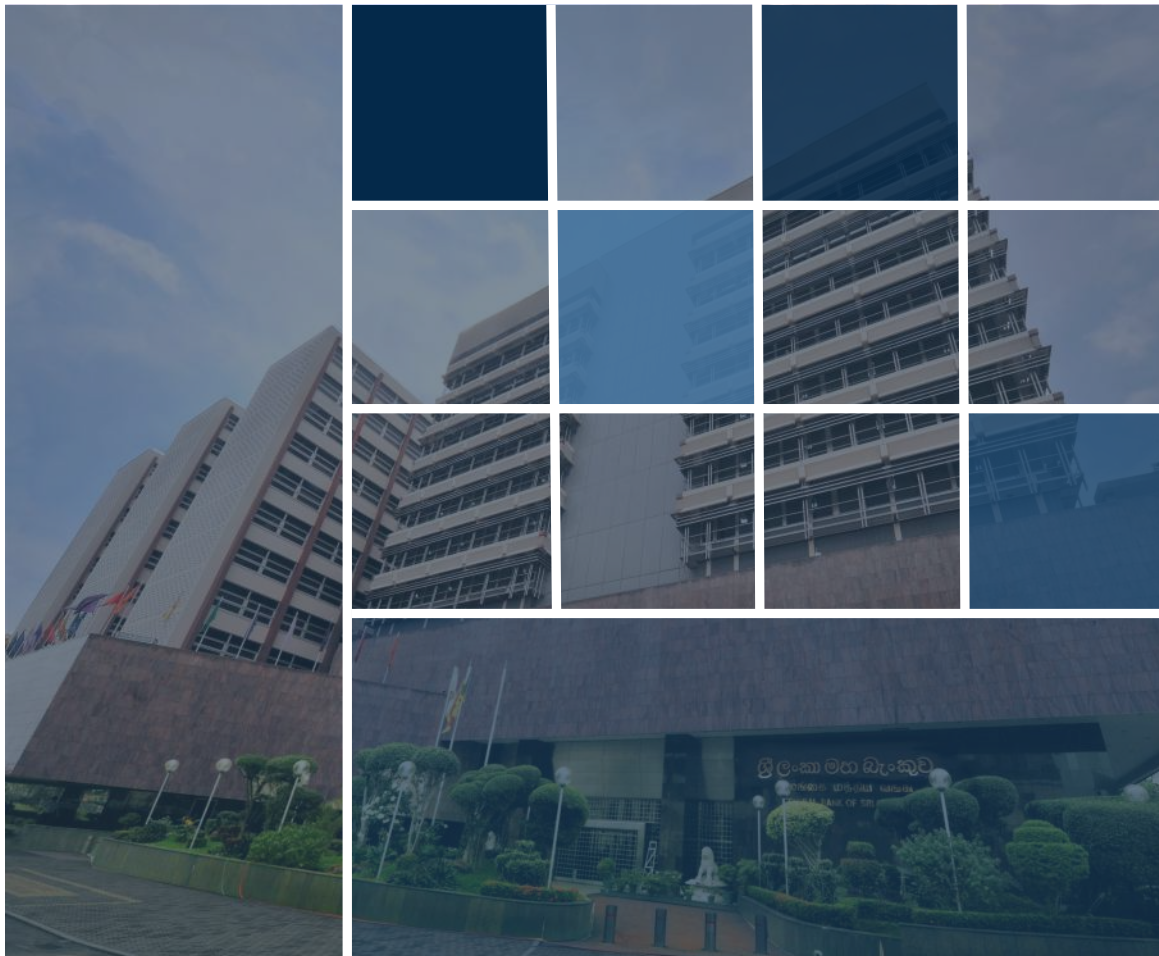


Weekly Economic Indicators

29th October 2020



Highlights of the Week

Real Sector

CCPI based headline inflation (Y-o-Y) remained unchanged at 4.0 per cent in October 2020. Meanwhile, Food inflation (Y-o-Y) and Non-food inflation (Y-o-Y) recorded at 10.0 per cent and 1.3 per cent, respectively, in October 2020.

During the period under review (24.10.2020 to 29.10.2020), crude oil prices largely showed a declining trend. Oil prices declined amidst renewed lockdowns in the U.S. and Europe due to the increase of Covid-19 cases and the expectations on worsening of unsteady economic demand. Overall, Brent and WTI prices declined by US dollars 1.85 per barrel and US dollars 1.65 per barrel, respectively, during the period.

Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 29th October 2020 increased by 13 bps to 5.85 per cent compared to the previous week.

The reserve money increased compared to the previous week mainly due to the increase in currency in circulation and deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a surplus of Rs.140.111 bn by end of this week, compared to a surplus of Rs.150.609 bn by the end of last week.

By 29th October 2020, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) decreased by 0.73 per cent to 5,726.59 points and the S&P SL 20 Index decreased by 0.68 per cent to 2,282.20 points, compared to the index values of last week.

External Sector

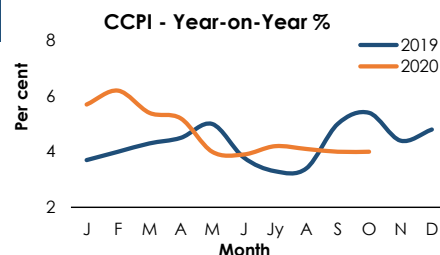
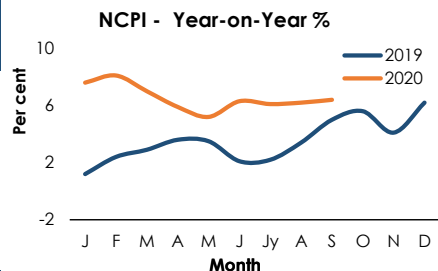
During the year up to 29th October 2020 the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the US dollar (1.4 per cent). Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee appreciated against the Indian rupee (2.6 per cent) while depreciating against the Euro (6.0 per cent), the Japanese yen (5.3 per cent) and the pound sterling (0.4 per cent) during this period.

The gross official reserves were estimated at US dollars 6,666.3 mn as at 30th September 2020.

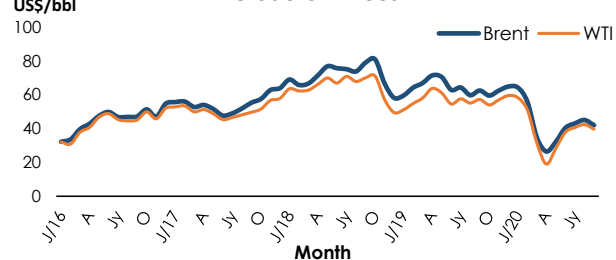
