Weekly Economic Indicators

04th June 2020



Highlights of the Week



During the period under review (30.05.2020 to 04.06.2020), crude oil prices largely showed an increasing trend. Prices rose to the highest levels since mid March 2020 amid optimism that major producers will extend production cuts as the world recovers from COVID-19 pandemic. However, in the end of the week, prices fell on doubts about the timing and scale of the possible extension to crude oil supply cuts. Overall, Brent and WTI prices increased by US dollars 1.92 per barrel and US dollars 1.61 per barrel, respectively, during the period.



Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 04th June 2020 decreased by 21 bps to 8.95 per cent compared to the previous week.

The reserve money increased compared to the previous week mainly due to the increase in deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a surplus of Rs. 30.610 bn by end of this week, compared to a surplus of Rs. 45.270 bn by the end of last week.

By 04th June 2020, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) decreased by 1.36 per cent to 4,781.03 points and the S&P SL 20 Index decreased by 3.05 per cent to 1,954.57 points, compared to the index values of last week.



External Sector

During the year up to 04th June 2020 the Sri Lankan Rupee depreciated against the US dollar (2.2 per cent). Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee appreciated against the Pound sterling (2.4 per cent) and the Indian rupee (3.4 per cent) while depreciating against the Euro (2.3 per cent) and the Japanese yen (2.0 per cent) during this period.
