
Weekly Economic Indicators

29th October 2021





Highlights of the Week

Real Sector

CCPI based headline inflation (Y-o-Y) increased to 7.6 per cent in October 2021 from 5.7 per cent in September 2021 due to the monthly increases of prices of items in both Food and Non-food categories. Meanwhile, Food inflation (Y-o-Y) and Non-food inflation (Y-o-Y) recorded at 12.8 per cent and 5.4 per cent, respectively, in October 2021.

During the period under review (23.10.2021 to 29.10.2021), crude oil prices largely showed a decreasing trend. At the beginning of the week, prices decreased due to higher than expected increase in crude oil stockpiles and fuel inventories of the US. However, crude oil prices rose moderately at the end of the week with the rising global fuel demand. Overall, both Brent and WTI prices decreased by US dollars 1.59 and US dollars 1.67 per barrel, respectively, during the period.

Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 29^{th} October 2021 increased by 59 bps to 7.82 per cent compared to the previous week.

The reserve money decreased compared to the previous week mainly due to the decrease in currency in circulation and decrease in deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a deficit of Rs. 183.954 bn by end of this week, compared to a deficit of Rs.171.839 bn by the end of last week.

By 29th October 2021, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) increased by 2.50 per cent to10,162.93 points and the S&P SL 20 Index increased by 2.85 per cent to 3,708.52 points, compared to the index values of last week.

External Sector

During the year up to 29th October 2021, the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the US dollar by 7.7 per cent. Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee appreciated against the Japanese yen by 1.7 per cent while depreciating against the pound sterling by 8.6 per cent, the Indian rupee by 5.6 per cent and the Euro by 2.7 per cent during this period.

The gross official reserves were estimated at US dollars 2,704.2 mn as at end September 2021.
