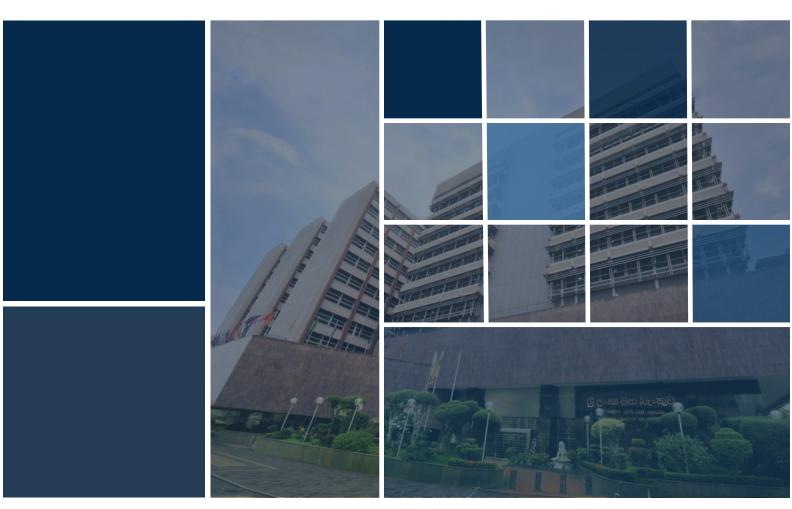
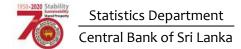
Weekly Economic Indicators

30th July 2021





Highlights of the Week



CCPI based headline inflation (Y-o-Y) increased to 5.7 per cent in July 2021 from 5.2 per cent in June 2021 due to monthly increases observed in prices of items in the Non-food category. Meanwhile, Food inflation (Y-o-Y) and Non-food inflation (Y-o-Y) recorded at 11.0 per cent and 3.2 per cent, respectively, in July 2021.

During the period under review (24.07.2021 to 30.07.2021), crude oil prices largely showed an increasing trend. Prices increased mainly due to the higher growing demand than the supply amidst the success in COVID-19 vaccinations that dampened the impact of the pandemic worldwide. Further, decline in US crude inventories to the pre-pandemic levels also helped in price increase. Overall, both Brent and WTI prices increased by US dollars 1.70 per barrel and US dollars 1.27 per barrel, respectively, during the period.



Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 30th July 2021 increased by 11 bps to 5.76 per cent compared to the previous week.

Broad money (M_{2b}) expanded by 21.5 per cent, on a Y-o-Y basis, in June 2021.

Net Credit to the Government from the banking system increased by Rs. 170.6 bn in June 2021.

Outstanding credit to public corporations increased by Rs. 19.4 bn in June 2021.

Outstanding credit extended to the private sector increased by Rs. 83.4 bn in June 2021.

The reserve money decreased compared to the previous week mainly due to the decrease in currency in circulation and deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a surplus of Rs.8.721 bn by the end of this week, compared to a surplus of Rs. 0.032 bn by the end of last week.

By 30th July 2021, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) decreased by 0.20 per cent to 8,120.48 points and the S&P SL 20 Index decreased by 0.97 per cent to 3,062.17 points, compared to the index values of last week.



External Sector

During the year up to 30th July 2021, the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the US dollar by 6.7 per cent. Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the pound sterling by 8.8 per cent, the Indian rupee by 5.4 per cent, the Euro by 3.4 per cent and the Japanese yen by 1.0 per cent during this period.

The gross official reserves were estimated at US dollars 4,060.0 mn as at end June 2021.

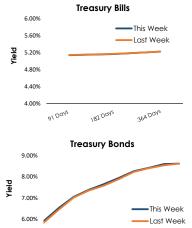
