Highlights of the Week

Real Sector

During the period under review (31.07.2021 to 06.08.2021), crude oil prices largely showed a declining trend, reflecting surprise build in crude stockpiles in the US, increasing spread of Delta variant of the coronavirus in major oil consuming countries and slowdown in manufacturing activities in China and the US. However, prices increased marginally at the end of the period due to rising tensions in the Middle East. Overall, both Brent and WTI prices fell by US dollars 3.04 per barrel and US dollars 3.89 per barrel, respectively, during the period.

Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 06th August 2021 decreased by 4 bps to 5.72 per cent compared to the previous week.

The reserve money increased compared to the previous week mainly due to the increase in deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a surplus of Rs. 48.322 bn by the end of this week, compared to a surplus of Rs. 8.721 bn by the end of last week.

By 06th August 2021, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) decreased by 0.26 per cent to 8,099.12 points and the S&P SL 20 Index decreased by 0.2 per cent to 3,056.02 points, compared to the index values of last week.

External Sector

During the year up to 06th August 2021, the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the US dollar by 6.7 per cent. Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the pound sterling by 8.6 per cent, the Indian rupee by 5.6 per cent, the Euro by 2.9 per cent and the Japanese yen by 0.6 per cent during this period.
