Highlights of the Week

Real Sector

CCPI based headline inflation (Y-o-Y) increased to 9.9 per cent in November 2021 from 7.6 per cent in October 2021 due to the monthly increases of prices of items in both Food and Non-food categories. Meanwhile, Food inflation (Y-o-Y) and Non-food inflation (Y-o-Y) recorded at 17.5 per cent and 6.4 per cent, respectively, in November 2021. Furthermore, the CCPI measured on an annual average basis, increased to 5.3 per cent in November 2021 from 4.8 per cent in October 2021.

During the period under review (29.11.2021 to 03.12.2021), crude oil prices largely showed a declining trend with heightened worries on demand amidst the new COVID-19 variant, Omicron, and concerns on the efficacy of vaccines against the new variant. Further, Fed's signals to end its assets purchases faster also affected the demand concerns. Towards the end of the period crude oil prices increased due to the decision of the OPEC+ to review supply additions ahead of its next scheduled meeting on 04th January 2021, if the Omicron variant hits demand. Overall, both Brent and WTI prices decreased by US dollars 5.81 and US dollars 4.64 per barrel, respectively, during the period.



Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 03rd December 2021 decreased by 17 bps to 8.00 per cent compared to the previous week.

Broad money (M_{2h}) expanded by 17.3 per cent, on a Y-o-Y basis, in October 2021.

Net Credit to the Government from the banking system increased by Rs. 130.9 bn in October 2021.

Outstanding credit to public corporations increased by Rs. 70.7 bn in October 2021.

Outstanding credit extended to the private sector increased by Rs. 35.1 bn in October 2021.

The reserve money decreased compared to the previous week mainly due to the decrease in currency in circulation and decrease in deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a deficit of Rs. 319.302 bn by the end of this week, compared to a deficit of Rs.282.994 bn by the end of last week.

By 03rd December 2021, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) decreased by 1.87 per cent to 10,988.32 points and the S&P SL 20 Index increased by 1.62 per cent to 3,884.57 points, compared to the index values of last week.



External Sector

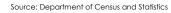
During the year up to 03rd December 2021, the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the US dollar by 7.0 per cent. Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee appreciated against the Japanese yen by 2.0 per cent and the Euro by 1.3 per cent while depreciating against the Indian rupee by 4.7 per cent and the pound sterling by 4.5 per cent during this period.

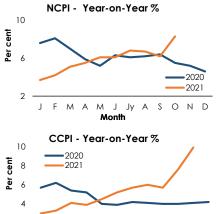
The gross official reserves were at US dollars 2,269.2 mn as at end October 2021.

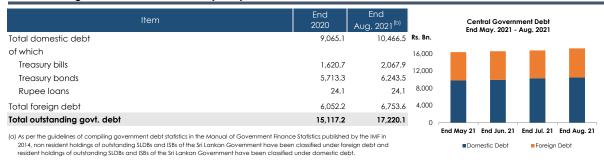

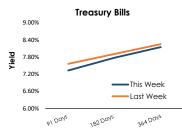
