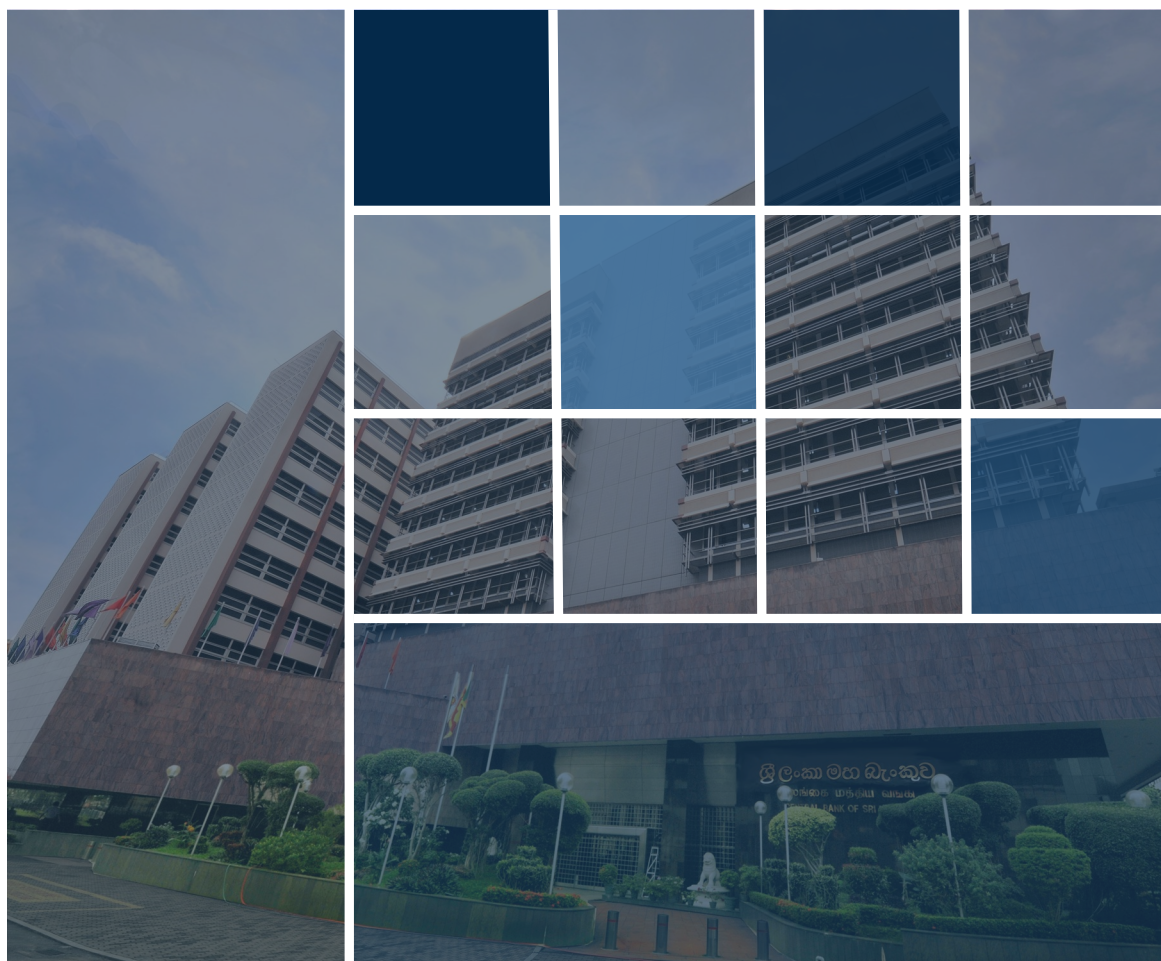


Weekly Economic Indicators

03rd May 2019



Highlights of the Week

Real Sector

The year-on-year CCPI headline inflation increased to 4.5 per cent in April 2019 from 4.3 per cent in March 2019. The month on month change of the CCPI increased by 0.3 per cent in April 2019 due to increase in the prices of the items in Non-Food category.

During the period, crude oil prices followed a mixed performance. Price decline was mainly supported by increase in U.S. output and an expected supply increase from OPEC. However, oil prices increased mid-week as tight global supplies offset economic concerns. Overall, both Brent and WTI prices fell by US\$ 1.2 per barrel within the period.

Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 03 May 2019 decreased by 04 bps to 12.20% compared to the previous week.

The reserve money decreased compared to the previous week mainly due to the decrease in currency in circulation and deposits held by the commercial banks.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a surplus of Rs. 44.61 bn by end of the week, compared to a deficit of Rs. 8.027 bn by the end of last week.

By 03 May 2019, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) increased by 0.03% to 5,438.8 points and the S&P SL 20 Index increased by 0.66% to 2,618.0 points, compared to the previous week.

External Sector

During the year up to 03 May 2019 the Sri Lanka rupee appreciated against the US dollar (3.4 per cent). Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lanka rupee appreciated against the pound sterling (0.6 per cent), Japanese yen (4.3 per cent), the euro (5.8 per cent) and the Indian rupee (2.5 per cent) during this period.

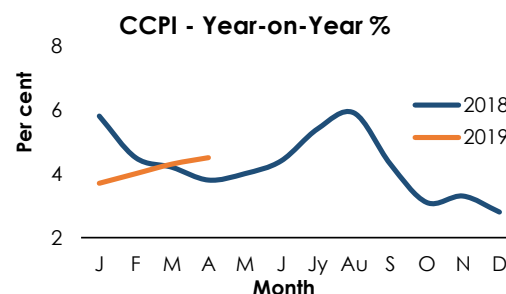
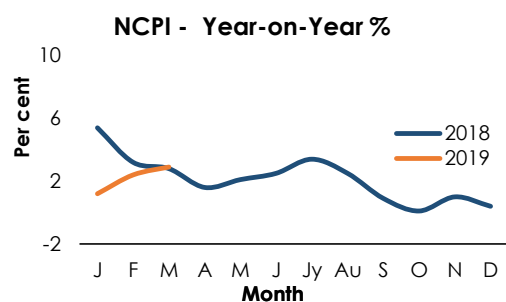
