 (I) Exchange rates have been defined in terms of indices so that the appreciation/depreciation of the rupee relative to other currencies is directly reflected by a rise/fall in the values of the effective exchange rate indices.
- (m) CCPI is used for the computation of the Real Effective Exchange Rate (REER). The REER is computed by adjusting Nominal Effective Exchange Rate (NEER) for inflation differentials with the countries whose currencies are included in the basket.
- (n) Grants are classified as a revenue item
- (o) Includes assets/ liabilities of National Development Bank, which merged with NDB Bank Ltd. With effect from August 2005.
- (p) Restructuring bonds worth Rs.19.4 billion, which were issued by the government to the two state banks, have been covered to Treasury bonds upon their maturity in October 2006. This amount, which previously appeared under other assets, as been included in net credit to government since October 2006.
- (q) With effect from 1 January 2013, the MPI was replaced by a newly introduced index, namely, S&P SL20 index. This index introduced on 27 June 2012 and its base period is 14 December 2004 = 1,000.

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
