

HIGHLIGHTS

Paddy production for 2026 Yala season, based on the sown extent as of end June 2026, is forecasted at 2.01 million metric tons, a **12.8% decline** from the previous Yala season



In June 2026, domestic tea production increased by 3.9% (y-o-y) marking a recovery after three consecutive months of y-o-y production declines



Local rubber production also increased by 7.0% (y-o-y) in June 2026 with improved weather conditions



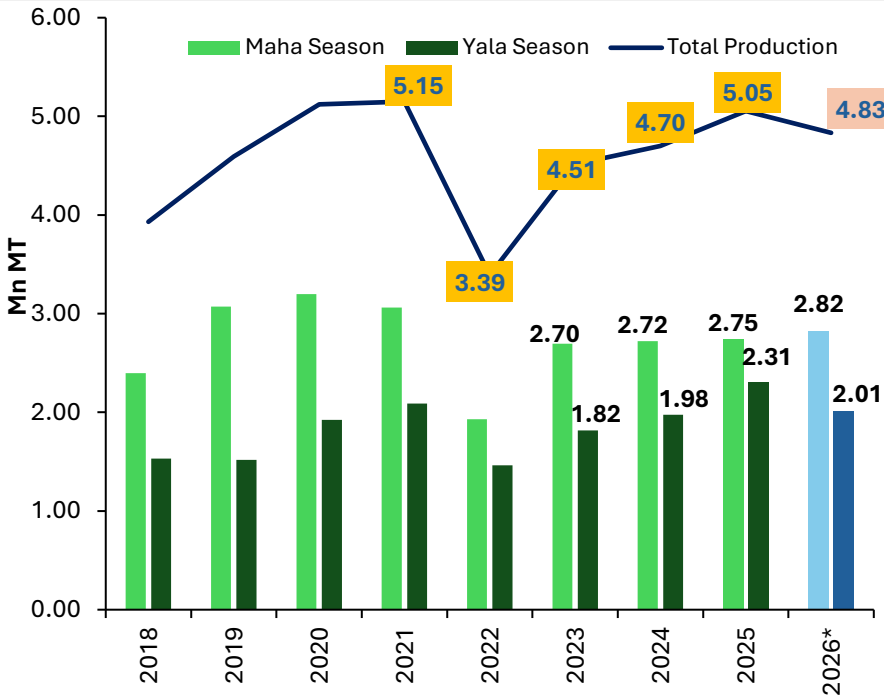
Marine fish production continued to decline by 11.3% (y-o-y) in June 2026 amid rising sea surface temperatures and higher fuel prices



Coconut production during May-June 2026 declined by 8.9% (y-o-y) partly due to the high base effect in the corresponding period of 2025



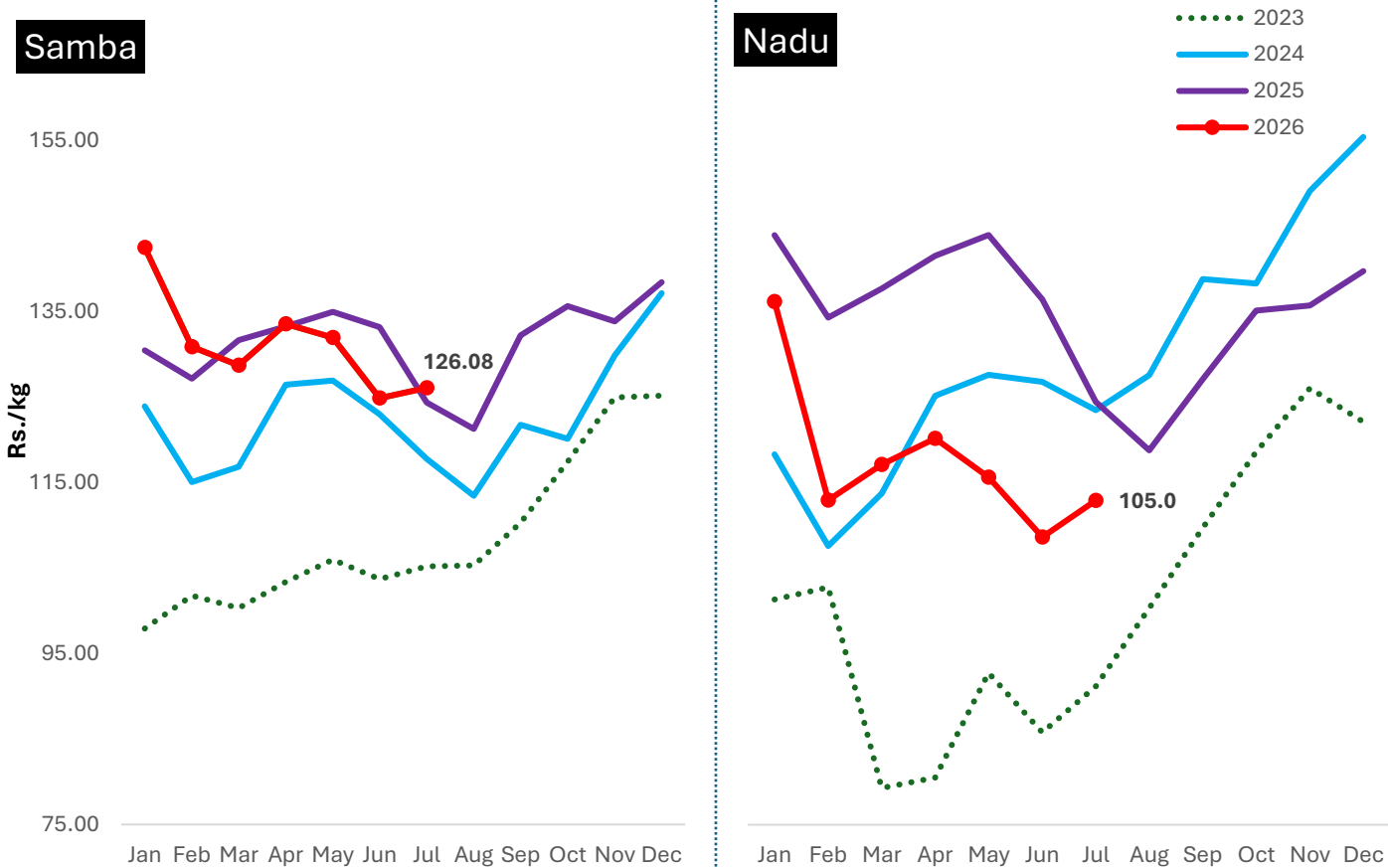

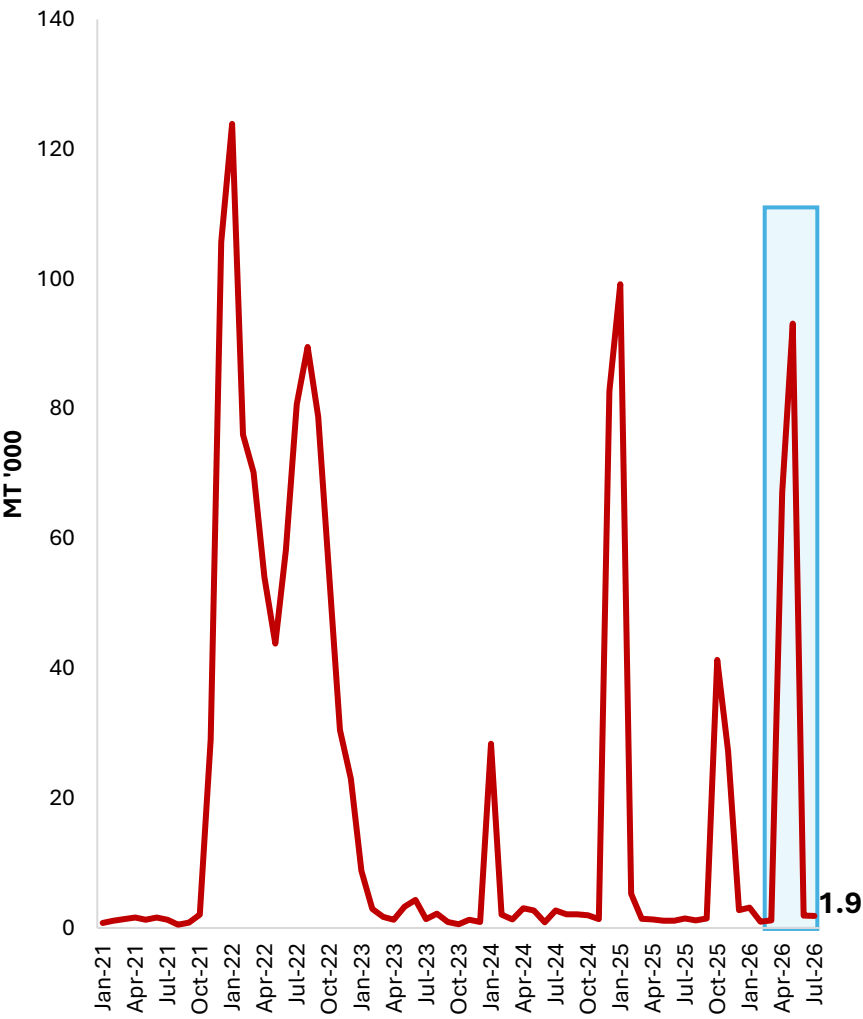

- Paddy production in the 2026 Yala season is estimated at **2.01 million metric tons**, a **12.8% decline** from the previous Yala season, based on the sown extent (including re-cultivated extent) reported as at end-June 2026
- Accordingly, total paddy production in 2026 is forecast at **4.83 million metric tons**, representing a **2.4% decline** from the previous year

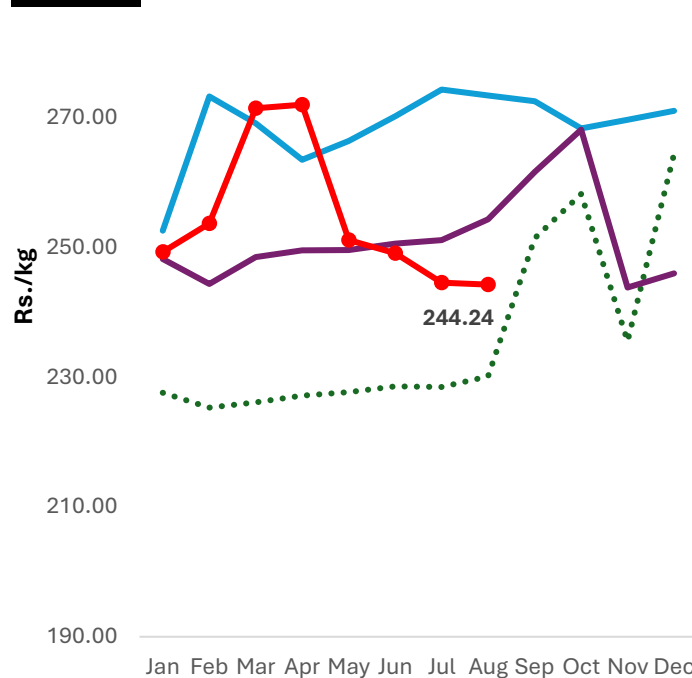
Rice Imports



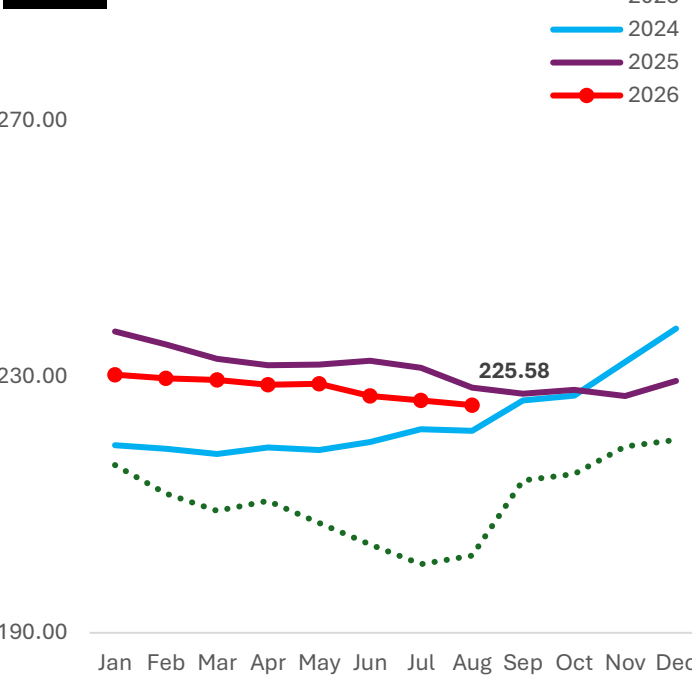
Rice imports declined in July 2026 as the temporary relaxation of import restrictions ended

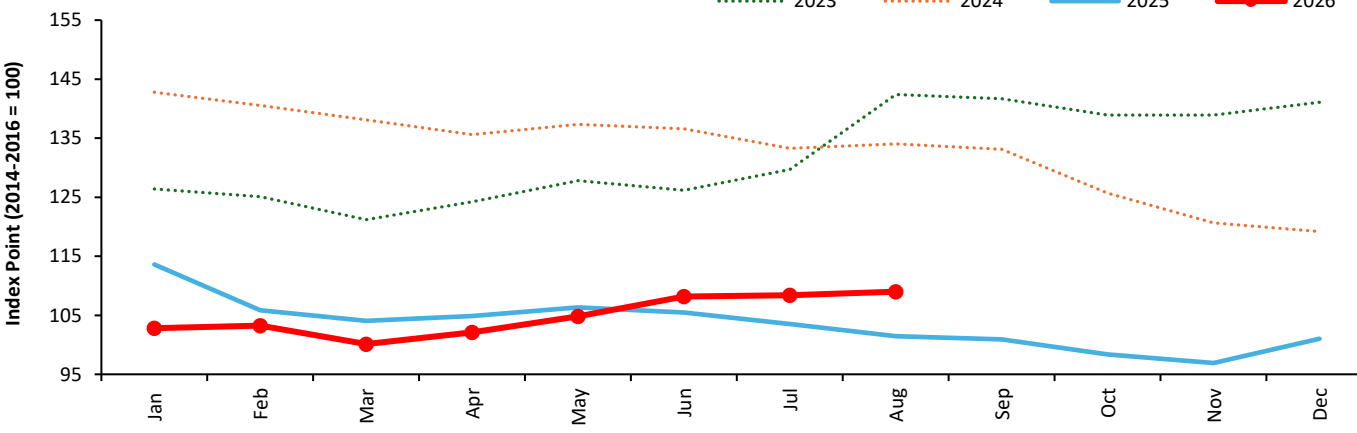

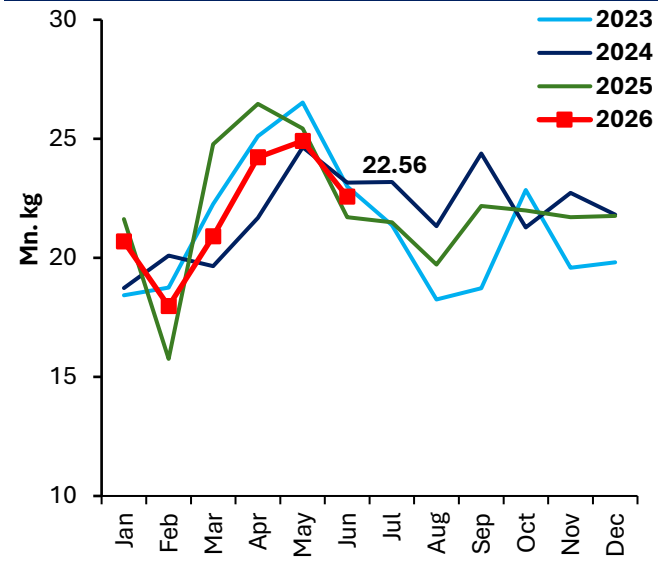


FAO All Rice Price Index

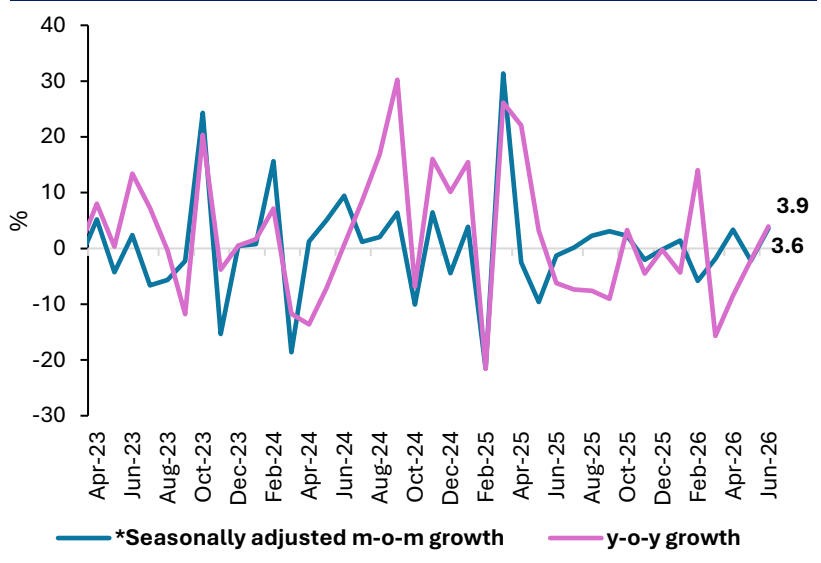

Tea Production Growth

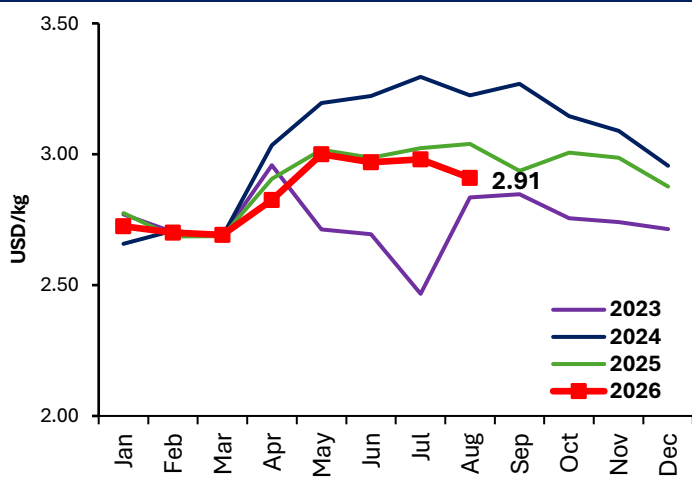


- Domestic tea production increased by **3.9%** (y-o-y) in June 2026, marking a recovery after three consecutive months of declines
- This also represents a **3.6%** m-o-m increase (seasonally adjusted).

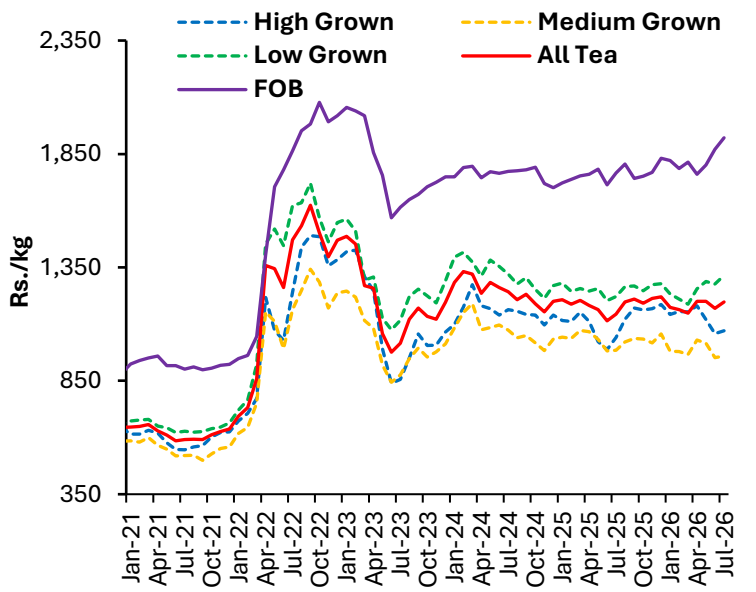
Global tea prices increased in August 2026 compared to the previous month, with the Kolkata auction recording a decline in the average price, while Colombo and Mombasa recorded slight increases

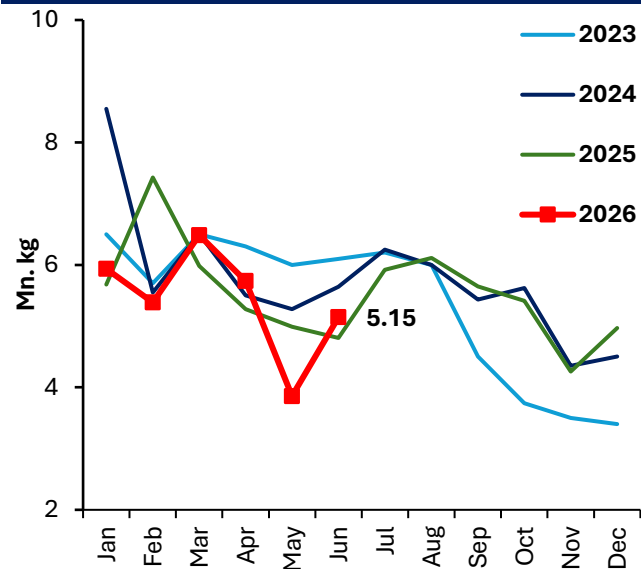

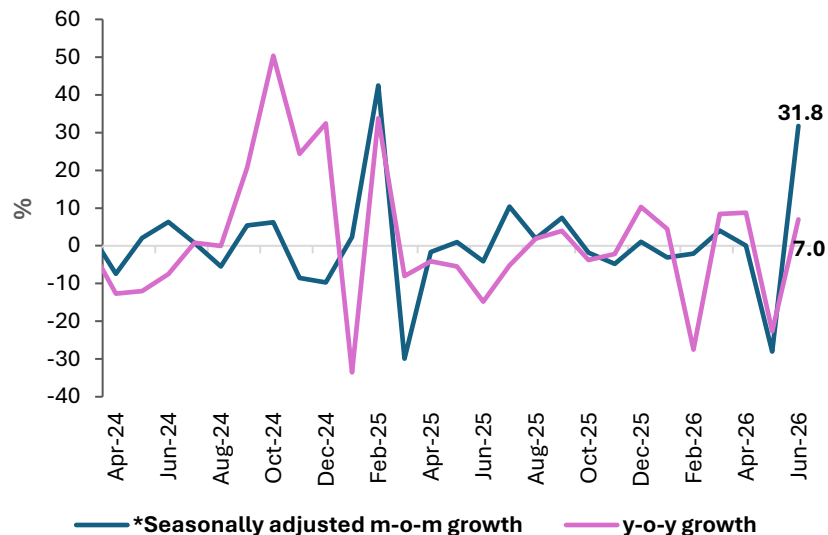

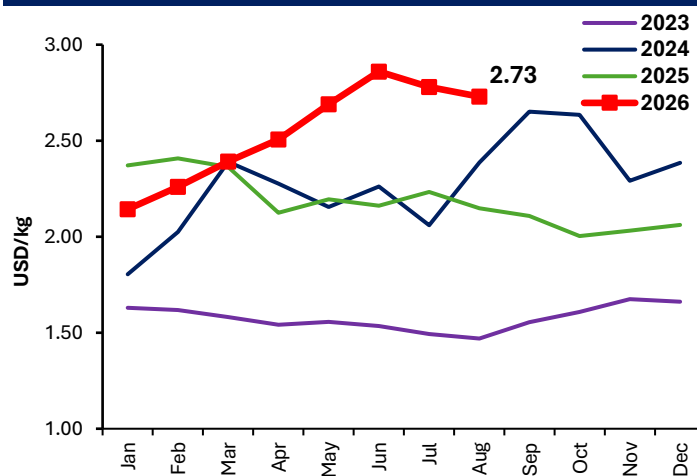
Rubber Production Growth



- Domestic rubber production increased by **7.0%** (y-o-y) in June 2026. This represents a **31.8%** m-o-m increase (seasonally adjusted)
- Global natural rubber prices declined slightly, primarily driven by the gradual entry of seasonal production from Southeast Asia into the market, easing supply concern

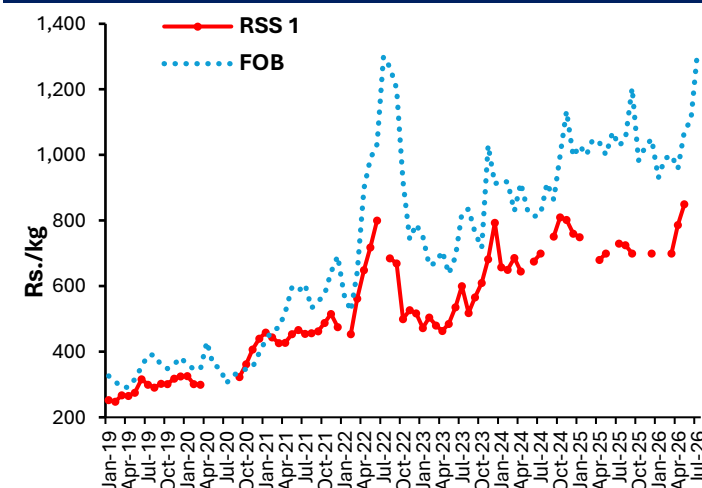

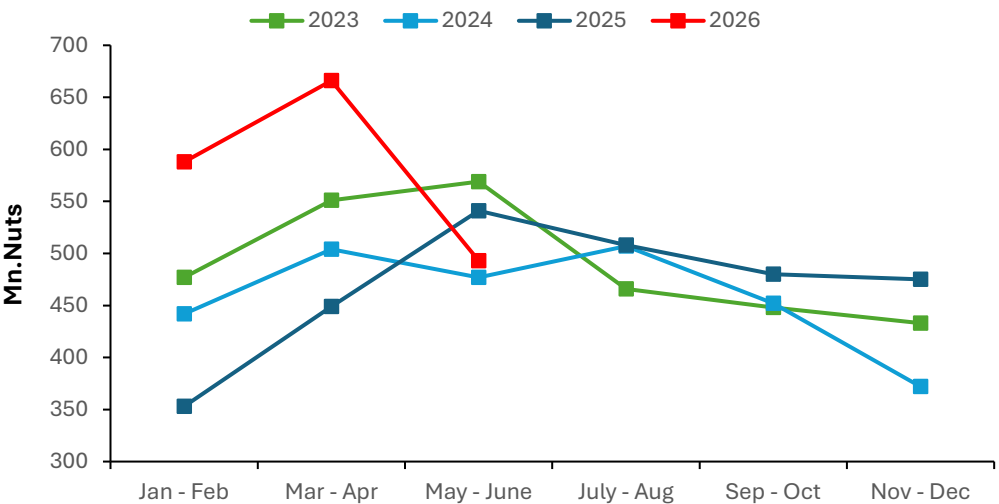

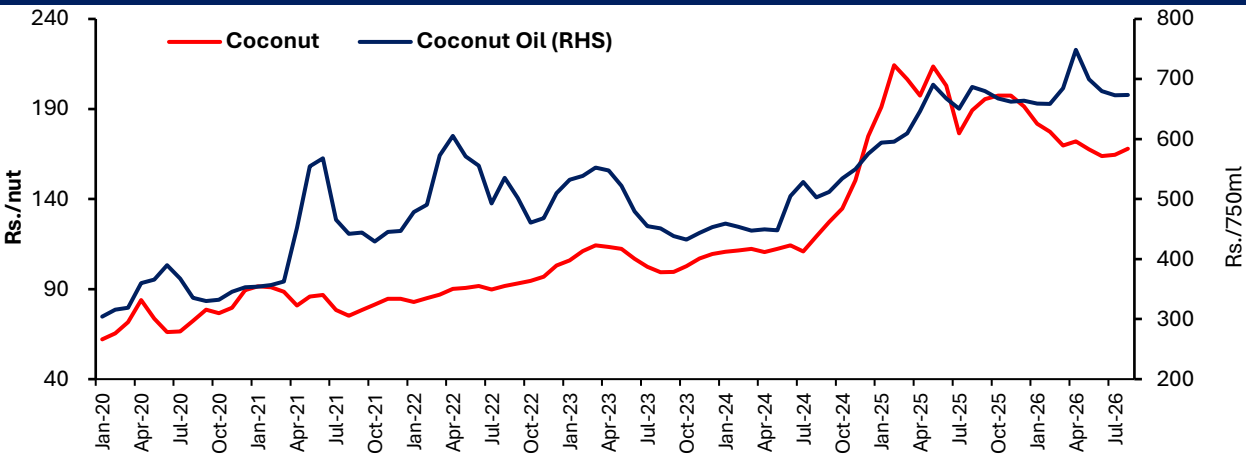

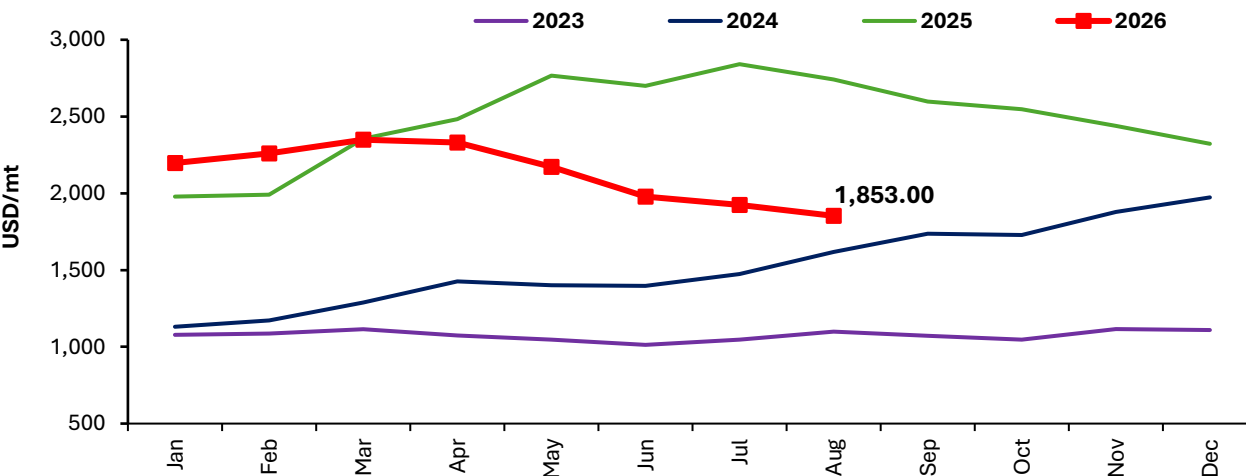

Retail Price of Coconut and Coconut Oil

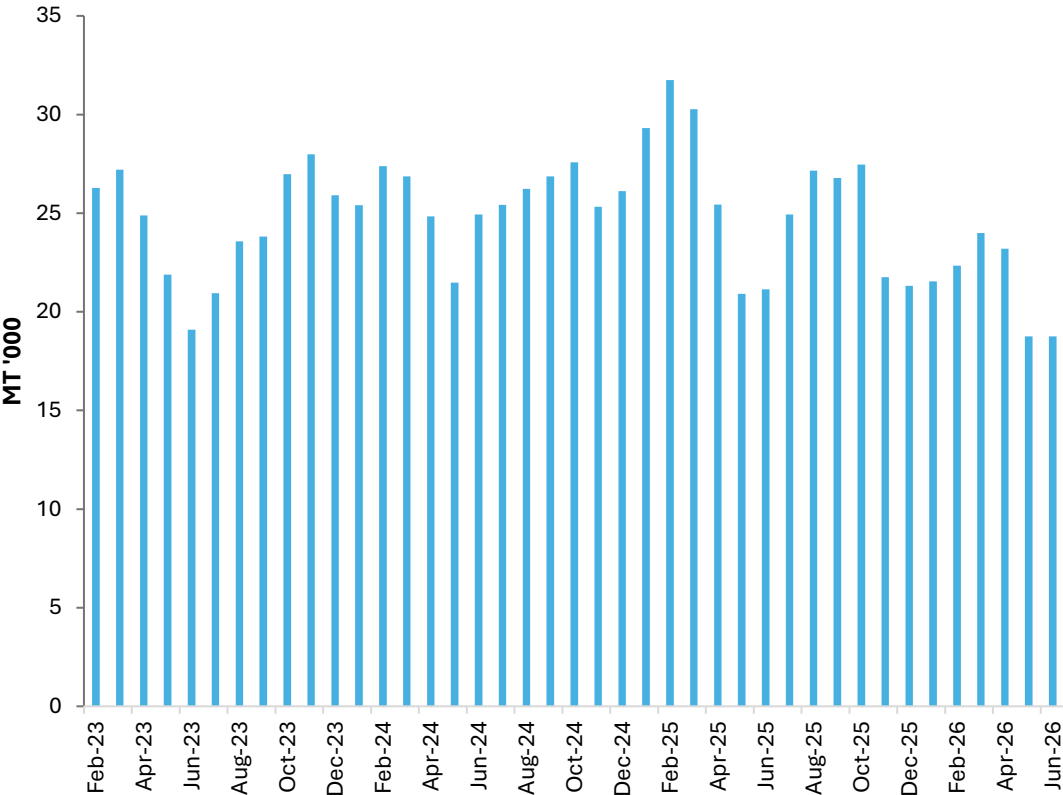


International Coconut Oil Prices



International coconut oil prices continued to decline in August 2026 compared with previous months

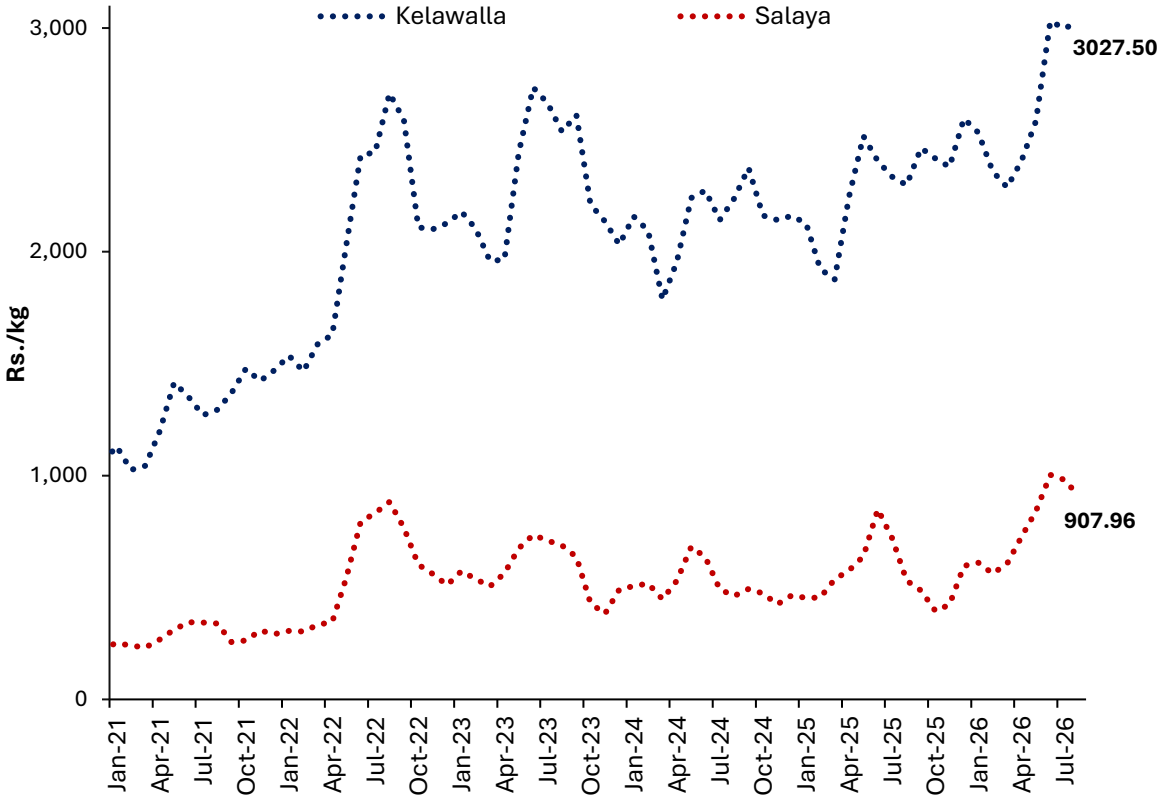

Retail Fish Prices



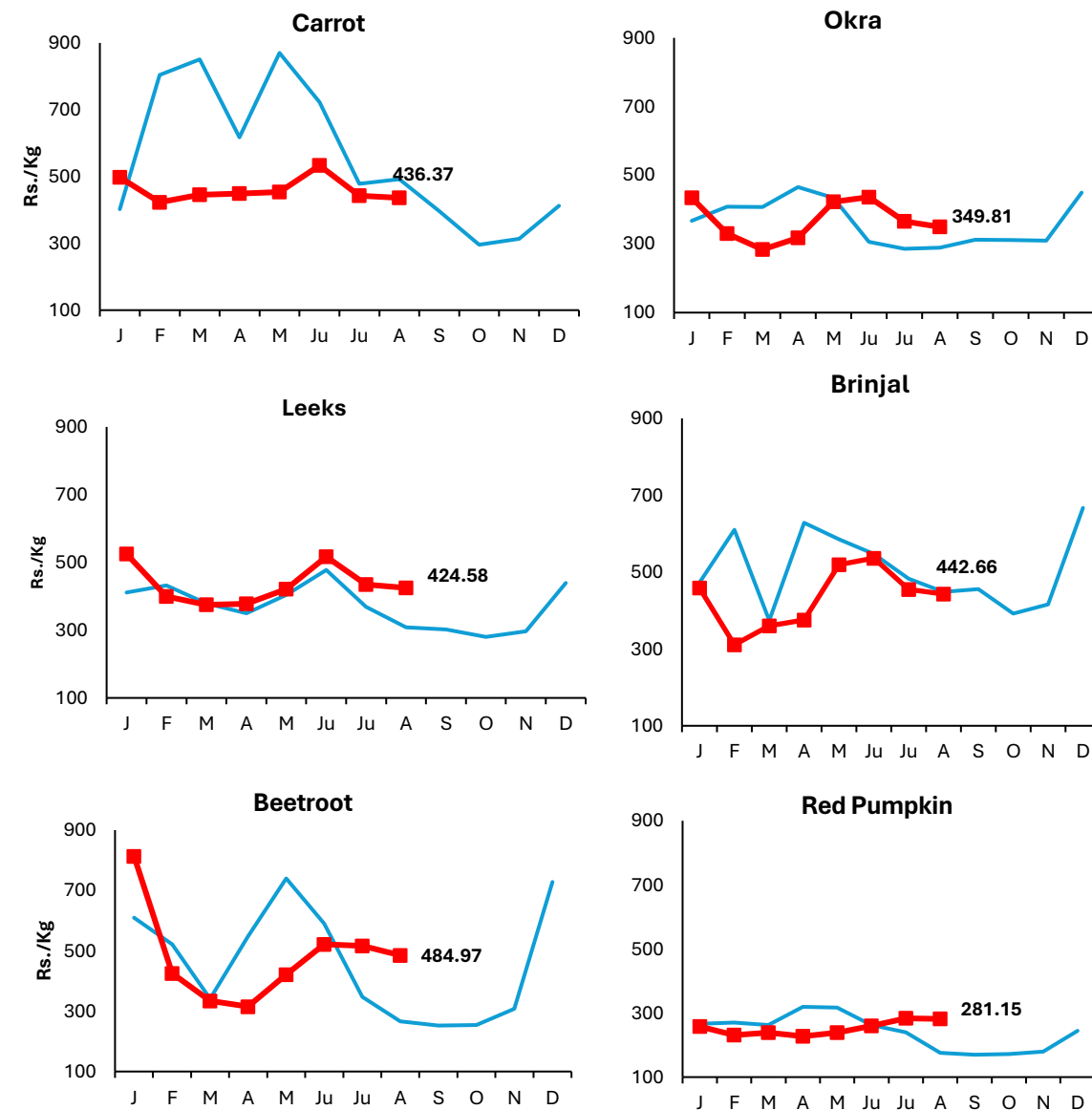
- According to provisional data, total marine fish production continued to decline by **11.3%** (y-o-y) in June 2026, amid rising sea surface temperatures and higher fuel prices

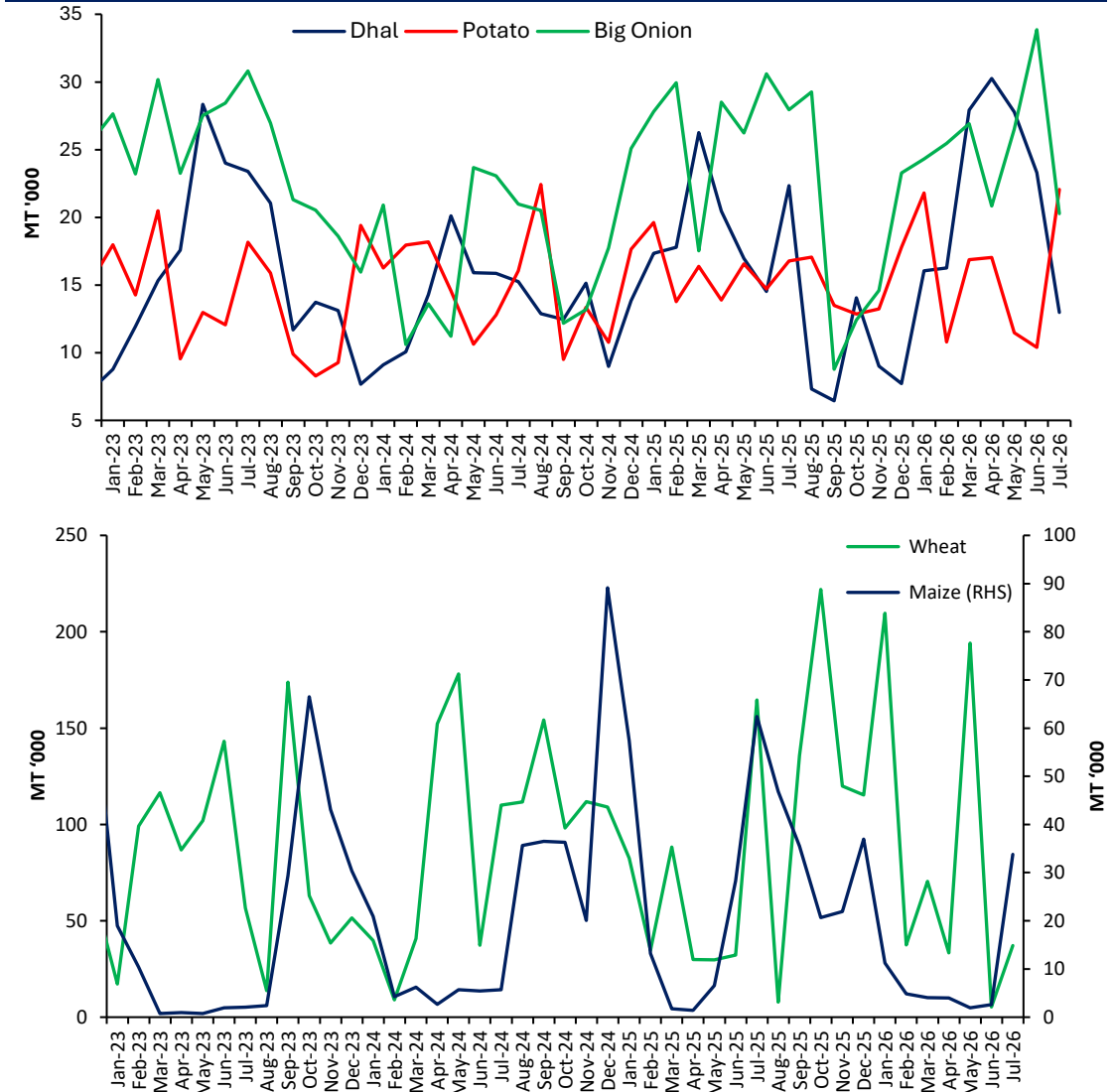

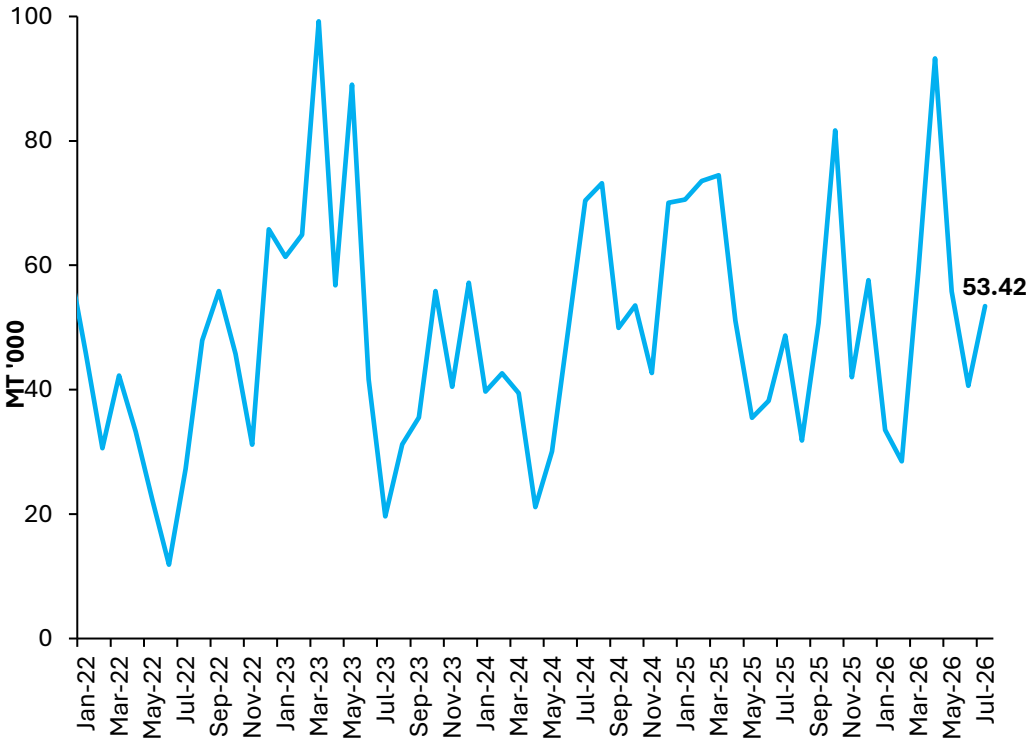

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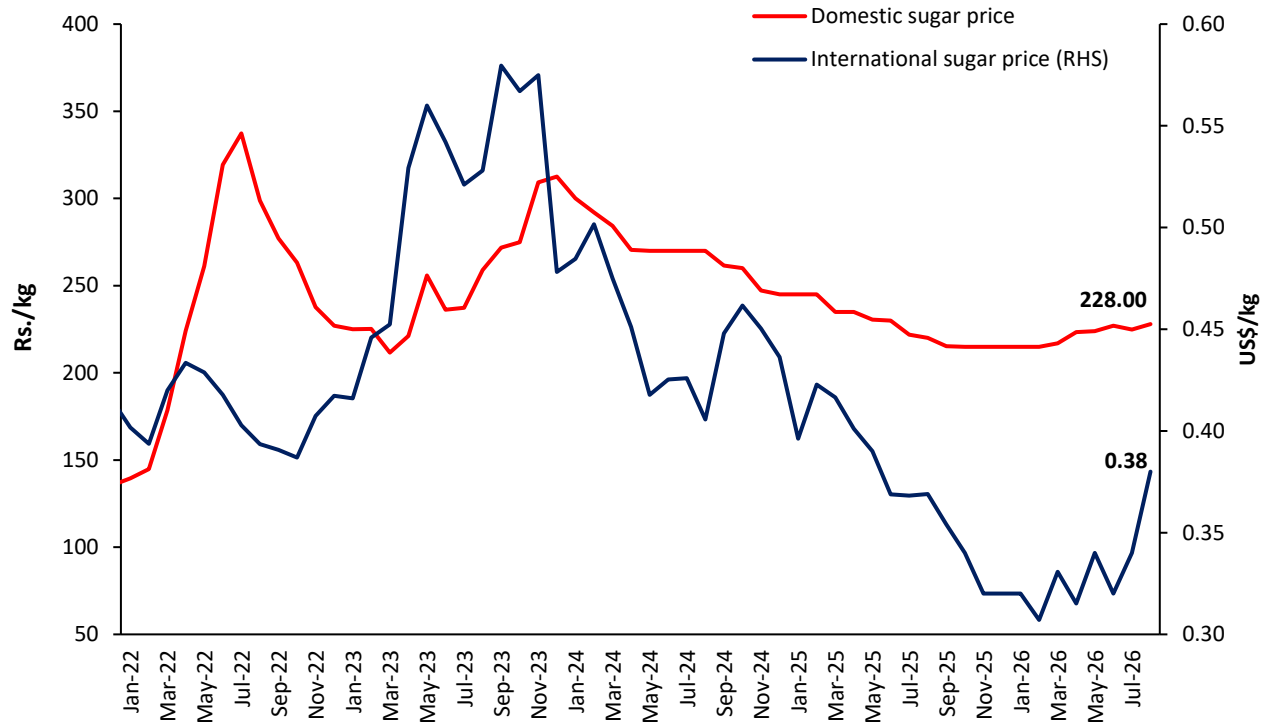

International sugar prices increased in August 2026 amid tighter global supply prospects, driven by hot and dry weather in the EU, El Niño-related conditions in Asia, and lower sugar production in Brazil

Further, India’s sugar export ban remains in effect until the end of September 2026

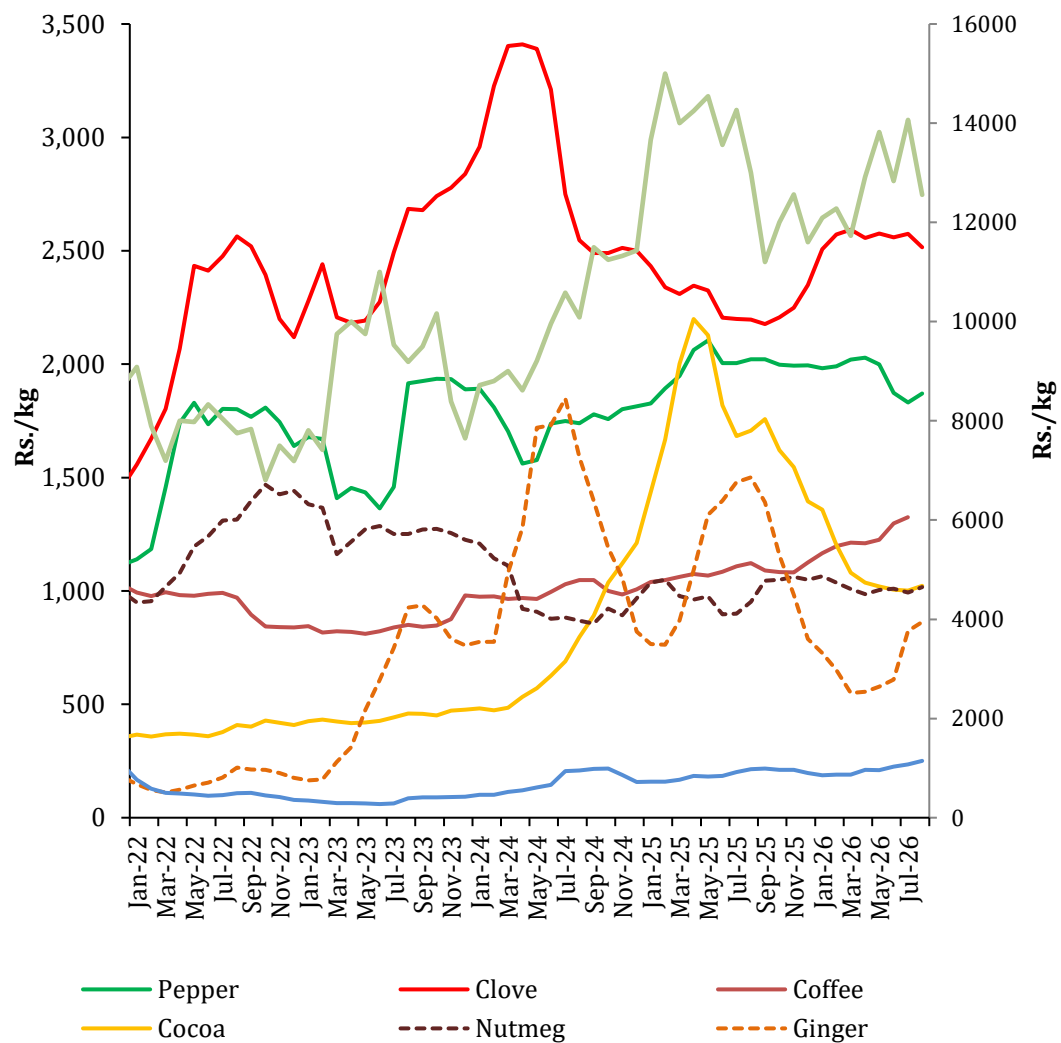

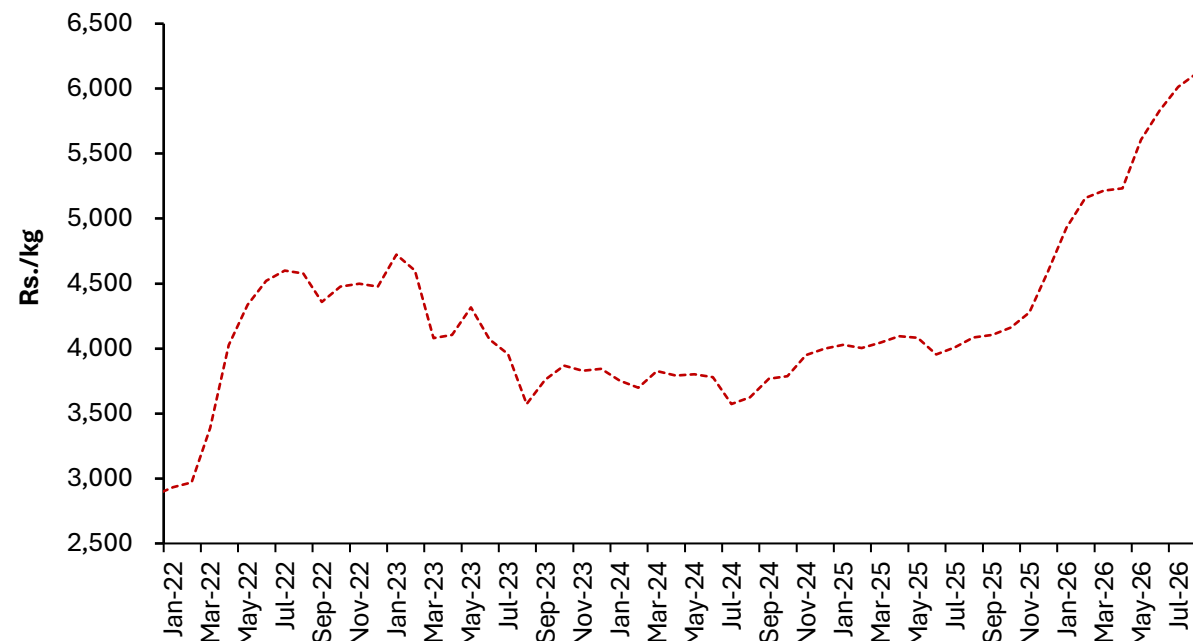

- In August 2026, market prices of export crops such as pepper, coffee, cocoa, nutmeg, cinnamon, ginger, and turmeric increased (m-o-m), while prices of cardamom and clove declined
- Earnings from spice exports recorded strong growth in August 2026 (y-o-y), mainly driven by a significant increase in pepper exports

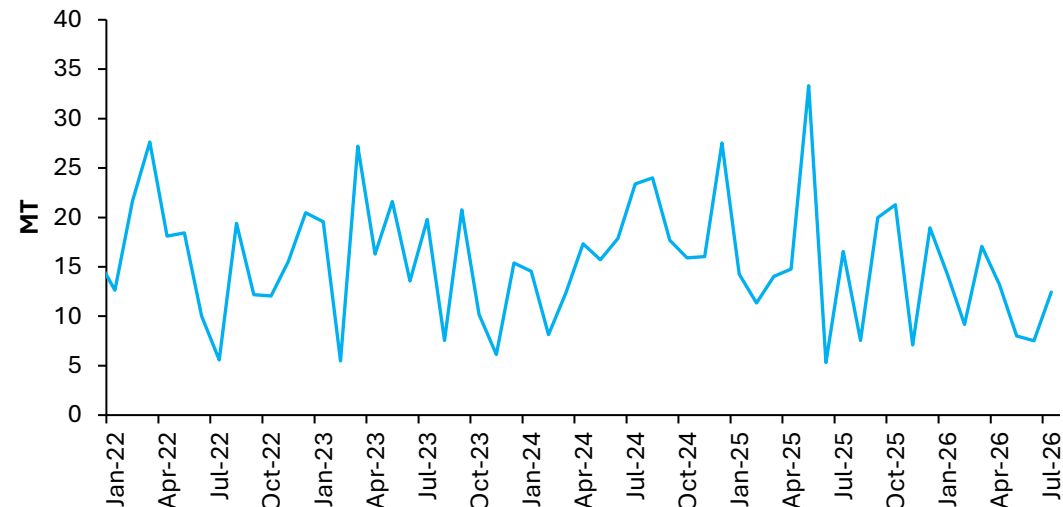

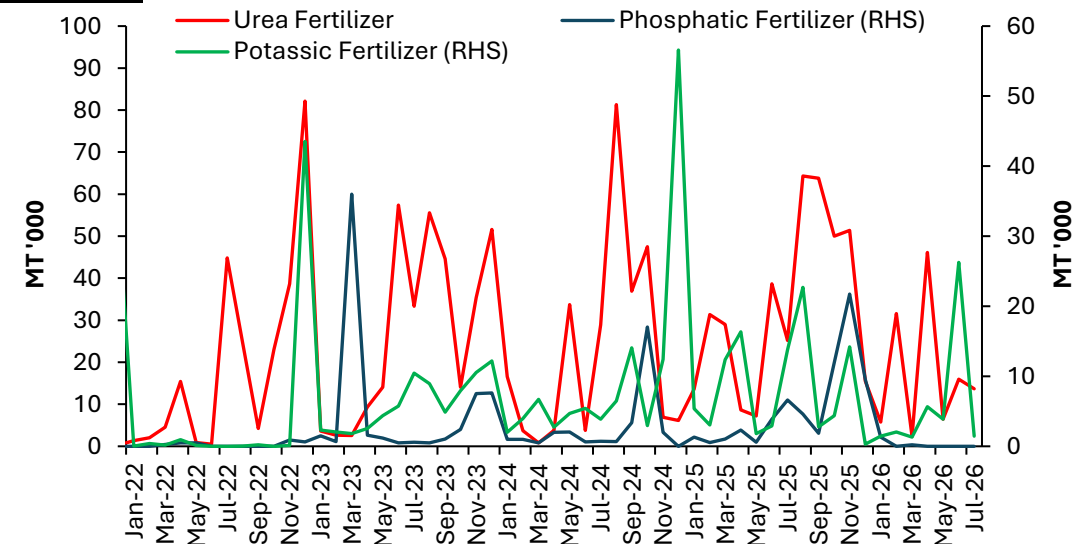

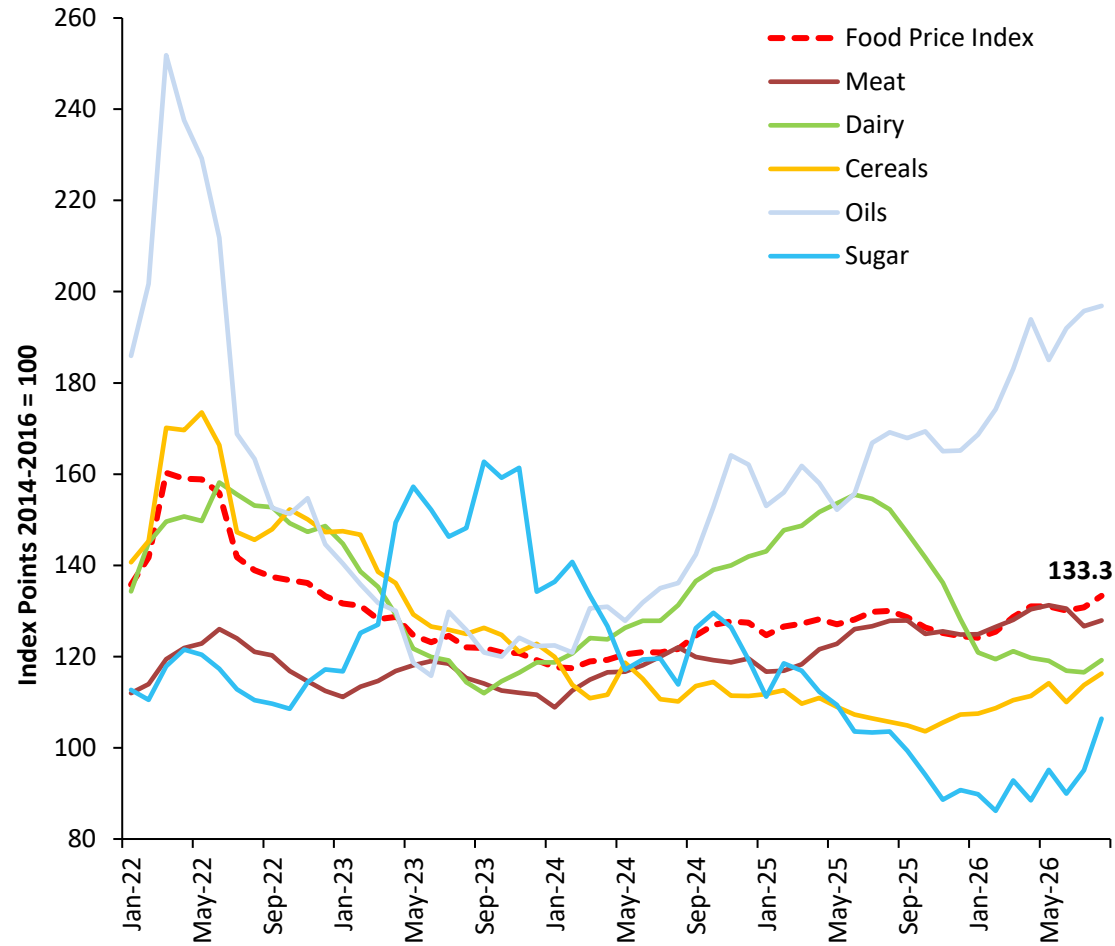

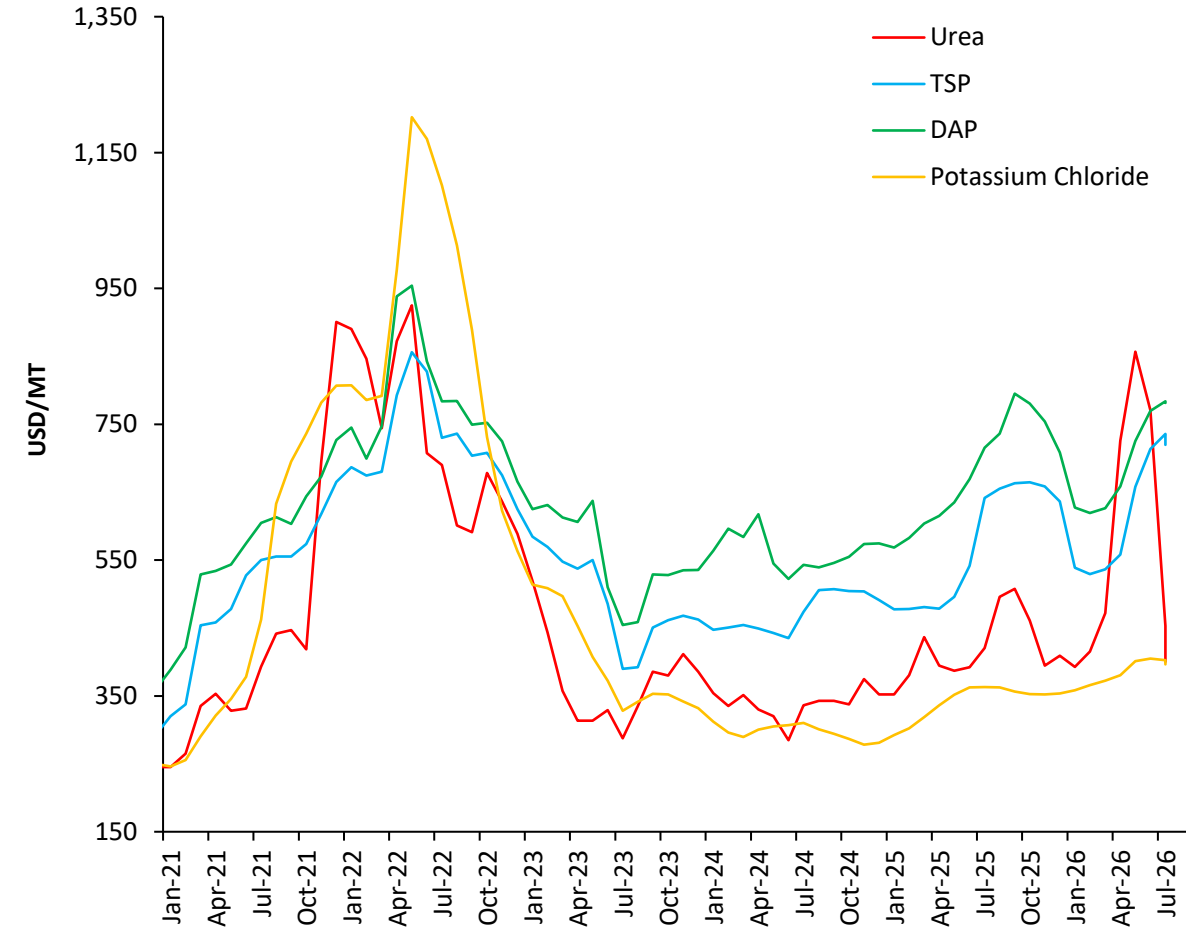
