




# Growth in Major Economic Activities (Constant 2015 Prices)





### Gross Value Added at basic prices






# Fiscal Operations (% of GDP)




### Outstanding Central Government Debt (% of GDP)

### Deficit Financing Net (% of GDP)







### **Movements of Selected Market Interest Rates**









# Total No. of Pupils & Pupils per Teacher Ratio (All Schools)




