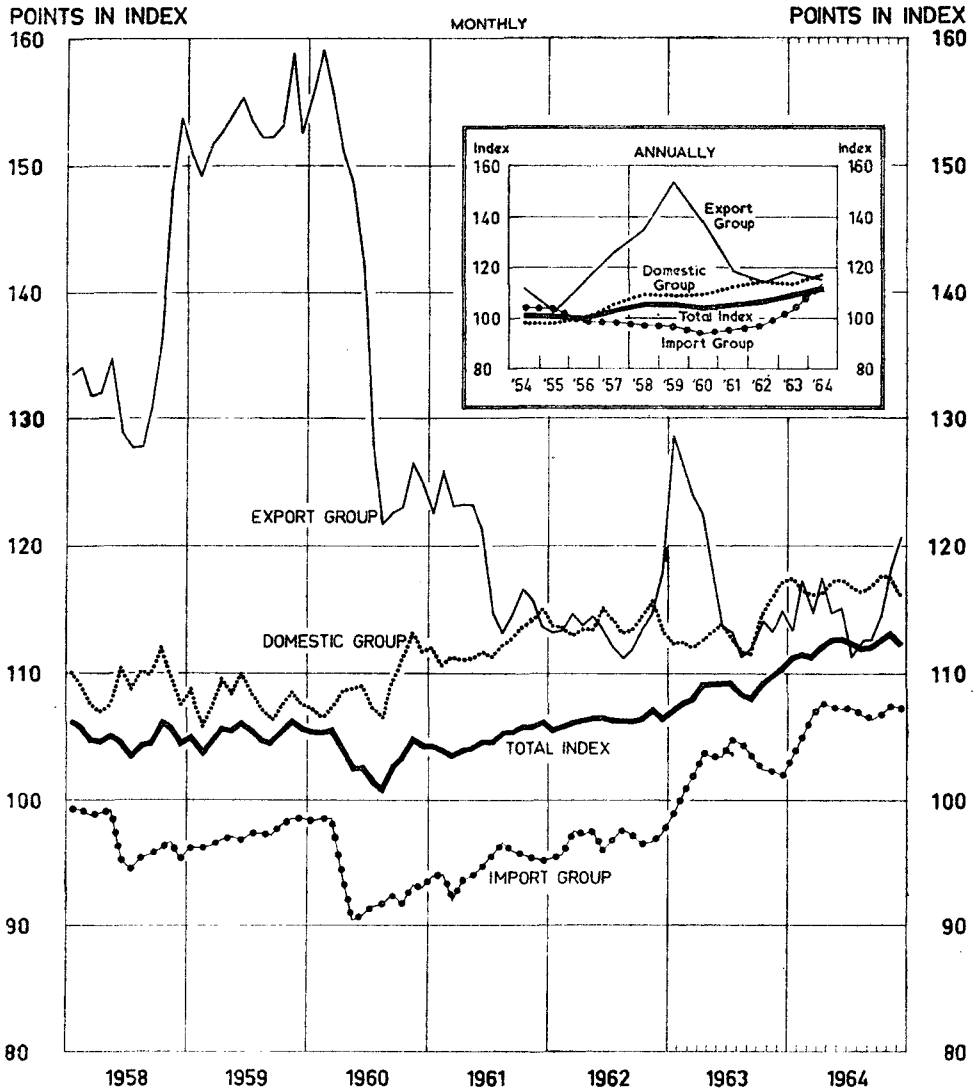

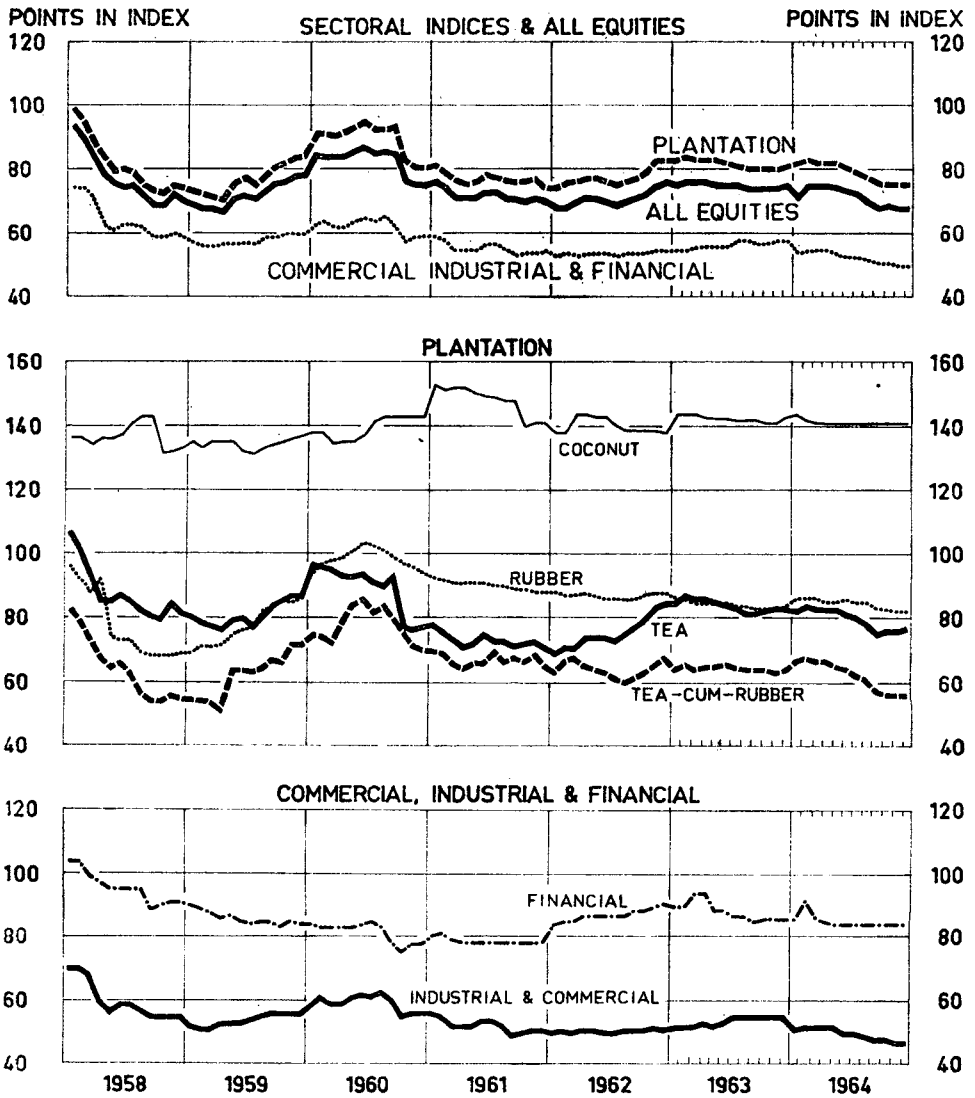
# WAGE RATE INDEX NUMBERS
