## Highlights of the Week

### Real Sector

IIP in October 2021 increased by 1.6 per cent to 107.8 compared to October 2020. Among the major sub divisions of the manufacturing industries, "Rubber and plastic products" (29.2 per cent) and "Beverages" (17.5 per cent) have mainly contributed to this overall increase.

During the period under review (04.12.2021 to 10.12.2021), crude oil prices largely showed an increasing trend owing to eased concerns on the impact of the Omicron COVID-19 variant on global fuel demand and delays in the return of Iranian crude oil, as indirect nuclear talks between the United States and Iran turned more pessimistic. Towards the end of the period, crude oil prices fell slightly owing to fears about the economic outlook of China. Overall, both Brent and WTI prices increased by US dollars 2.92 and US dollars 3.03 per barrel, respectively, during the period.

## Monetary Sector

Weekly AWPR for the week ending 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021 increased by 16 bps to 8.16 per cent compared to the previous week.

The reserve money decreased compared to the previous week mainly due to the decrease in deposits held by the commercial banks with the Central Bank.

The total outstanding market liquidity was a deficit of Rs. 358.887 bn by end of this week, compared to a deficit of Rs. 319.302 bn by the end of last week.

By 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021, the All Share Price Index (ASPI) increased by 3.69 per cent to 11,393.48 points and the S&P SL 20 Index increased by 4.89 per cent to 4,074.63 points, compared to the index values of last week.

## External Sector

During the year up to 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021, the Sri Lankan rupee depreciated against the US dollar by 7.3 per cent. Given the cross currency exchange rate movements, the Sri Lankan rupee appreciated against the Japanese yen by 2.1 per cent and the Euro by 1.0 per cent while depreciating against the Indian rupee by 4.2 per cent and the pound sterling by 4.4 per cent during this period.

The gross official reserves were estimated at US dollars 1,587.0 mn as at end November 2021.
