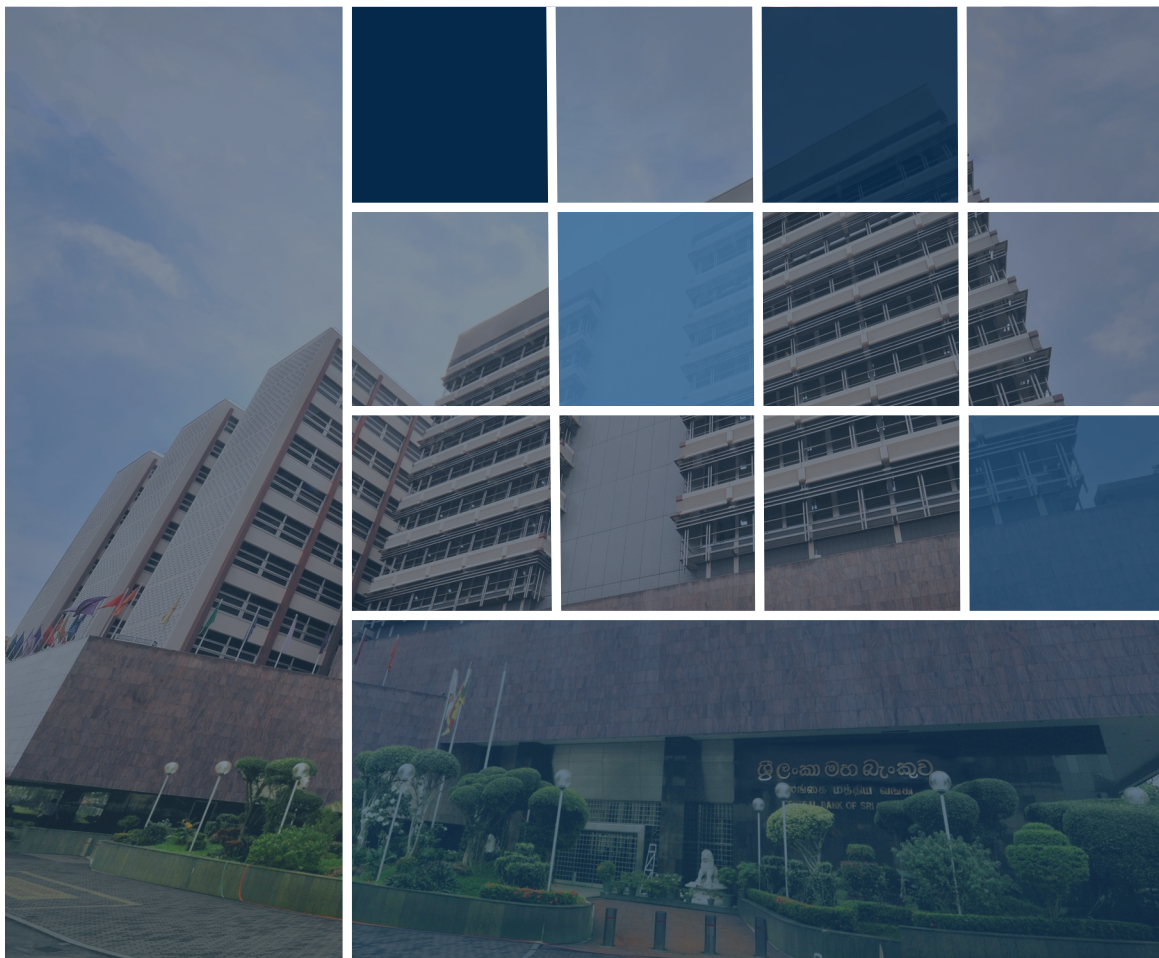

Highlights of the Week

Real Sector

The IIP in November 2018 has decreased by 1.2 per cent in comparison with the corresponding month of 2017. Among the major sub divisions of the manufacturing industries; volume of "Other non-metallic mineral products" (11.3%); "Food Products" (2.7%) have contributed to the overall decrease in production during the month of November, 2018 compared to that of November, 2017 and "Beverages" (14.2%); "Rubber and plastic products" (13.3%); "Coke and refined petroleum products" (5.8%); "Wearing apparel" (3.8%) decreased during the period.

During the period, crude oil prices followed an increasing trend. Price increase was supported by OPEC-led supply cuts and hopes of successful US-China trade talks. However, concerns over slowing global economic growth, which could dent demand, dampened the price pressure to some extent. Overall, both Brent and WTI prices rose by US\$ 4.3 per barrel and US\$ 3.8 per barrel, respectively, within the period.

Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 11 January 2019 decreased by 10 bps to 11.82% compared to the previous week

The reserve money decreased compared to the previous week mainly due to decrease in currency in circulation.

The total outstanding market liquidity decreased to a deficit of Rs. 168.990 bn by end of the week, compared to a deficit of Rs. 152.890 bn by the end of last week.

By 11 January 2019, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) decreased by 1.65% to 5,967.3 points and the S&P SL 20 Index decreased by 2.23 to 3,036.6 points, compared to the previous week.

External Sector

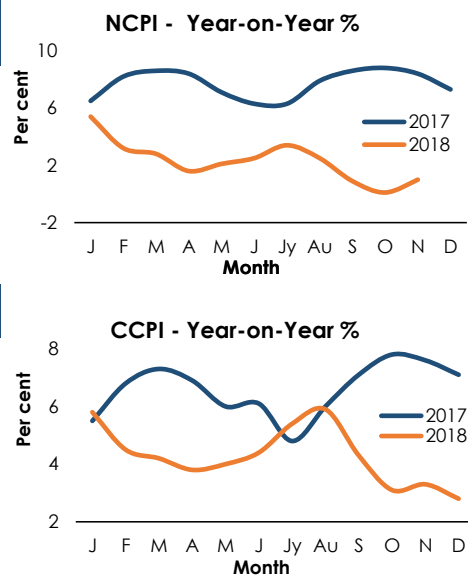
During the year up to 11 January 2019 the Sri Lanka rupee appreciated against the US dollar (0.3 per cent). Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lanka rupee depreciated against the Japanese yen (1.7 per cent), euro (0.5 per cent) and the pound sterling (0.3 per cent), while the Sri Lanka rupee appreciated against the Indian rupee (1.0 per cent) during this period.

The gross official reserves were estimated at US dollars 6,936.35 million as at 31st December 2018.
