
Weekly Economic Indicators

10th July 2020



Highlights of the Week



During the first four months of the year 2020, domestic tea production declined in comparison to the previous year owing to dry weather conditions. Production of rubber decreased in response to low market prices while coconut production decreased considerably due to the lagged effect of adverse weather conditions prevailed during the early part of 2019.

During the period under review (04.07.2020 to 10.07.2020), crude oil prices showed a mixed performance. Prices increased mainly due to supply cuts made by major producers. However, prices declined considerably in the end of the period due to worries on renewed lockdowns due to a surge in COVID-19 cases in the U.S. and some other countries that will lower the global fuel demand. Overall, Brent and WTI prices decreased by US dollars 0.75 per barrel and US dollars 1.01 per barrel, respectively, during the period.



Monetary Sector

The Central Bank reduced its policy interest rates, the Standing Deposit Facility Rate (SDFR) and the Standing Lending Facility Rate (SLFR), by 100 basis points each, to 4.50 per cent and 5.50 per cent, respectively, effective from 09th July 2020.

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 10th July 2020 decreased by 37 bps to 8.11 per cent compared to the previous week

The reserve money increased compared to the previous week mainly due to the increase in deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a surplus of Rs. 166.675 bn by end of this week, compared to a surplus of Rs. 160.021 bn by the end of last week.

By 10th July 2020, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) decreased by 1.15 per cent to 4,992.62 points and the S&P SL 20 Index decreased by 2.31 per cent to 2140.19 points, compared to the index values of last week.



External Sector

During the year up to 10th July 2020 the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the US dollar (2.2 per cent). Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee appreciated against the pound sterling (2.0 per cent) and the Indian rupee (3.1 per cent) while depreciating against the Euro (2.7 per cent) and the Japanese yen (3.6 per cent) during this period.

The gross official reserves were estimated at US dollars 6,693.2 mn as at 30th June 2020.
